AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: On March 9, the D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated earning a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations, in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' 6-3 road record (.667) since April 8 is tied for the NL's third-best winning pct. (also: Padres, .667, 6-3), behind the Cardinals (.778, 7-2) and Braves (.875, 7-1).

- **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 24-game hitting streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is MLB's longest active streak and the second-longest since 2024, behind Bryan Reynolds' 25-gamer (June 1-29, 2024).
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base 15 times in his last 6 games, hitting .579 (11-for-19)/1.442 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 4 walks (2 K).
 - In his last 13 games, is hitting .409 (18-for-44)/1.154 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 4 walks (6 K).
- **Jose Fernandez** has a 10-game on-base streak as a starter, including 4 multi-hit efforts, hitting .368 (14-for-38)/.915 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks (7 K).
 - In his last 16 starts, is hitting .355 (22-for-62)/.836 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 3 walks (13 K).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 13-2 @ Brewers last night.

- **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his career-best 24-game hit streak with his eighth-inning single.
- **James McCann** had a 2-run single in the fifth inning to cut the lead to 1.
- **Ryan Thompson** (0.2 IP), **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) and **James McCann** (1.0 IP) combined for 2.2 scoreless innings (H, 0 BB, K).

ROSTER MOVES: Today, the D-backs recalled LHP **Philip Abner** from Triple-A Reno and optioned RHP **Andrew Hoffmann** to Reno following last night's game.

KETEL GETTING ON BASE: **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games, batting .273 (15-for-55)/.788 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 5 walks.

2-WAY THOMAS: **Alek Thomas** in his last 8 games, is batting .345 (10-for-29)/1.056 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 1 walk (1 K).

- His 5 DRS are tied for third in MLB among outfielders (also: 3 others) to Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHI (9) and Willyer Abreu/BOS (7).

WE'LL TAKE A DOZEN: The D-backs' 12 comeback victories lead the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (11), Braves (10) and Cardinals (10) [source: MLB Research].

- They are a MLB-best 11-6 in games when they allow the first run.

PRODUCING AT THE BOTTOM: Since April 13, the D-backs' 7-9 hitters in the lineup lead MLB in AVG (1st, .303), OPS (1st, .903), SLG (1st, .561), RBI (1st, 30), extra-base hits (1st, 18) and are top 3 in homers (T-2nd, 8).

ROAD SNAKES: **Ildemaro Vargas'** 17-game road hitting streak is MLB's longest active streak...is batting .333 (22-for-66)/.802 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 3 walks during the span.

- **Adrian Del Castillo** has reached base in 7 straight road games, hitting .320 (8-for-25)/.850 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 9 of his last 11 road games (11 H, 3 BB)/.821 OPS with 4 homers and 7 RBI.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 11 of his last 12 road games (10 H, 8 BB)/.701 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI, 1 SAC and 1 SF.
- **Jose Fernandez** in his last 9 road games, is hitting .306 (11-for-36)/.685 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 1 walk.

VS. BREWERS: The D-backs have taken 4 straight season series since 2022 (16-12)...are 8-5 in the last 13 games @ Brewers.
