## PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (37-26) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (24-40) June 7, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - Game #65/Home #34 LHP Ranger Suárez (4-0, 2.72 ERA) vs. LHP Andrew Heaney (3-4, 3.39 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** won the first game of this three-game series vs. Philadelphia on Friday night in walkoff fashion...Will wrap up this series with the Phillies before welcoming Miami to town for three games (Monday-Wednesday) to conclude a nine-game homestand (lost two of three vs. Houston to begin the homestand)...Have gone 12-14 since Don Kelly managed his first game on May 9 vs. Atlanta...Have posted the second-best fielding percentage (.992) in all of Major League Baseball since Kelly took over (New York-AL has an MLB-best .993 fielding percentage during that time)...Have played in 12 one-run games since Kelly became manager (6-6 record in those games), tied for second-most among Major League teams in that stretch.

**WALK IT OFF:** Nick Gonzales led Pittsburgh to a 5-4 victory vs. Philadelphia on Friday with his walkoff sacrifice fly that scored Adam Frazier...It was the third walkoff of Gonzales' career, the first since producing a walkoff single in an 8-7 win over the Phillies last July 19...It was also Pittsburgh's fifth walkoff of the season (tied for fourth-most among Major League teams)...Tommy Pham delivered a walkoff single on April 6 vs. New York-AL (5-4, 11 innings), Joey Bart recorded walkoff singles on April 9 vs. St. Louis (2-1, 13 innings) and May 11 vs. Atlanta (4-3) and Frazier scored on a game-ending wild pitch on May 23 vs. Milwaukee (6-5, 10 innings).

**LEGGING IT OUT:** Nick Gonzales tripled in the first inning of Friday's win vs. Philadelphia, marking his first triple since last September 19 at St. Louis...Pittsburgh's 11 triples this season are sixth-most in Major League Baseball, trailing Colorado (18), Chicago-NL (15), New York-NL (13), Arizona (12) and Kansas City (12)...Gonzales became the first Pirate to record a triple and a walkoff RBI in the same game since Adam Frazier on September 20, 2017 vs. Milwaukee (hit a walkoff two-run homer in that win).

**SOUTHPAW SIGHTING:** The Pirates will be opposed by a left-handed starter for the second time in three games (also Framber Valdez on Thursday vs. Houston) and 15th time this season...Pittsburgh is 4-10 in those games...Prior to Thursday vs. Valdez, the last time the Pirates were opposed by a starting southpaw was Cincinnati's Nick Lodolo on May 19 (Pittsburgh was defeated, 7-1).

**RED-HOT REYNOLDS:** Bryan Reynolds tied Friday night's win vs. Philadelphia two separate times...He brought home Nick Gonzales with an RBI single in the first inning to tie the game at 1, while also tying the game at 2 with his solo shot off Tanner Banks in the third inning...Over his last 18 games (since May 17 at Philadelphia), Reynolds is batting .348 (23-for-66) with eight extra-base hits (four doubles, one triple, three home runs), 16 RBI, nine walks, six runs scored and a 1.005 OPS...His 16 RBI in that span are tied for ninth-most in all of Major League Baseball, while his 1.005 OPS is the 13th-best in Major League Baseball during that stretch.

**UP GOES FRAZIER:** Adam Frazier collected three hits on Friday vs. Philadelphia, his third three-hit game of the season (also May 23 and May 25 vs. Milwaukee)...Across his last 13 games (since May 20 vs. Cincinnati), Frazier is 17-for-48 (.354) with five doubles, a home run, five RBI, four walks and five runs scored...During that stretch, Frazier has raised his season average from .217 to .254.

**BEASTS OF THE EAST:** Pittsburgh has gone 17-8 against the National League East here at PNC Park since the beginning of last season (3-1 vs. Philadelphia)...The Pirates have gone 5-0-2 in seven series here against the division since the start of the 2024 campaign (last series loss was vs. Miami from September 29-October 1, 2023).

**BULLPEN BOOST:** Pittsburgh relievers combined to toss 5.1 innings in Friday's win vs. Philadelphia...It was the Pirates' fourth win this season where their bullpen pitched at least 5.1 innings (first since May 27 at Arizona)...The four-such wins are tied for fifth-most in all of MLB (Los Angeles-NL, 10, ranks first).

**PLAY RENEGADE:** David Bednar struck out the side in the ninth inning and picked up his first win of the season on Friday vs. Philadelphia (first win since May 21, 2024 vs. San Francisco, a game that Nick Gonzales ended with a walkoff single)...It also marked the fourth time in Bednar's career that he struck out the side (first since May 7, 2022-G2 at Cincinnati)...In his last 21 games (since April 19 vs. Cleveland), Bednar has a 2.75 ERA (19.2ip/6er) and 29 strikeouts (just three walks in that span)...His 29 strikeouts in that stretch are tied with New York (NL)'s Edwin Díaz for third-most among Major League relievers, trailing Minnesota's Griffin Jax (34) and Colorado's Jake Bird (33).

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed as a free agent on February 22, 2025.

**STARTING OFF:** The 33-year-old southpaw is in his 12th Major League season...He signed a one-year contract with Pittsburgh on February 22 after spending each of the previous two years with Texas...Was Los Angeles (AL)'s nominee in both 2018 and 2019 for the distinguished Roberto Clemente Award for his community involvement.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Heaney allowed two runs on five hits (zero walks) and three strikeouts over 5.2 innings on June 1 at San Diego, but had a no-decision in the 6-4 loss.

**AGAINST THE PHILLIES:** Heaney is 0-2 with a 6.08 ERA (13.1ip/9er) and three career starts against Philadelphia...He allowed one run on four hits and three walks (two strikeouts) in 5.0 innings on May 16 at Citizens Bank Park (no-decision in an 8-4 loss).

**PUTTING UP ZEROES:** Heaney had his career-best streak of 19.1 consecutive scoreless innings come to an end in the fourth inning of his start on April 29 vs. Chicago (NL).

**A HALO OF A PERFORMANCE:** Heaney allowed one hit over 6.0 innings (struck out nine) while earning the win in the team's 3-0 shutout in Anaheim against the Angels on April 23 (struck out each of the first six batters he faced)...He became the first Pirates lefthander to throw 6.0-plus scoreless innings with nine-plus strikeouts since Francisco Liriano on April 3, 2016 vs. St. Louis (10 strikeouts)...Heaney also became the first Pirates left-handed pitcher to throw 6.0-plus scoreless innings in consecutive starts since Jose Quintana from May 9-15, 2022...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Heaney became the first Pirates southpaw in club history to throw 6.0-plus scoreless innings with nine-plus strikeouts while allowing one hit or fewer and issuing zero walks in an outing.

**AND THE WHIFF:** Heaney struck out each of the first six batters he faced in his start on April 23 in Anaheim against the Angels, becoming the first Pirates left-handed pitcher to strike out six-plus consecutive batters since Francisco Liriano on June 1, 2013 vs. Cincinnati (seven straight)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Heaney and Paul Skenes (May 17, 2024 at Wrigley Field against the Cubs) are the only Pittsburgh pitchers in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to strike out six or more straight batters to begin a game.

**PESKY LEFTIES:** According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Bailey Falter (7.0ip/0r on April 16) and Heaney (7.1ip/0r on April 17) became the first pair of Pirates left-handed teammates to pitch 7.0-plus scoreless innings in consecutive team games since John Candelaria (9.0ip) and Larry McWilliams (7.0ip) did so on July 25 and July 27, 1982.

**RESPECTED VETERAN:** Prior to his start on April 17, Heaney was honored by his coaches and teammates for reaching 10 years of Major League service...He is one of two Pirates with 10-plus years of service time (10 years, 51 days), along with Andrew McCutchen (16 years, 24 days)...Tommy Pham ranks third (nine years, 165 days).

**FOUR YOUR INFO:** Heaney is one of four Major League left-handed pitchers to record 150-plus strikeouts in each of the last two seasons, along with Yusei Kikuchi, Framber Valdez and MacKenzie Gore...He is also one of five lefties to throw 145.0-plus innings in each of the last two years, along with Valdez, Kikuchi, Patrick Corbin and JP Sears.

**ON POINT:** Over 1080.2 innings in his career, Heaney has averaged 3.46 strikeouts for every walk issued...Since 1901, that is the eighth-best strikeout-to-walk ratio among MLB lefties, behind Chris Sale (5.25), Clayton Kershaw (4.33), Hyun Jin Ryu (3.96), Cliff Lee (3.93), Madison Bumgarner (3.81), David Price (3.69) and Johan Santana (3.51)
