RAY REPORT—The Rays wrap up a seven-game road trip against the Yankees (2-2) and Blue Jays (1-1, 1 to play) today in Toronto...are 6-4 in their last 10 games on the heels of a 1-4 stretch (July 5-10)...their 17-12 (.586) mark since June 19 is tied with the Rangers for second in the AL behind the Astros (20-9/.690)...including off days, this marks their 36th consecutive day occupying fourth place in the AL East...are 4.5 games behind the Royals for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...are at .500 for the 24th time, most in a season in club history...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500...have been within two games of .500 each day since June 23.

- After last night's 6-3 loss, the Rays have collected four hits or fewer in three straight games (3, 4, 4), their longest streak since May 9-12, 2021 (3G)...their last longer streak was four games from Aug. 11-14, 2017...they are batting .124/.250/.225 (11-for-89) with 31 SO collectively during the current run.
- The Rays went 3-for-10 (.300) with RISP and 1-for-21 (.048) in all other at-bats...they are 6-for-18 (.333) with RISP this series on the heels of an MLB-worst 11-for-97 (.113) clip in their previous 13 games (July 5-22).
- Rays hitters have recorded 10+ SO in three straight games (10, 10, 11), matching their longest streak in 2024 (5x)...their last four-game streak was Sept. 19-22, 2023.
- Over the Rays last seven games, they have plated 18 of their 26 runs (69.2%) via the home run, well above their season mark of 38.3 pct. (153 of 400)...their 11 HR since the All-Star break are tied with the Mets and Rockies for the most in the majors.
- Despite a 5-4 mark in their last nine, the Rays are 6-14 (.300) in their last 20 games vs. AL East opponents dating to May 19 after starting 9-7...only the Cubs (8-19/.296) and White Sox (3-9/.250) have worse records against their own divisions in that span.
- Including the current set, three straight and five of the Rays last six three-game series have been decided by a rubber game.
- Tampa Bay is 13-3 in its last 16 games following a loss, including five straight wins

WHAT'S AT STAKE

- With a win today, the Rays would:
 - Win their ninth consecutive rubber game, setting a new club record (prev. 8, 3x, last: July-Sept. 2018)...according to Elias, it would mark the longest single-season streak in the majors since the Yankees won 10 straight from May 5-Sept. 12, 2019.
 - Improve to 8-1-1 in their last 10 series and remain undefeated over their last four (3-0-1)...also, move to 4-1-1 in their last six road series after splitting their first 10.
 - Move to 3-0-1 in their last four series against the Blue Jays and record their first road series win over an AL East opponent since May 17-19 at Toronto.
 - Improve to 10-3-1 in series against opponents who entered with a sub-.500 record.
 - Win their 12th consecutive series in which they claimed the opening contest.
 - Avoid back-to-back losses for the first time since being swept in a three-game series at Texas from July 5-7.

TAJ TIME—Rays starter **RHP Taj Bradley** is 4-1 with an MLB-best 0.92 ERA (49.0IP, 5ER) over his last eight starts, marking the second-lowest ERA over an eight-start span in franchise history (excl. openers) behind **Chris Archer's** 0.84 ERA (53.1IP, 5ER) from Sept. 14, 2014-April 26, 2015...only **PHI Ranger Suárez** (0.82 from April 11-May 21) has turned in a lower ERA over an eight-start stretch this season...the last pitcher in the majors to record a 0.92 or better ERA over an eight-start span in an age 23 or younger season was **STL Jack Flaherty** (0.87) from July 26-Sept. 3, 2019 (single-season streaks only)...the lowest ERA over a nine-start span in club history (excl. openers) belongs to **Blake Snell**, who posted a 1.03 ERA (52.2IP, 6ER) from Aug. 10-Sept. 23, 2018...Bradley carries a career-best 17.0 scoreless inning streak into today's outing, the longest active streak among MLB starters and the longest streak by any Ray (starter/reliever) since **Kevin Kelly** (20.1) from May 14-July 15 (G2), 2023.

Bradley has earned the win in three of his last four starts, pitching to a 0.35 ERA (25.2IP, 1ER) and 0.86 WHIP...overall, he has yielded just 1 ER over his last 27.0 IP. He has tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in back-to-back starts, becoming the youngest hurler in club history to accomplish the feat...only 12 pitchers have turned the trick for the Rays, most recently **Charlie Morton** from June 5-10, 2019...no Tampa Bay hurler has thrown 7.0+ scoreless innings in three consecutive starts.

The Rays rotation as a whole leads the majors with a 3.04 ERA (154.0IP, 52ER) and 360 opp. SLG over the club's last 29 games since June 19.

20-20 VISION—**Randy Arozarena** is 5 HR and 4 SB shy of his fourth consecutive 20-20 season...he and **B.J. Upton** (2011 - 16HR, 23SB) are the only players in Rays history to record 15+ HR and 15+ SB before the end of July...he joins **CLE José Ramírez** and **KC Bobby Witt Jr.** as the only AL hitters to reach those figures...the Rays have 60 games remaining—Arozarena has never recorded fewer than 5 HR and 4 SB over any 60-game span in his career...he is already the first player in MLB history to record a 20-20 season as a rookie and again in each of the next two seasons...Arozarena, Ramírez and **PHI Trea Turner** are the only players to record 20-20 seasons in each of the last three years (2021-23)...among active players, only Ramírez and **LAA Mike Trout** (both 5) have more 20-20 seasons than Arozarena, who is one of nine active hitters with at least three such campaigns...the three 20-20 seasons are tied with Upton for the most in franchise history.

THE MAGIC NUMBER—The Rays have won 12 consecutive games when plating 4+ runs, their longest single-season streak since a 21-game run to open the 2023 campaign...since the start of June, they are 17-2 in games scoring 4+ times, second best in the majors behind the Padres (20-2/.909)...this, compared to 6-19 with three runs or fewer.

Scoring the first run has also dictated the Rays success as of late...the team that has scored first has won in each of their last seven games.

RUNNIN' RAYS—Tampa Bay has recorded multiple steals in back-to-back games for the first time since June 19-20...it falls one game shy of the club's longest streak in 2024 (2x, last: May 4-6)...the Rays have stolen a base in 11 of their last 12 games and 16 of 18 in July...their 104 SB overall pace the AL and are tied with the Phillies for fourth in the majors behind the Reds (146), Brewers (138) and Nationals (137)...the Rays have three players with 15+ SB (Arozarena, Caballero, Palacios), tied with the Royals and Nationals for most in MLB.

Despite recording just 1 SB in his last 21 games, **José Caballero's** 25 SB are still tied for the AL lead with **BOS David Hamilton**.

Randy Arozarena has stolen a base in consecutive games for the second time this season (also May 5-6)...his career high is three straight games (2x, last: June 26-29, 2022)...Arozarena's 6 SB this month are tied for third most in the AL.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own MLB's best record in games decided by two runs or fewer at 36-16 (.692), winning each of their last three...in franchise history, only the 2020 Rays (23-10/.697) have produced a better record in such contests...Tampa Bay is also an MLB-best 20-10 (.667) in games decided by two runs or fewer on the road, including wins in nine of 13 and 13 of its last 18 such games.

The Rays 17-9 (.654) mark in one-run games ranks second behind the Mets (20-10/.667)...their bullpen has pitched to a 2.24 ERA (104.1IP, 26ER) in one-run contests.

NORTH OF THE BORDER—The Rays and Blue Jays conclude the third of four series in 2024 today...the clubs split a season-opening four-game set at Tropicana Field from March 28-31 before the Rays took two of three in Toronto from May 17-19...the Rays have won six straight season series over the Jays since 2018, going 65-43 (.602) in that span, the best mark against Toronto by any AL club...currently leading 5-4, they need at least split the final four meetings to secure a seventh consecutive season series win...the Rays are 7-4 in their last 11 and 12-8 in their previous 20 games against the Jays.

CONNECTIONS

- Rays Manager **Kevin Cash** began his MLB playing career with the Blue Jays from 2002-04...he was also a major league advance scout for Toronto in 2012.
- Blue Jays VP, Baseball Strategy **James Click** spent 14 seasons with the Rays from 2005-19, including three as VP, baseball operations...Click served as the Astros GM from 2020-22 before joining Toronto ahead of last season.
- Rays Asst. GM **Carlos Rodriguez** spent four years as a Blue Jays scout before joining the Rays in 2010...during his time with the Jays, he signed **Yan Gomes**, the first Brazilian-born player to reach the major leagues.
- Rays Hitting Coach **Chad Mottola** held the same position with the Toronto in 2013 after five seasons as a Blue Jays minor league coach...during his playing career, he was signed by the Jays three times and was a teammate of **Kevin Cash** with Triple-A Syracuse in 2002.
- Bally Sports Sun announcer **Brian Anderson** made his MLB debut at Rogers Centre (then SkyDome) on Sept. 10, 1993 in relief for the Angels...the first batter he faced was Hall of Famer **Paul Molitor**.
- Richie Palacios'** brother, **Joshua**, was drafted by Toronto in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft and made his debut with the Blue Jays in 2021 at Rogers Centre.
- Blue Jays OF **Kevin Kiermaier** spent 10 seasons with the Rays from 2013-22, winning three Gold Glove awards and one Platinum Glove...his 31.7 bWAR with the Rays rank fourth club history.
- Blue Jays LHP **Génesis Cabrera** spent nearly five seasons in the Rays system before being dealt to the Cardinals at the 2018 trade deadline as part of a package the Rays used to acquire OF **Tommy Pham**...he was traded to the Blue Jays in mid-July last season.
- Toronto INF **Bo Bichette** (Orlando) and RHP **Nate Pearson** (Odessa) hail from the Sunshine State.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will toe the rubber for his 14th start, including his sixth on the road...leads the majors with a 0.92 ERA (49.0IP, 5ER) since June 8...has a 0.35 ERA (25.2IP, 1ER) in his last four outings...is on a 17.0 scoreless inning streak...the Rays have won six of his last seven starts...is on a career-high four-decision winning streak...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before his May 10 reinstatement.

LAST TIME OUT—He matched a career-high with 7.0 IP in a 9-1 road win over the Yankees on July 20 (W, 7.0IP, 1H, 0R, 2BB, 5SO)...his only hit allowed was a leadoff double by **Ben Rice**...Bradley became the first visiting pitcher to throw 7.0+ scoreless innings on one hit or fewer at Yankee Stadium since **Jameson Taillon** on July 7, 2023...was the first Ray to do so at Yankee Stadium and the second overall, joining **Erasmus Ramirez** on Sept. 14, 2015 at Tropicana Field (7.2IP, 1H, 0R, 2BB, 6SO).

TAJ IN TORONTO—He has made four career appearances (2GS) against Toronto, all coming last season...posted an 8.31 ERA (13.0IP, 12ER) in those outings...both appearances at Rogers Centre came out of the bullpen (Sept. 29 & Oct. 1).

BEST OF THE BEST—Over his last eight starts since June 8, Bradley is 4-1 with a majors-best 0.92 ERA (49.0IP, 5ER), ranking among MLB leaders over that span in opp. SLG (1st, .240), opp. OPS (1st, .484), opp. average (3rd, .170), strikeouts (T4th, 58), opp. OBP (6th, .245) and WHIP (6th, 0.94)...the 0.92 ERA is second lowest by a Ray over an eight-start span in franchise history, trailing only **Chris Archer's** 0.84 ERA (53.1IP, 5ER) from Sept. 14, 2014-April 26, 2015...the lowest ERA over a nine-start stretch in club history (excl. openers) belongs to **Blake Snell**, who posted a 1.03 ERA (52.2IP, 6ER) from Aug. 10-Sept. 23, 2018.

- ✦ He has allowed 2 ER or fewer in all eight outings, becoming the first Rays starter to work 5.0+ IP and allow 2 ER or fewer in eight straight starts since **Shane McCannahan** (8GS) from March 30-May 8, 2023 (excl. multi-season streaks)...McCannahan was also the last to do so in nine straight starts in a single season (14GS: May 5-July 26, 2022).
- ✦ Bradley's streak is the longest active run in the majors...three pitchers in MLB have thrown 5.0+ IP and allowed 2 ER or fewer in nine straight starts: **SEA Luis Castillo** (10GS) and **CWS Garrett Crochet/SD Matt Waldron** (both 9GS).
- ✦ Excluding his outings on May 20 vs. Boston (5ER) and June 1 at Baltimore (9ER), Bradley has pitched to a 1.11 ERA (65.0IP, 8ER) across his other 12 starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN—Bradley has pitched to a 1.42 ERA (19.0IP, 3ER) over his last three road starts, all of which were quality...he joins **Ryan Pepiot** (April 7-June 4) as the only Rays to throw three consecutive quality starts on the road this season...the last Tampa Bay hurler to throw four straight quality starts on the road was **Zach Eflin** (4GS, Aug. 1-Sept. 15, 2023).

RARE COMPANY—Bradley is the 10th pitcher (12th instance) in franchise history to throw 7.0+ scoreless innings in back-to-back starts, including the first since **Charlie Morton** from June 5-10, 2019...no pitcher in club history has done so in three straight starts.

- ✦ He is riding a 17.0 inning scoreless streak, the longest active run among MLB starters.
- ✦ In his last start, he became the fifth pitcher in his age 23 season or younger to throw 7.0+ scoreless innings and allow one hit or fewer at Yankee Stadium, joining **BAL Jim Palmer** (May 12, 1967), **BOS Billy Rohr** (April 14, 1967), **PHA Eddie Smith** (Sept. 29, 1937-G2) and **PHA Ruben Bressler** (Aug. 16, 1915).

RIGHT ON—Over his last five starts, Bradley has limited right-handed hitters to a 4-for-45 (.089) clip with four walks, 15 SO and no extra-base hits...lefties are 12-for-61 (.197) in that span...min. 100 AB, his .160 (19-for-119) opp. average against righties on the season is third in the AL/sixth in the majors, trailing **MIA Tanner Scott** (.140), **NYN Luis Gil** (.149), **TEX José Leclerc** (.150), **PHI Zack Wheeler** (.153) and **MIL Bryan Hudson** (.154).

- ✦ Bradley has limited righties to a .188 (9-for-48) average on his four-seam fastball compared to a .314 (22-for-70) mark vs. lefties.

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—Bradley's 218 SO as a starter are the most in club history through a pitcher's first 34 career starts, outpacing **Shane McCannahan** (215SO)...since 2021, only **ATL Spencer Strider** (292), **CIN Hunter Greene** (233) and **CIN Nick Lodolo** (227) have more punchouts through their first 34 starts in all of MLB.
