Third

Atlanta's loss last night dropped the Braves' one-half game behind the Mets and into third place in the NL East standings.

The club is in third for the first time since after play on May 23, 2022, 769 days ago.

Atlanta played 382 straight games sitting either first or second in the division prior to this afternoon.

The Mets (55-48) and Braves (54-48) trail the Phillies (64-39) in the division by 9.0 and 9.5 games, respectively.

Despite sitting third in the division, Atlanta owns the fifth-best record in the NL.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Mets today continue a four-game weekend series with what is the ninth of 13 total games between the teams this season... The two meet for the final time for a three-game set at Truist Park in Atlanta, September 24-26, in the Braves final homestand of the season.

A The Braves have lost each of the first two games of this series and are just 3-5 in eight total games versus New York this year...New York was the first team to take a series from Atlanta this season, winning two-of-three games at Truist Park in April.

A Atlanta went 10-3 in 13 games with New York last season, a .769 winning percentage...Since the Mets were founded in 1962, the best single-season winning percentage the Braves have logged against New York is .778, going 14-4 in 18 games with the Mets in both 1964 and 1966.

A The Braves have won 19 of the last 28 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 172-120 (+52) over the stretch.

A The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for six consecutive seasons...Prior to last year's 10-3 mark, they went 10-9 in both 2022 & 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 64-43 (.598) against New York overall.

A The Braves won the first series between the clubs at Citi Field this season, two-games-to-one... Atlanta went 5-2 against New York here last season, including a 21-3 victory in the first game of a doubleheader here, August 12.

A RH Tylor Megill is set today to make the ninth start and 10th total appearance against Atlanta in his career, and is 1-3 with a 4.79 ERA (22 ER/41.1 IP) over his first nine appearances...He made his major league debut against Atlanta in 2021, and has faced the Braves more than any other team in his career...The 6-foot-7, 230-pound right-hander has lost each of his last three decisions to the Braves dating to 2022, going 0-3 with a 6.65 ERA (16 ER/21.2 IP) in five games, four starts.

LOSS: Atlanta jumped out to a two-run lead in the second inning, but allowed seven runs in the third and ultimately fell to New York, 8-4...The Braves have scored first in each of the two games of this series before losing.

A Entering the set, Atlanta was 37-16 when scoring the first run of a game this year.

A The seven runs allowed by the Braves in the third inning match their most in a single frame this season...The Nationals also scored seven in the bottom of the fourth on June 9 in D.C.

A New York clubbed three home runs in the third last night, the first three-homer inning allowed by Atlanta pitching this year and the first such inning of Charlie Morton's career...The Braves had not allowed three homers in an inning since September 14, 2020 at Baltimore.

SPENCER SCHWELLENBACH: The right-hander today makes the 10th start of his major league career and his first against New York...A native of Saginaw, MI, Schwellenbach is 3-5 with a 4.62 ERA (26 ER/50.2 IP) over his first nine starts in the majors.

A Atlanta has scored just 24 total runs in his nine starts, an average of just 2.7 runs per game...The Braves have won each of the two games in which they score more than four runs in his starts.

A The right-hander has completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his last three starts, and is 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) this month...He has four starts this season of at least 6.0 innings and no more than two runs allowed, the most through nine starts for Atlanta since Michael Soroka in 2019.

A Schwellenbach ranks in the 90th percentile or better across all pitchers in baseball in chase percentage (98th, 35.8%), walk percentage (93rd, 4.7%) and barrel percentage (90th, 4.7%)...He has issued just 10 walks and allowed just seven barrels through his nine games.

A His slider has averaged 40.0 inches of vertical drop, which is 5.6 inches and 16% better than the average.

SIX STRAIGHT: Atlanta's loss last night was its sixth consecutive defeat, the club's longest losing streak of the season and the longest active skid in the National League...The Chicago White Sox have lost 12 straight games.

A The losing run is the longest for Atlanta since also losing six straight, September 25 to September 30, 2017...The Braves' run of consecutive NL East division titles began the next year.

A Atlanta has not dropped seven straight games since August of 2016.

A The Braves have batted .223/.284/.376 during the skid, and seven of the eight home runs have come in two of the six games...Atlanta is 6-for-35 (.171) with runners in scoring position during the draught, with all six hits being singles.

A On the mound during the skid, Atlanta has a 5.87 ERA (35 ER/53.2) and has surrendered 13 homers and 39 total runs.

ADAM DUVAL: Drove in three of Atlanta's four runs last night, going 2-for-4 with a pair of home runs...It was his first multi-homer game of the season.

A The two drives give Duvall 10 homers on the season, the ninth double-digit homer season of his career...He has hit at least 10 homers in each season since 2016.

A Four of Duvall's 10 homers on the season have come in his last 13 games dating to July 7, during which he has batted .250/.278/.519 with eight RBI.

A His first homer last night came off of right-hander Kodai Senga, and Duvall is 12-for-49 (.245) against right-handers this year, he totaled just 14 hits (.114).

Today's Game

- Scheduled to make his 10th career start and first against New York (NL).
- After nine career starts, Schwellenbach ranks fifth among rookies in Braves franchise history with 49 strikeouts through their first 10 games...Sean Newcomb and Michael Soroka rank third and fourth respectively with 55 and 52 punchouts.
- Struckout a career-most eight hitters in his last start against St. Louis.
- Pitching to a 2.84 ERA and averaging 6.1 innings pitched over his last three starts.
- Has surrendered a combined 11 runs in the fifth inning of his nine outings this season with Atlanta for a 11.42 ERA (11 ER/8.2 IP) in that frame.
 - Pitching to a 3.21 ERA (15 ER/42.0 IP) in all other innings with the Braves this season.
- Producing a 35.8% chase rate through his first nine career starts.
 - The leader among qualifiers is Christopher Sánchez with a chase rate of 34.9%.
- Throwing strikes on 70.7% of his pitches.
 - The leader among qualifiers is again Tarik Skubal with a strike rate of 70.0%.
- Earned the first win of his career against Detroit on June 18, holding the Tigers to three hits and fanning seven hitters over 6.0 innings of one-run ball.
 - Became the first Braves pitcher in franchise history to make three starts through his first four career appearances against American League opponents.
 - Became the 14th Atlanta rookie to hold an opponent to three hits or less over 6.0 innings without allowing more than one run in one of their first four outings.
- Faced Baltimore on June 12 in his third career start.
 - Schwellenbach joined Charlie Morton and Ian Anderson as the only Braves pitchers in franchise history to make two of their first three career appearances as starters against American League opponents...He will become just the second hurler to face two AL East opponents in that span.

- Ian Anderson made his first two career starts against Boston and New York (AL) in 2020, while Charlie Morton pitched against Texas and Los Angeles (AL) in his first two outings in 2008.
- Joined Ian Anderson (2020) and Kyle Davies (2005) as the only Braves pitchers in franchise history to make one of their first two career starts in Fenway Park.
- Made his major league debut on May 29 against the Nationals...went 5.0 innings allowing five hits, three runs, one walk and striking out five Washington hitters.
 - Became just the ninth pitcher in Braves franchise history to debut against the Nationals.
- Made his debut at age 23 years and 364 days, becoming the youngest starter to debut for Atlanta since AJ Smith-Shawver last season on June 4...Teammate Hurston Waldrep became the youngest pitcher to make their first start shortly after debuting at 22 years and 100 days.
 - He was the sixth youngest starter to debut this season at the time of his start.
- Pitched 13.0 scoreless innings in two starts with Double-A Mississippi while recording 17 strikeouts and issuing just one walk, earning the win in both games.
 - Held hitters to a .122 batting average.
- Made six starts for High-A Rome and went 2-1 with a 2.53 ERA this season.
 - It would rank as the third lowest ERA among qualified starters in the South Atlantic League.

2023 Recap

- Completed his first professional season and went 5-2 with a 2.49 ERA (18 ER/65.0 IP) in 16 games, all starts between Single-A Augusta and High-A Rome.
 - Finished 4-2 with a 2.63 ERA and 41 strikeouts in 13 starts with the GreenJackets.
 - Went 1-0 with a 1.98 ERA and 14 strikeouts in three starts with the Emperors.

Amateur

- Selected by the Braves in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Nebraska.
 - Missed the 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, he was named the Big Ten Player of the Year and the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year.
 - Was also a Golden Spikes Award Semifinalist, ABCA/Rawlings First-Team All-American, D1 Baseball First-Team All-American, Baseball America Second-Team All-American and Collegiate Baseball Second-Team All-American.
 - Played shortstop in 48 games for the Cornhuskers while hitting .284 with 40 RBI, six home runs and nine stolen bases.
 - Went 3-1 with 10 saves and a 0.57 ERA (2 ER/31.2 IP) in 18 relief appearances

Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 30 yrs • #49

Saves/Opp: 0/2 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 36/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 16/6

- **Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...He's the only pitcher in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed.**
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 58% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 95th percentile.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 33/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/3

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .068 (3-for-44) off him, which is best in Major League Baseball (min. 40 BF with RISP).**
- Just three of Chavez's 17 inherited runners have scored, the sixth-best percentage (17.6%) in the National League (min. 15 IR).
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.80) ranks seventh behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63), Mike Remlinger (2.74) and Luis Avilán (2.77).
- By Run Value, Chavez second most valuable cutter (13 RV, tied) in baseball among both starters and relievers... Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 16) is the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 52% of his offerings.
- Among the 31 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older (min. 10 games), Chavez owns the second-best ERA in the National League and third-best in MLB (1.83)...Texas' Kirby Yates (1.21) and Los Angeles' Daniel Hudson (1.49) are the only players to lead him in that regard.
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,020 strikeouts rank sixth.
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.11 ERA (39 ER/166.2 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)...Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).

Jimmy Herget • RHP • 6-3 • 170 • 30 yrs

- This morning was reinstated off the injured list after missing 41 games with right shoulder inflammation.
- At Triple-A, across 16 games and two organizations, has posted a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP)...Has struck out 14 against only two walks (4.67 K/BB).
- On May 2, was acquired from the Los Angeles Angels in exchange for cash considerations.
- At the major league level, has pitched for Cincinnati (2019), Texas (2020-'21) and the Los Angeles Angels (2021-'23).
- Was drafted by Atlanta in the 40th round of the 2012 draft, but did not sign...Signed with Cincinnati in 2015 after being selected in the sixth round.

Grant Holmes • RHP • 6-0 • 226 • 28 yrs • #66

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 10/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- On June 16, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two strikeouts and no walks in his major league debut...Holmes is just the second Brave to pitch to those parameters in his major league debut in the Atlanta era (since 1966)... He joined Manny Bañuelos, who did it in a starting nod on July 2, 2015...Just three other pitchers have done it in franchise history.
- Among International League pitchers, his 2.63 ERA ranked fourth at the time of his call-up (min. 40 IP).
- Signed with the Braves organization as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
- Was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 MLB draft...Was traded to the Oakland Athletics on August 1, 2016, along with Frankie Montas and Jharel Cotton in exchange for Rich Hill and Josh Reddick...Holmes was released by Oakland on July 28, 2022.

Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #26

Saves/Opp: 22/24 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 38/30 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/0

- Among pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (122 apps.), Iglesias' 1.96 ERA (26 ER/119.2 IP) is the best in Major League Baseball.
- Iglesias is one of five active pitchers with at least 500 games pitched and a sub-3.00 ERA.
- Has made 502 career pitching appearances.
- Has converted 14 consecutive save opportunities, the fifth-longest active streak in MLB (tied).
- Ranks fourth in the National League and sixth in the majors with 22 saves.
- Has 212 career saves, fifth most among active pitchers.
- Since 2017, his 447 appearances rank fourth in the majors.
- Was named National League Reliever of the month for August 2023 after he pitched 13 scoreless appearances within the month...In 13.0 innings, struck out 17, walked four and allowed only seven hits.

Joe Jiménez • RHP • 6-3 • 277 • 29 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 18 **1st Batter/Retired:** 40/29 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/0

- **Owens the second-best Expected ERA in the National League (min. 1.25 BF/G) and the fifth-best in MLB (2.33).**
- On June 12 allowed his first barreled ball of the season season (Statcast)...Was the only pitcher in Major League Baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed.
