NATIONALS NEWS

ONE MORE FOR THE ROAD
The Nationals will take on the Giants in the last of a three-game series at Oracle Park on Wednesday...It will also be the final game of a six-game road trip...Washington took game two of the series last night, 6-3, to clinch their fifth road series win in a row.

- **Luis Garcia Jr.** (1-for-3, HR, 2 RBI, R) hit a two-run home run in the first inning...**Daylen Life** (1-for-2, 3B, 2 RBI, 2 BB) hit his second triple of the year and also knocked in a pair.
- **Brad Lord** improved to 4-0 with 2.2 innings of scoreless relief.
- Following today's game, the Nationals will head back to Washington to enjoy an off day on Thursday before they begin a six-game homestand with the Mariners (Fri-Sun) and Royals (Mon-Wed).

YOU PLAY TO WIN THE GAME
Washington has won five consecutive road series, the longest streak by the Nationals since Aug.-Sept. 2014...With a win today, the Nationals would win their fifth straight game at Oracle Park dating back to Aug. 9, 2025...That would be the longest win streak the Nationals have ever had in San Francisco (Won four games in a row in SF two previous times, most recently from April 25, 2018 - Aug. 8, 2019)...A win would also secure the Nationals first sweep in San Francisco since Aug. 5-7, 2019...Washington is 10-4 since 2022 at Oracle Park.

- The Nationals are 23-13 (.639) on the road this season...Washington's 23 wins on the road are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Braves (23)...The .639 winning percentage ranks third-best.
- Overall, the Nationals are 24-17 (.585) since April 25...Washington has won 10 of its 15 series over this stretch and has lost just two series since May 2.

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS
All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams has reached base safely in 13 of the last 15 games...He has two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, two hit by pitches, six walks, three stolen bases and 10 runs scored during that span.
- Wood has reached base safely in 22 of his last 24 games, hitting .341/.455/.549 with four doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI, 18 walks, one hit by pitch and 24 runs scored during that stretch...Wood is also just one of two players in Major League Baseball this season with at least 15 home runs and 10 stolen bases...CJ Abrams is one home run shy of joining Wood and **Jordan Walker** on that list.
- Wood has produced 17 home runs and 12 stolen bases through his first 68 games of the season...The only two players in Franchise history (MON/WSH) to match those numbers through their first 70 games of the year were **Alfonso Soriano** in 2006 (24 HR, 17 SB) and Hall of Famer **Andre Dawson** in 1981 (19 HR, 22 SB).

MAKING THEIR PITCH
Simon Mathews' pitching staff ranks fourth in Major League Baseball (second in the National League) with a 3.31 ERA in 20 games since May 19...They are 12-8 during that stretch and have secured nine saves, tied for second-most in MLB.

- **Zach Littell** has won his last five games pitching to a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP)...He had held opponents to a .188 average over that span...His five-game winning streak is the first by a Nationals pitcher since **Stephen Strasburg** earned the win in a Nationals record (2005-pres.) seven straight games from June 21-July 28, 2019.
- **Brad Lord** (6 games, 1 ER, 14.0 IP, 0.64 ERA), **Orlando Ribalta** (9 games, 2 ER, 9.1 IP, 1.93 ERA) and **Paxton Schultz** (5 games, 1 ER, 6.1 IP, 1.42 ERA) have all yielded just two earned runs or less in relief since May 19.

BACKSTOP BATS
Drew Millas and **Keibert Ruiz** have been the most productive offense catching tandem in Major League Baseball since May 6...Combined, they rank among all MLB catching groups in OPS (1st, .920), batting average (1st, .306), RBI (T1st, 24) and hits (1st, 34), home runs (T4th, 6).

- Ruiz has hit safely in 15 of his last 19 games, going 24-for-65 (.369) with nine doubles, four homers, 18 RBI, three walks, one stolen base and 13 runs scored.
- On the season, Ruiz is tied for first among Major League catchers with 14 doubles and fourth among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in slugging percentage (6th, .496).

VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE
Since May 6, Washington's offense ranks first in runs scored (179), RBI (173) and in home runs (50) and second in slugging percentage (.458) and doubles (59).

- Washington has scored 53 runs in the first inning this season, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have also scored 133 runs in the seventh inning or later this year, also the most in MLB.
- The Nationals recorded at least one extra-base hit in 32 straight games from April 29-June 2, the fourth-longest active streak in baseball behind San Francisco (36), Pittsburgh (34) and Chicago White Sox (33) at that time.

THIS AND THAT
Some notable notes about other Nationals players:

- **Daylen Life** is tied for second among National League outfielders with 15 doubles.
- **Nasim Nuñez** is tied for the lead in Major League Baseball in stolen bases (23).

CAREER

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

LAST START

Griffin tossed 5.0 innings and allowed just one run on two hits at Arizona on June 5...He earned his seventh win of the season in the 14-2 win at Chase Field.

LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .173 batting average (13-for-75) with 22 strikeouts and just six walks...His four-seam fastball (.071), sweep (.182) and sinker (.167) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year.

- In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he ranks among qualified National League rookie pitchers in wins (1st, 7), starts (1st, 13), WHIP (2nd, 1.10), innings pitched (3rd, 72.0), strikeouts (13rd, 69) and opponents' average (3rd, .216).

GRIFFIN'S GLOVE

Griffin has two defensive runs saved and two runs saved above average according to FanGraphs.com, second-most among National League pitchers.

BACK IN THE STATES, BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

Griffin earned his first Major League win as a starter in his first career start on March 30 at Philadelphia...He threw 5.0 innings allowing just two earned runs on five hits with five strikeouts and no walks.

- It was his first Major League appearance since Sept. 22, 2022 at Tampa Bay and first Major League start after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball

WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.

- Recorded a 0.61 ERA (4 ER/59.0 IP) in nine starts from May 17 to July 12, 2025.
- Tossed 8.2 scoreless innings on June 15, 2024 at Nippon (5 H, 9 SO, 2 BB).
- Struck out 12 batters twice in 2024, both against Hiroshima: June 29 and Aug. 7.
