WEDNESDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Twins, 4-2, on Cedric Mullins' first career walk-off home run in the ninth inning...The game started with a leadoff home run by **Gunnar** Henderson, marking the fourth time since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954 that the O's hit both a leadoff and walk-off home run in the same game, and first since May 23, 2000 vs. Seattle (see box at right); the last MLB team to do so was the Oakland A's on May 12, 2023 vs. Texas, when Esteury Ruiz hit the leadoff homer and Brent Rooker walked it off...Marked Baltimore's third walk-off win of the season, joining James McCann's single on April 3 and Jordan Westburg's home run on April 1, both against Kansas City. *θ*<sup>\*</sup> The win clinched Baltimore's second sweep of the season, first sweep of the Twins

- since a three-game set at Target Field from July 7-9, 2023, and first sweep of the Twins at Oriole Park since a three-game set from April 4-7, 2016.
- The O's have won seven in a row against the Twins, tied for their longest active winning streak against a single opponent (Nationals). 0.

HOMER HAPPY: Bird batters have hit at least three home runs in five consecutive games for the first time since August 6-10, 1996...Marks the longest such streak in MLB since the Braves did so in five straight from June 11-15, 2022...The O's are one game shy of tying the MLB record of six straight games with at least three homers set by the 1987 Orioles. *θ*<sub>\*</sub> Entering today's games, the Orioles lead MLB with 30 home runs, the most through

- the first 18 games of a season in club history (since 1954); the most homers through the first 19 games is 31 by the 1966 club.
- Gunnar Henderson has homered in three straight games for the second time in his O. career, joining June 10-13, 2023; the last Oriole to homer in four straight games was DJ Stewart from September 5-9, 2020.

<u>COMEBACK KIDS</u>: Eight of the Orioles' 12 wins this season, including five of their last seven, have been in comeback fashion, the most in MLB...Baltimore's 56 comeback wins since the start of last season are the most in MLB...Their 92 come-from-behind victories since the start of 2022 are also the most in MLB.

RUN IT UP: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank fifth in MLB with 104 runs scored...Their +27 run differential is third in the AL and fourth in MLB.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT: The Orioles are slashing .182/.234/.354 (57-for-314) in two-strike counts...They lead MLB in slugging, home runs (13), and extra-base hits (27) with two strikes, and lead the AL in OPS (.587)...**Jordan Westburg** has hit .367/.406/.767 (11-for-30) in two-strike counts, with three doubles and three home runs...He leads MLB in two-strike slugging percentage, and leads the AL in two-strike average and OPS (1.173).

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Colton Cowser was selected as the AL Player of the Week for the period of April 8-14 after slashing .435/.481/1.130 (10-for-23) with four doubles, four home runs, six runs scored, 12 RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games...During that time, he led MLB in slugging, OPS (1.611), extra-base hits (8), total bases (26), and RBI... He led the AL in homers, ranked tied for the lead in doubles, and ranked among the leaders in hits (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), runs (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), and average (4<sup>th</sup>)...Marks the first career honor for Cowser, who is the first O's player to win the award since **Gunnar Henderson** for the week of June 5-11, 2023...Each of the last three Orioles to win Player of the Week have been rookies, including Cowser, Henderson and **Ryan Mountcastle** in 2021.

KIMBREL COUNT: Craig Kimbrel recorded the 421st save of his career Monday night against Minnesota, one behind Billy Wagner for seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (424) has more among active players...Kimbrel now has 1,206 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1.225).

**STRIKE A POSE:** Baltimore pitchers have fanned 167 batters so far in 2024, the most strikeouts through 18 games in O's history...The total would also be the most through the first 19 games, surpassing the previous mark of 163 by the 2023 team.  $\partial_r$  The Birds have an MLB-best 4.18 strikeout-to-walk ratio; since the mound moved

back in 1893, the best K/BB in a full season is 3.98 by the 2017 Cleveland Indians

<u>O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO:</u> The Birds begin a six-game road trip against the Royals (3 G) and Angels (3 G)...The Orioles have a scheduled off day after the trip on Thursday, April 25...The O's wrapped up their first road trip of the season with a 4-2 record against Pittsburgh (1-2) and Boston (3-0) from April 5-11.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: The O's and Royals are meeting for the second and final series of the regular season in Kansas City this weekend...The Birds took two out of three against the Royals in Baltimore from April 1-3, including two walk-off wins...The O's went 5-1 against the Royals last year; they took two out of three at Kauffman Stadium from May 2-4 before completing a three-game sweep in Baltimore from June 9-11.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 97 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)... Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).  $\partial_{x}$  The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full

regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award... He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 327 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver (1.480)

**<u>QUICK HITS</u>**: Scheduled to make his fourth start and second of the season against the Royals...Made his fourth Opening Day roster...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his

2023 campaign...The O's went 24-8 in his starts and his career-high 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, OF Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the loss, his first decision of the year, on Saturday vs. Milwaukee...Tossed 4.0 innings, allowing eight runs (6 ER) on 10 hits (2 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts; the eight runs surrendered set a career high.

**AGAINST THE ROYALS:** Today will mark Kremer's third career start against the Royals...Faced Kansas City on April 1, 2024 in Baltimore, allowing three runs on three hits (2 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts...Owns a 1-0 record with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in his two prior starts against them.

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Went 0-2 with an 8.31 ERA (16 ER/17.1 IP), allowing a .378/.422/.561 (31-for-82) slash line in four starts against AL Central opponents in 2023...Owns a lifetime 2-5 record with a 5.94 ERA (31 ER/47.0) in 10 career starts against the division

**LIFE ON THE ROAD:** In Kremer's lone start away from Camden Yards this season, he completed 7.0 innings, allowing one run (0 ER) on five hits with six strikeouts on April 7 against the Pirates.

**NIGHT OWL:** In 2023, Kremer posted an 11-3 record with a 3.70 ERA (49 ER/119.1 IP) in 22 night starts, compared to a 2-2 record and 5.06 ERA (30 ER/53.1 IP) in 10 day starts...Opponents own a .263/.319/.418 (262-for-995) slash line off Kremer in 49 evening appearances (48 GS) in his career.

APRIL SHOWERS: In his 13 career starts in the month of April, Kremer has a 6.64 ERA (45 ER/61.0 IP), allowing 80 hits (15 HR) and 17 walks with 57 strikeouts...Opponents are slashing .314/.359/.541(80-for-255), the highest OPS against (.900) in any month; his second-highest OPS against in a month is June at .776.

**<u>GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS</u>:** Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...He went 8-4 with a 5.04 ERA (51 ER/91.0 IP) and seven quality starts in his first 17 starts to open the year, allowing 105 hits (19 HR) and 24 walks with 82 strikeouts.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Earned the win on September 28 vs. Boston, clinching the AL East...Collected his 300<sup>th</sup> career strikeout on September 17 vs. Tampa Bay, matching Chuck Estrada and Daniel Cabrera as the fifth-fastest Orioles by appearances (69) to reach the mark...Logged four straight quality starts from August 10-29, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic; made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12, 2023 at IoanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K).

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Kremer made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS against the Texas Rangers on October 10...Allowed six runs on seven hits and one walk in 1.2 innings...The six earned runs marked the most amount that Kremer had given up in a game since June 30 vs. Minnesota (7 ER...It was

Scheduled to make his fifth start of the season and his fifth career start against Kansas City...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits and two walks with five strikeouts on Sunday vs. Milwaukee...Faced the Royals on April 3, 2024, allowing two runs on nine hits with three strikeouts across 5.2 innings...Became the first pitcher in team history (since 1954) to go 6.0+ innings and allow two hits or fewer in his first three appearances with the team, according to *MLB.com*'s Sarah Langs (<u>@SlangsOnSports</u>)...Went 10-8 with a 3.39 ERA (73 ER/193.2 IP) in 32 starts for the Brewers in 2023.
