TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to even their series with the Reds tonight after dropping the series-opener here in Cincinnati last night 2-1...SF has lost three straight on this road trip, with its only win coming last Friday at Baltimore.

- ▶ SF enters this series five games under .500 at 6-11 (.353) through 17 games...it's tied with five other instances as the team's worst start to a season through 17 games since the year 2000 (also 2023, 2017, 2008, 2004 and 2000).
- ▶ The Giants have won each of their last two series here at GABP dating to 2024 and are 3-1-1 in their last five series here dating to 2021 with the only series loss coming in 2022.

JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: MLB celebrates the life and legacy of Jackie Robinson today on what is the 79th anniversary of his Dodger debut.

- ▶ All on-field personnel will don the number 42 in Dodger Blue on their uniform (regardless of their primary team colors)...teams and umpires will also have "42" patches on the side of their caps.
- ▶ The recognition also includes commemorative base jewels, lineup cards and "Breaking Barriers" batting practice shirts.



ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves today:

- ▶ **OF Drew Gilbert** (#42) and **OF Will Brennan** (#42) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Jared Oliva** (left wrist hamate fracture) and **OF Harrison Bader** (left hamstring strain) were both placed on the 10-day injured list...Bader's placement is retroactive to April 12.

MAHLE TIME: RHP Tyler Mahle makes his fourth start of the season, this time being against the team that drafted him...he was originally selected in the seventh round of the 2013 MLB Draft by the Reds out of Westminster (CA) High School...the veteran pitched six seasons with the Reds (2017-2022), going 31-38 with a 4.35 ERA and 637 strikeouts in 114 games (113 starts)...he has a career 5.02 ERA at Great American Ball Park in 55 games (54 starts) and is pitching in this ballpark tonight for the first time as a visitor.

- ▶ Mahle had a strong last outing, striking out six while allowing three hits and four walks over 5.2 shutout innings vs. the Phillies on April 8.
- ▶ His four-seamer has a usage rate of 50.9% with a .400 batting average thus far (8x20)...the Reds have a .203 batting average vs. four-seamers this season, 28th in MLB.

HIT OR MISS...: After a four-game stretch where SF had an uptick offensively (21 runs on 45 hits last Monday-Friday), SF has scored five runs on 24 hits over its last three games.

- ▶ The Giants enter today with the lowest runs per game in the Majors (3.06)...they also rank inside MLB's bottom five in on-base percentage (.286, 29th), OPS (.641, 26th), walks (34, 30th) and home runs (nine, 30th).
- ▶ SF's nine homers through its first 17 games this season are its fewest since 2015 (also nine)...the .641 OPS is the team's worst since posting a .572 OPS to start the 2019 season.
- ▶ On the flip side, the Giants .242 team average is 11th-best while their 136 hits are 15th-best in MLB...the team has a .295 BABIP, which is 12th-best in MLB.
- ▶ In six wins this season, the Giants' offense is averaging 6.0 runs per game and slashing .327/.365/.531 (.896 OPS)...in the club's 11 losses, they're averaging 1.45 runs per game and are slashing .190/.237/.250 (.487).

TAKE THE RED PILL: SF has homered in each of its last 13 road games at the Reds beginning with an IF Evan Longoria homer on May 28, 2022...the streak is the Giants' second-longest here in Cincinnati all-time behind a 16-game streak from 1976-1978 (Stats, LLC).

- ▶ The Giants that have homered in that 13-game streak are **IF Willy Adames**, **IF Matt Chapman**, **OF Michael Conforto**, **OF Jerar Encarnacion**, Longoria, **IF Tyler Fitzgerald**, **IF Wilmer Flores**, **OF Heliot Ramos**, **C/OF Blake Sabol**, **IF Casey Schmitt**, **OF Austin Slater** and **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.**

ARRAEZ AND SHINE: **IF Luis Arraez** returned to the lineup yesterday and added three hits...he is batting .333 through his first 16 games this season.

- ▶ Partnered with **IF Willy Adames**, who had a homer out of the leadoff spot last night, the top two hitters in SF's lineup are batting .302, which is best mark in the National League, and second-best in the Majors behind only the Rays (.311).
- ▶ Collectively, SF middle infielders are batting .282, which is tied with Toronto for third-best in MLB behind only Miami (.331) and Atlanta (.321).

TODAY'S STARTER

TYLER MAHLE RHP #42

2026 RECORD: 0-2, 4.30 ERA

WELCOME TO SF: Mahle is in his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5 and will make his first road start of the season tonight.

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his best start as a Giant last Wednesday vs. Philadelphia...tossed 5.2 shutout innings and held batters to just three hits with four walks and six strikeouts...batters were just 1-for-9 with five strikeouts off his splitter...overall, the righty threw 94 pitches in the outing, his most in nearly a year (threw 96 pitches on May 23, 2025 at CWS).

VS. REDS: Will be facing his former team for the first time in his career...Mahle was drafted by the Reds in the seventh round in 2013 out of Westminster High School in Southern California...he made his MLB debut with the club in 2017 and spent parts of six seasons with the Reds from 2017-2022...in 114 games (113 starts), he went 31-38 with a 4.35 ERA.

BINGO!: Entering play today, Mahle has faced all 29 Major League clubs over his 10-year MLB career...his start against the Reds tonight will mark the final club left to face.

HOMECOMING: Mahle is returning to Great American Ball Park for the first time since 2022...he started the game on July 30 for the Reds that season just days before being dealt to the Twins in the trade that brought IF Spencer Steer (among others) to Cincinnati...the right-hander has appeared in 55 games (54 starts) here in Cincy and has gone 13-18 with a 5.02 ERA in those games.

SPRING CLEANING: In four Cactus League starts this spring, Mahle tossed 10.0 scoreless innings with just two hits and 13 strikeouts, going 3-0 in those starts...he also made one exhibition start on March 22 at Triple-A Sacramento, where he gave up just one run on one hit over 5.0 innings of work.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Texas Rangers under the reins of Bruce Bochy...posted a 6-4 record over 16 starts and set career-bests in ERA (2.18), opponents' batting average (.218), opposing OPS (.593) and home runs per nine innings (0.52) (min. 10 starts)...overall, the righty tossed 86.2 innings in the 16 starts with a 1.13 WHIP.

EARLY BIRD: Last season, the right-hander was named the Rangers Player of the Month for March/April after going 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA and 0.98 WHIP in six starts through April...he led all American League pitchers in ERA, opponents' OPS (.465) and slugging percentage (.211) in the first month of the season.

COMING IN HOT: Mahle's hot start carried into May as he sported a 5-1 record with a 1.47 ERA (9er, 55.0ip) and a 0.98 WHIP over his first 10 starts of the 2025 season...he had a 1.64 ERA (12er, 66.0ip) in 12 starts through the end of May.

THE LONG BALL: He began his 2025 campaign by tossing a career-best 40.2 homerless innings, marking the longest homerless streak to start the season among any starter in the Majors last year...the right-hander permitted just five home runs in 86.2 innings all year (0.52 HR/9ip).

BANANA SPLIT: His most valuable pitch last season was his splitter, which he used 27.7% of the time...the pitch had a +5 run value, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

IL STINT: His impressive start to the season was interrupted by a shoulder injury that sidelined him for most of the year...was placed on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder fatigue on June 15 (retro to June 12) and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 1...missed over three months of play and was reinstated on September 18...following his return, he made another two starts, allowing one earned run over 9.2 innings (0.93 ERA).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Mahle's primary pitch is his four-seam fastball, a pitch he threw 49.7% of the time last season...the pitch accounted for over half of his strikeouts last season (35 of 66) and he held batters to a .209 (27x147) with the pitch.

PRESS REWIND: Mahle was selected by the Reds in the seventh round in 2013 out of Westminster High School in Huntington Beach, CA...he's pitched in 142 games (141 starts) over parts of nine seasons in the Majors for Cincinnati (2017-2022), Minnesota (2022-23), and Texas (2024-25)...in those 142 games, the righty has posted a 39-46 record with a 4.07 ERA and 753 strikeouts (9.22 K/9.0ip)...since the 2020 season, Mahle is 28-23 with a 3.61 ERA (190er, 473.1ip) in 90 games (89 starts).

TOMORROW'S STARTER LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

2026 RECORD: 2-1, 3.24 ERA

- ▶ Will be making his second career start against the Reds.
- ▶ Was a tough-luck loser at home the first time he faced the Reds on April 8, 2025 (L, 6.0ip, 7h, er, r, 4k).
- ▶ Earned his second victory of the season his last time out, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing just one run on five hits while striking out four at Baltimore.
- ▶ Has allowed only two home runs across 17 day games in his career (10 starts, 63.0ip) with an ERA of 3.29.

#42 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper
Last Game: 4/11 at BAL; 1.1ip, 3h, r, er, 3k (29 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-12 (.167) with two walks and four strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (69-for-381) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-12 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

#42 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 4/12 at BAL; 1.0ip, h, bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's first 17 games.
- ▶ Has allowed runs in one of his seven games and has issued at least one walk in five of seven contests (seven walks in 8.1ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 7-for-19 (.368) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-10 (.100).
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#42 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter
Last Game: 4/12 at BAL; 0.2ip, h, r, er, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ With his win last Wednesday, at age 33 years and 56 days old, he became the oldest pitcher in the San Francisco era (since 1958) to earn their first career MLB win as a member of the Giants.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's 16 games, tossing 7.1-innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 41.0 innings dating to June 11, 2023, which is the 10th longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#42 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts and four walks in eight games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

#42 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup
Last Game: 4/12 at BAL; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six of SF's 17 games, allowing four runs in 5.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 50.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fifth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#42 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter
Last Game: 4/10 vs. BAL; 1.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, k, hr (18 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL... logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.
- ▶ Went 6-4 with a 3.62 ERA (39er, 97.0ip) with 111 strikeouts over 21 games between Triple-A Sacramento and Triple-A Syracuse.

#42 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's first 17 games.
- ▶ Batters are 2-for-13 in ABs that end with his slider and 4-for-11 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider last season.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.

#42 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip, 2k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Six of his eight appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

#42 WILLY ADAMES ▶ IF

(uh-DAH-mess)

- ▶ Is 11-for-28 (.393) in his last seven games with nine of the 11 hits going for extra-bases (seven doubles, two homers).
- ▶ Overall, 12 of his 18 hits this year have been for extra-bases (nine 2B, three HR)...nine doubles are tied for most in NL (tied for second-most in MLB).
- ▶ Traditionally has been somewhat of a slow starter but his 12 XBH in March/April have surpassed his career-best 11 from March/April 2024 (29 games).
- ▶ His .869 OPS through his first 17 games is the second-best of his career to start a season through 17 games behind a .908 OPS in 2024 w/Milwaukee.
