REMAINING SPRING SLATE: The St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their final weekend of Grapefruit League play and 29th Spring Training in Jupiter (1998-2026) as they travel to West Palm Beach to face the Houston Astros today, the 28th and last Grapefruit League game for the Redbirds.

• St. Louis has won four in a row and seven of its last nine (March 12-present)... With a win today, the Cardinals can match their Grapefruit League win total from 2023 (17-7-5 record).

• The Cardinals break camp and fly to Springfield, Mo., tomorrow to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field ... First pitch is 6:05 p.m. CT.

• In four days, the Cardinals open their 135th season of play in the National League by hosting the Tampa Bay Rays on Thursday, March 26, the earliest Opening Day in franchise history ... St. Louis played on March 27 last season vs. Minnesota, a 5-3 Redbirds winner at Busch Stadium.

BIRDS ONE OF THE BEST IN ABS: According to *Baseball Savant*, the Cardinals are an MLB-best 75% (27-9) in successful overruns as a fielding team in MLB's Automated Ball-Strike (ABS) Challenge System this Spring.

• Catcher **Pedro Pagés** is a perfect 8-0 in challenges, best of any backstop with 8+ challenge opportunities.

• Overall as a challenging batting team this Spring, St. Louis is 12-12 (50%), tied for 8th-best in MLB.

100: **Masyn Winn** was named the 2025 winner of the Rawlings Gold Glove Award at shortstop, the first of his career and the 100th by the Cardinals - the most all-time for any MLB franchise since the award's inception in 1957 ... Winn joined **Ozzie Smith** (11 times), **Édgar Rentería** (2), and **Dal Maxvill** (1) as the fourth Cardinals shortstop to win the award.

PLAYERS USED: The Cardinals enter today with 107 different players appearing in a Grapefruit League game (64 position players and 43 pitchers) ... Of the 107 players, 47 were minor league campers (35 position players and 12 pitchers).

• Those in Major League camp to never appear include outfielder **Last Nootbaar** and pitchers **Hunter Dobbins**, **Ixan Henderson**, **Pete Hansen**, **Cooper Hjerpe**, **Tekoah Roby**, and **Zack Thompson**.

GRACEFFO OPTIONED: Yesterday, the Cardinals reduced the Spring Training roster to 34 players, optioning RHP **Gordon Graceffo** to Memphis (AAA).

LIBBY TO START OPENING DAY: LHP **Matthew Liberatore** was named the Cardinals Opening Day starter vs. Tampa Bay on March 26 at Busch Stadium.

• The 26-year-old Liberatore will become one of just 16 left-handers to make an Opening Day start for St. Louis (since 1901) and the first since **Donovan Osborne** on April 5, 1999 vs. Milwaukee, the same year Libby was born.

• The last Cardinals Opening Day lefty starter to be credited with a win was **John Tudor** in a 9-3 win over the Cubs on April 7, 1987 at Wrigley Field.

• Libby will be facing his drafting team, the Tampa Bay Rays (1st round, 2018), for the 3rd time in his career and for the 2nd time at Busch ... The southpaw pitched arguably his finest career outing against the Rays at Tropicana Field (Aug. 10, 2023) firing a career-high 8.0 scoreless IP of two-hit ball with a season-high seven strikeouts in a 5-2 win.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#36 MICHAEL McGREEVY · RHP · 6-4 · 230 LBS · AGE 25

- Is scheduled to start Game 2 of the regular season on March 28 against Tampa Bay.
- Cardinals 1st round pick in 2021 made his Major League debut vs. Texas on July 31, 2024, throwing 7.0 innings and allowing one run in a 10-1 victory.
- Has 11 wins in his first 21 Major League games, 6th Cardinals pitcher to achieve that mark and first since Luis Arroyo in 1955. Jack Harper set the franchise record with 14 wins in 1901. Bobby Miller of the Dodgers was the last in MLB with 11 (2023).
- His .769 win percentage Post All-Star Break over the past two seasons (2024-25) is the best among starting pitchers. His 7 wins post All-Star Break ranked T-5th among Major League pitchers. Most by a Cardinals pitcher since Adam Wainwright went 10-2 post All-Star Break in 2021.
- Ranked among N.L. rookies in 2025 Wins (8, T-2nd), Innings Pitched (95.2, 6th) and Games Started (16, 6th)
- Combined to make 31 starts over 32 appearances between St. Louis and Memphis (AAA) in 2025. Hurlled a career-high 170.2 innings and won 16 games.
- Was recalled five times to St. Louis during the season including once as the 27th player in a doubleheader (6/19 at CWS).

#44 GORDON GRACEFFO · RHP · 6-2 · 235 LBS · AGE 25

- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2026 World Baseball Classic.
- Made his Major League debut June 29, 2024 vs. Cincinnati in which he pitched 4.1 innings, the longest relief outing by a Cardinals rookie since Angel Rondón (5.0 IP on May 22, 2022 at Pittsburgh) the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in his MLB debut since John Martin in 1980, who threw 7.0 innings on Aug. 27, 1980 vs. Philadelphia.
- Earned his first career MLB win (4/30 at CIN), 2nd MLB win (5/5 vs. PIT) and first MLB save (5/6 vs. PIT) in 2025, becoming the 14th Cardinals pitcher with two wins and a save within his first three appearances of a season, and the first to do so since John Gant in 2019.
- Became the 6th Villanova alum to appear for the Cardinals, joining LHP/OF Mike O'Neill (1901-04), OF Ernie Lush (1910), C Mike Murphy (1912), 1B/PH Mike Pasquella (1919), and INF Steve Huntz (1967, '69).

#58 CHRIS ROYCROFT · RHP · 6-7 · 245 LBS · AGE 28

- Signed by the Cardinals as a minor league free agent, two days after his 25th birthday, following pitching two seasons with the independent Joliet Slammers of the Frontier League, the local team near his hometown and college.
- Struck out Francisco Lindor (swinging) for his first Major League strikeout. Surrendered a home run to two-time All-Star Game Home Run Derby Winner, Pete Alonso, as the next batter, challenging him on a 1-2 pitch.
- At 6-foot-7, is the tallest to appear for St. Louis since pitchers Adam Wainwright (6-7) and Andrew Miller (6-7). Only minor league pitchers D.J. Carpenter (6-8) and Reiner López (6-8) are taller in the organization.
- Climbed three levels during the 2023 season from Peoria (High-A) to Memphis (AAA) before making his Major League debut in 2024.
- In 2024, profiled the lowest hard-hit percentage (exit velocity of 95 MPH or more) on four-seam fastballs (13.0%) of pitchers facing 40 or more batters.
- Was selected to his first Opening Day roster in 2025 and retired the side (9-1-2) in order with a strikeout for a Hold vs. Minnesota (March 27).
- Won the clubhouse Cheesesteak Eating Contest with 8-1/2 during the Philadelphia series, then capped it off earning the win in his first career appearance vs. the Phillies (May 14) in Game 2 of the DH.

#65 GEORGE SORIANO · RHP · 6-1 · 230 LBS · AGE 27

- Acquired by the Cardinals on February 10, 2026 from the Nationals in a trade that sent RHP Andre Granillo to Washington.
- Was claimed off waivers three times in 2025-26 off season by the Orioles (11/5/25), Braves (1/9/26) and Nationals (1/30/26).
- Has been on the Marlins Opening Day roster each of the last two seasons (2024 & 2025).
- Pitched in 72 Major League games, making one start, as a member of the Miami Marlins (2023-25).
- Made one postseason appearance completing a scoreless inning with the Marlins in Game 1 of the 2023 Wild Card round against the Philadelphia Phillies at Citizens Bank Park.
- Made his Major League debut vs. Arizona (April 16, 2023) tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with a pair of strikeouts. Fanned All-Star outfielder Corbin Carroll for his first Major League strikeout.
