TODAY'S GAME: Coming off a four-game sweep at the hands of the Phillies in Philadelphia, the Giants open up the final series of their three-city road trip tonight in Colorado.

- SF is 1-6 through the first seven games of its longest road trip of the season after going 1-2 in Boston and 0-4 in Philly.
- With yesterday's defeat the Giants are a season-worst six games under . 500 at 15-21 entering play today.
- SF is 9-6 in day games while it's 6-15 in night games.. SF has a . 725 OPS and is averaging 4.5 runs/game during the day. at night SF ownsa.628 OPS and is averaging 3.1 runs/game

BDAY HJELLE DONUT: Giants RHP Sean Hjelle turns 27 today.
ROCKY ROAD HERE: Since 2021, the Giants are 18-8 vs. the Rockies at Coors Field with a +51 run differential...however, SF went 4-3 against the Rockies in Denver in 2023, losing three of four games during their last series in mid September.

- In 51 overall games against the Rockies since 2021 the Giants are 38-13 with a +113 run differential...the Giants are 17-4 in their last 21 games against Colorado dating to August 21, 2022.
- The Giants went 6-1 (.857) against the Rockies in games decided by two or fewer runs, which was their best season record against a division opponent since posting a 9-0 record against the Padres in 2008 (Stats, LLC)
CAN WE GET 5 ON IT?: The Giants are currently in the midst of an 11-game streak in which their offense has scored four runs or fewer, the longest such streak in MLB this season, and the Giants' longest since May 19-30, 2019
- Over this current 11-game span, which started April 24, SF has a $.210 / .276 / .324$ slash line with 10 homers and 27 runs.
- The Giants are one of three teams that are undefeated when scoring at least five runs in a game this season (8-0), joining Oakland (7-0) and Minnesota (13-0)
I LOVE IT HERE: Three Giants are inside the top-10 in career OPS at Coors Field among players currently on MLB active rosters (min. 30 games)...when expanding to active players, including those on the IL, SF has four inside the top-12.
- IF Nick Ahmed has a . 997 OPS at Coors Field, his best at any ballpark he's played at least 20 games...his eight home runs at Coors are tied for second-most (with Dodger Stadium) behind his 32 homers at Chase Field
- OF Mike Yastrzemski has a . 994 OPS and 10 homers at Coors, both career-highs at any road ballpark (min. 15 games)
- IF Wilmer Flores has a . 954 OPS at Coors Field, his best at any ballpark he's played at least 25 games, and his .361 batting average is his highest among all ballparks he's played at least seven games.

LOOKING FOR LENGTH: Giants starters logged at least 6.0 innings in five of six games from April 22-28 with the lone exception being an opener going 1.0 inning...in seven games on this trip, no Giants starter has finished 6.0 innings

- When the Giants get at least 6.0 innings from their starter this year they are 12-4
- The only starter on this trip to complete even 5.0 innings was today's probable, LHP Kyle Harrison, who did so in last Thursday's finale in Boston.
- SF's rotation has a 8.34 ERA (21er, 22.2ip) on this sevengame trip so far.
NEED A STOPPER: The Giants have needed LHP Kyle Harrison to be a stopper this season as he has yet to pitch in a game following a win...he's done his part as the Giants are 5-2 in games he's started.
- Harrison has typically been much better at Oracle Park than on the road in his young MLB career, going 1-0 with a 2.97 ERA in seven home starts compared to 2-2 with a 4.95 ERA in seven road starts.
- In his one start against the Rockies last season, he struck out five while allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits (one home run) across 5.0 innings at Oracle Park.
- Colorado is in the upper-half of MLB in hitting lefties, with their .251 average ranking T-12th and their . 695 OPS ranking 13th...COL does strike out a lot against southpaws, however, with its $24.2 \%$ strikeout rate ranking ninth in MLB.
WADE AND SEE: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. has a . 472 on-base percentage against right-handed pitchers this season, which ranks third in MLB (min. 75 PA against RHPs)...he is also batting . 352 against righties this season, which ranks tied for sixth in MLB.
- Wade has a . 469 on-base percentage through 34 games played this season...the only Giants player since 1971 to have a better on-base percentage through 34 games (min. 50 PA) is OF Barry Bonds (sixtimes) according to Stats, LLC.
THAIRO TIME: IF Thairo Estrada is tied for the team lead with five home runs this season.
- Through six games in May, Estrada is 8-for-24 (.333) with three runs, two doubles, a homer and a . 902 OPS...he has accounted for $40 \%$ of SF's RBIs this month (6-of-15)

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season today in the first game of this three-game series against the Colorado Rockies...Harrison is 2-1 with a 3.79 ERA (16er, 38.0ip) in his seven starts this season...the Giants are 5-2 in his starts this season, having won each of his last four.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to MLB.com and Baseball America...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA

LAST TIME OUT: Worked around a season-high (and MLB careerhigh) five walks and struck out seven batters in 5.0 innings last Thursday at Boston in SF's 3-1 victory, their lone win thus far on this 10-game road trip...allowed a run on three hits and threw a season-high 95 pitches...his five walks equaled the amount he had issued over his first six starts...the 95 pitches were also an early MLB career high with his previous high being 94 in his last outing of the 2023 campaign vs. LA last year.

A LITTLE HELP FROM BUSTER: Former Giants catcher Buster Posey swung by the Giants' clubhouse a few weeks ago and Harrison stopped him for a brief chat as he had been searching to find a feel for all three of his pitches at once...as told to the SF Chronicle, Harrison told Posey that he felt so close, yet so far from finding his footing..."you're going to feel like that your whole career," Posey told him..."it's that everlasting search."...Harrison took the advice and worked hard between starts in search of his slider, which he found in his start against the Pirates on April 26th.
FROM SIS: According to Sports Info Solutions, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues. opposing hitters are 18-for-51 (.353) with three homers in atbats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball.. they're 21 -for-95 (.221) in at-bats ending with the four-seam.. last year, opponents hit . 182 against the four-seam, 278 against everything else he threw.
GIVE ME 5: Harrison has pitched 5.0 innings in six of his seven starts this season

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 65.5\% of the time, second-highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches (Michael Kopech, 78.4\%)

VS. COLORADO: Faces the Rockies for just the second time in his career and will make his Coors Field debut tonight
NO FREE PASSES: Has limited the walks through his first seven starts, allowing 10 free passes in 38.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.


MORE FROM SIS: According to Sports Info Solutions, one career stat for Harrison that stands out is that his first time through the order, he has 39 strikeouts vs. 126 batters faced...other times through the order, he has just 34 strikeouts out of 180 batters faced.
LOTS OF PUNCHOUTS: Has struck out 73 batters in his first 14 big league games...according to Stats, LLC, since 1901, the only other Giants lefty to have struck out 73-or-more batters through his first 14 games with the Giants was LHP Shawn Estes (74).

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected....went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2 ip ) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6\%) batters he faced in all Triple-A.. Harrison's $14.50 \mathrm{~K} / 9 \mathrm{ip}$ in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip)

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since Madison Bumgarner in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

## \#75 CAMILO DOVAL» RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker
Last Game: $5 / 2$ at BOS; S, 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- Has pitched once in the last eight days after throwing in three straight from April 26-28.
- Is 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 6-for-6 in save opportunities over his last 11 outings.
- Has struck out 15 batters over 11.2 innings of work (11.6 SO/9.0).
- 12 of his 15 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- Righties are just 2-for-19 (.105) off him, while lefties are 7-for-25.
- Earned his first career All-Star selection last season and wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).


## \#64 SEAN HJELLE RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: $5 / 5$ at PHI; 2.0ip, $2 \mathrm{~h}, 6 \mathrm{k}$ (30 pitches)

- Worked 4.0 scoreless innings in the Philly series and struck out 10 over two appearances...the last time a Giants reliever had 10+ strikeouts in any series (since 1969) was RHP Tom Griffin from Aug. $14-17,1980$ vs. ATL.
- Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19....missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- Four of his five outings with SF have been scoreless.
- The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.


## \#77 LUKE JACKSON $~>~ R H P$

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: $5 / 6$ at PHI; 1.1 ip, $h$, bb, $k$ ( 21 pitches)

- Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- Has made four appearances since being reinstated (6.1ip, 7h, Or, 2bb, 4k)
- Batters are 9-for-26 (.346) with three walks and four strikeouts vs. Jackson in his six appearances at the MLB level this year...opposing hitters have a batting average on balls in play of . 391
Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.


## \#68 ERIK MILLER•LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: $5 / 6$ at PHI; 1.1ip, 2 k (22 pitches)

- Has held opponents scoreless in 10 of his last 12 outings, while striking out 17 batters and posting a 0.73 WHIP....has a 2.19 ERA in that time (since April 10).
- LHBs are 2-for-21 (.095) off him and RHBs are 5-for-36 (.139) with two home runs.
- The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- Is ranked the Giants No. 27 prospect according to MLB.com
- Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters ( $12.63 \mathrm{~K} / 9 \mathrm{ip}$ ).


## BULLPEN NOTES

- In seven games on this road trip, the bullpen has a 3.41 ERA (13er, 34.1 ip ) with 42 strikeouts and two homers allowed
- The bullpen has had to cover a lot of innings on this trip with Giants starters only throwing 22.2 innings in the seven games
- That is essentially because the Giants threw a scheduled bullpen game last Wednesday in Boston (the Blake Snell spot in the rotation) and allowed six runs on 10 hits in 7.0 innings.
- SF then had another bullpen game on Saturday when RHP Keaton Winn couldn't escape the 1st inning amidst rainy conditions in Philly so the 'pen covered 7.1 innings, allowing nine runs (six earned) on eight hits and eight walks.

## Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/4 at PHI; 2.1ip, 2h, 4r, 1er, 2bb, 2k (48 pitches)

- Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento last Thursday and made his MLB debut on Saturday at Philadelphia...struck out Bryce Harper for his first career strikeout
- Is SF's 28th-best prospect according to MLB.com.
- In 10 appearances at Triple-A (all in relief), Rodríguez had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2 ip ) with 10 strikeouts and four walks...batters were hitting 184 off him to start the year
