**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-4 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, losing a three-game series 1-2 in New York at Citi Field earlier in the week, followed by consecutive losses in Tampa Bay on Friday and Saturday...today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale against the Rays in St. Petersburg...after today's game, they will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Mariners (Monday-Wednesday) and four against the Blue Jays (Thursday-Sunday).

☞ Twins are just 1-8 in their last nine, following a stretch where they went 8-1 in nine games from April 6-14.

☞ Twins are looking to snap a four-game losing streak, their longest since April 15-19 (also 4)...last time they lost five-straight was September 16-20, 2025.

**FLOP AT THE TROP:** The Twins lost to the Rays yesterday by a score of 6-1...Bailey Ober (2-1) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits and walked twice, while striking out 11 times...they went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base...Byron Buxton had two of the club's five hits, both singles...Twins avoided their first shutout of the season, scoring with two outs in the bottom of the ninth on a Royce Lewis single.

**TOUCH OF RAY:** The Twins and Rays are playing for the sixth and final time this season...Twins are just 1-4 vs. Tampa this season, going 1-3 at Target Field from April 3-5 and 0-2 this weekend at the Trop.

☞ Derek Shelton has a managerial record of 2-12 against Tampa Bay, going 1-10 in Tampa, the only win coming with the Pirates last season at George M. Steinbrenner Field on April 2.

☞ In four games against the Rays this season, Brooks Lee has gone 4-for-13 (.308) with one double, one home run, one walk, a .357 on-base percentage and a .615 slugging percentage.

☞ Twins have hit four home runs off Rays pitching this season: Brooks Lee (Friday night off Drew Rasmussen), Royce Lewis (Friday night off Trevor Martin), Matt Wallner (April 5 off Nick Martinez) and Tristan Gray (April 3 off Yoendrys Gómez).

☞ Lifetime vs. Scholtens: Matt Wallner has two singles in two at-bats...Royce Lewis is 1-for-1 with two walks and a grand slam on September 15, 2023, when Scholtens pitched for the White Sox.

☞ In his last nine games in Tampa Bay — including both ballparks (Trop & Steinbrenner) — Byron Buxton has posted an .833 OPS with 10 hits, two doubles and two home runs.

**HOME SICK:** The Twins return home tonight to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Mariners (Monday-Wednesday) and four against the Blue Jays (Thursday-Sunday)...Twins are 7-6 at home, compared to 5-9 on the road...the offense has scored 5.2 runs-per-game at home, compared to 4.5 runs-per-game on the road...the pitching staff has posted a 3.63 ERA at home, compared to a 5.00 ERA on the road.

**KEEP AUSTIN WEIRD:** Austin Martin has reached base safely in 17-straight games with a plate appearance and in 20 of 22 games with a plate appearance...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-game on-base streak from May 28-June 20, 2025...the 17-straight is tied for fourth-longest active streak in baseball...below are baseball's longest active on-base streaks:

**SIMP-LEE DEVINE:** Brooks Lee is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with a .931 OPS on this roadtrip...he has seven hits in his last 13 at-bats...below are Lee's numbers through the first 10 games (March 26-April 8), compared to his last 15 (since April 9):

**BREAK A BROOM:** Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the second time in 2026, the other being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati in three games at Target Field.

☞ Twins are looking to avoid being swept by the Rays for the first time since June 6-8, 2023 at Tropicana Field (3 games).

☞ Twins were swept six times in 2025: three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15), three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), three games vs. the Athletics (August 19-21) and four games vs. Chicago-AL (September 1-4).

**RISPING IT ALL:** Twins began the season hitting .306 (49-for-160) with runners in scoring position through their first 20 games...in their last seven games, they are hitting .179 (12-for-67) with RISP, since game two of the Reds series on April 18 — 1-6 since that date.

**PREVENT DEFENSE:** Twins pitchers have posted a 0.80 home runs-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio, fifth-lowest in baseball, trailing San Diego (0.66), Pittsburgh (0.69), Los Angeles-AL (0.77) and Detroit (0.78).

☞ Twins are 11-9 when allowing one home run-or-less and 9-6 when allowing zero homers...1-6 when allowing multiple homers.

**TWINS MILB WEEKLYS:** Twins have named Double-A Wichita catcher/outfielder Ricardo Olivar and High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Eduardo Tait as their Twins co-minor league Players of the Week, and have named Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper as their co-minor league Pitchers of the Week.

☞ Olivar, 24, played in five games for the Wind Surge, hitting .412 (7-for-17) with one double, four home runs and seven RBI, including a two-homer game on Wednesday at Northwest Arkansas.

☞ Tait, 19, played in five games for the Kernels, hitting .286 (6-for-21) with two doubles, two home runs, two walks and six RBI.

☞ Hill, 20, made the start on Wednesday at Peoria, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, striking out seven of his 15 batters faced, while not issued a walk.

☞ Culpepper, 24, started at Northwest Arkansas on Thursday, allowing five runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts (18 batters faced).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1986, the game between California and the Twins was delayed for nine minutes when strong winds tore a hole in the Metrodome roof, causing suspended lights and speakers to sag toward the field...the roof was reinflated and California rallied for six runs in the ninth inning to win, 7-6.

- ☞ Making his sixth start of the season, 57th start of his career (59th game) and fourth career start vs. Tampa Bay (second this season).
- ☞ On April 21 at New York-NL, allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) through 5.0 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts in a no-decision; Twins won, 5-3.
- ☞ Is 0-2 with a 6.43 ERA (14.0 IP, 10 ER), five walks and six strikeouts away from Target Field this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sim made his fifth start of the season on April 21 at New York-NL, his former organization, opposite right-hander Nolan McLean...allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) through 5.0 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins came from behind to win game one of the series by a score of 5-3; he did not factor into the decision.

- ☞ He fired a season-high 95 pitches in the outing, his most since a 99-pitch performance on July 28, 2025 vs. Boston.
- ☞ Has allowed a homer in each of his first five starts of the season, becoming the only starter in Major League Baseball to do so, and the first Twins starter since Kyle Gibson surrendered a long ball in each of his first five starts of 2017.
- ☞ Sim was drafted by New York-NL in the second round of the 2018 Amateur Draft before being traded to Toronto along with left-hander Anthony Kay in exchange for right-hander Marcus Stroman and cash.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Woods Richardson made his fourth start of the season on April 15 vs. Boston opposite left-hander Connelly Early...took the loss, his second in as many starts and third straight decision with a loss to begin 2026...marked the first time he has started a season with three losses before recording a win; sixth consecutive start without a win dating back to September 21, 2025 vs. Cleveland, his longest such streak since going seven starts without a victory from July 2-August 10, 2024...allowed seven runs (six earned) on a career-high 10 hits (1 HR) through 5.0 innings pitched with three walks and three strikeouts in the outing.

- ☞ Surrendered a three-run shot to Trevor Story in the third inning; has allowed a home run in four consecutive starts to begin the season, joining Colorado's Tomoyuki Sugano and St. Louis' Matthew Liberatore as the only starters in MLB to allow a homer in each of their first four starts of the year.
- ☞ Each of the first five Boston batters reached to begin the third inning courtesy of singles by Isiah Kiner-Falefa and Cedanne Rafaela, a walk by Roman Anthony, a two-error sequence by Luke Keaschall on a Masataka Yoshida grounder that brought in a pair of runs, and then Trevor Story's blast to cap off a five-run frame.

**FLORIDA MAN:** Sim is set to make his fourth career start against Tampa Bay and secon this season (also on April 5); he is 0-0 with a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER), six walks, 12 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP and a .242 (15-for-62) BAA in his career against the Rays...in his most recent outing against Tampa Bay on April 5 at Target Field, Sim had a quality start, firing 6.2 innings of one-run baseball, with his only blemish being a fourth-inning, solo-home run off the bat of Junior Caminero...he surrendered five hits on the day with two walks and four strikeouts and did not factor into the decision; the Twins would go on to lose the game 4-1.

- ☞ Simeon has faced 11 active Rays batters, who have combined for a .244 (11-for-45) BAA with one double (Yandy Diaz), two home runs (Junior Caminero and Cedric Mullins), six RBI, three walks and eight strikeouts.

**NOTHING COMES EAST-Y:** Today's game will mark Simeon's 12th career start against an AL East opponent and fourth out of his six starts this season; 1-2, 6.49 ERA (52.2 IP, 38 ER) with 21 walks, 42 strikeouts, 12 homers allowed, a 1.65 WHIP and a .307 (66-for-215) BAA in his career against the AL East.

- ☞ In three starts against the AL East this season, Sim is 0-2 with a 6.89 ERA (15.2 IP, 12 ER) with six walks, nine strikeouts, a 1.72 WHIP and a .323 (21-for-65) BAA.
- ☞ His 6.49 ERA against the AL East is his highest against any division in Major League Baseball.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In his career, Sim has gone 6-5 with a 4.03 ERA (140.2 IP, 63 ER), 55 walks, 133 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 28 games (27 starts) at home compared to 6-8 with a 4.70 ERA (139.2 IP, 73 ER), 54 walks, 112 strikeouts and a 1.36 WHIP in 30 road games (29 starts).

- ☞ Is 0-2, 6.43 ERA (14.0 IP, 10 ER) with five walks, six strikeouts, a 1.43 WHIP and a .268 (15-for-56) BAA in his three starts away from Target Field this season; it is his highest ERA through the first three road starts of a season in his career.
- ☞ Has allowed a home run in each of his first three road starts this season, marking his longest such streak since allowing a long-ball in three straight on the road from July 2-August 27, 2025.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In his first five starts of 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .271/.340/.521 (13-for-48) with three doubles, three home runs, five walks and eight strikeouts, while righties are slashing .309/.367/.491 (17-for-55) with four doubles, two home runs, five walks and five strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .243/.318/.386 (118-for-485) with 52 walks and 110 strikeouts (2.12 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .245/.312/.419 (143-for-583) with 57 walks and 135 strikeouts (2.37 K/BB).

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson relies on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He is the only Twins pitcher to throw at least 100 pitches with three different pitch types within his arsenal this season (4-seam fastball, split finger, slider).
- ☞ Sim's -4 run value with his slider and his -5 run value with his split finger each rank as the worst among all pitchers in Major League Baseball.
- ☞ This season, Sim has an overall strikeout percentage of just 12.0%, over eight percent below his career average; it falls within the bottom four percent among all pitchers this season.

**WELL TRAVELED:** Simeon is no stranger to pitching in opposing ballparks, with today's outing marking the 30th road start of his career, accounting for nearly 53% of his starts...he is one of 33 pitchers in Twins club history (1961-) to make his first 29 career road starts in MLB with Minnesota...among those 33 starters through their first 29 career road starts, Simeon has the fewest decisions (13), hits allowed (129) and losses (7); he also ranks second in innings pitched (135.1 IP) and total baserunners allowed (190), trailing only teammate Bailey Ober (176) during that span.

**EARLY AND OFTEN:** Through his first 56 starts, Woods Richardson has set the tone in the first inning, posting a career 2.73 ERA (56.0 IP, 17 ER) with 26 walks, 54 strikeouts and a .201 (41-for-204) BAA in the opening frame...below are some of his numbers in the first inning and where those numbers rank among starting pitchers in Twins club history since 1974 (min. 200 plate appearances):

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP CONNOR PRIELIPP (2026: 0-0, 4.50 ERA // CAREER: 0-0, 4.50 ERA)

Left-hander Connor Prielipp will get the start in tomorrow's game vs. Seattle to kickoff a seven-day, seven-game homestand for the Twins...Prielipp made his major league debut on April 22 at New York-NL, when he allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts through 4.0 innings pitched, as the Twins went on to lose 3-2; he did not factor into the decision...in the outing, Prielipp became the 19th pitcher in Twins club history (1961-) to strike out at least six batters in his big league debut, and the first to do so in 4.0-or-fewer innings pitched... Prielipp, the reigning Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year, currently ranks as the Twins' fourth overall prospect (no. 81 prospect in MLB) and highest ranked pitching prospect in Minnesota's system, per *Baseball America*.
