SUNDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles avoided the sweep with a 6-5, walk-off victory over the ankees in the finale of the three-game set...Snapped their season-high-tying five-game losing streak and avoided being swept in a homestand for the first time since August 6-12, ..Cedric Mullins lined a walk-off, two-RBI double in the bottom of the ninth, his career walk-off plate appearance and third walk-off hit (last: 4/17/24 vs. MIN, 2-run HR)... **Gunnar Henderson** cranked his 28th homer of the season, which ties for the third-most before the break in Orioles history with Nelson Cruz (2014) and Mark Trumbo (2016), behind only Brady Anderson (30, 1996) and Chris Davis (37, 2013)...**Anthony Santander** blasted his 24th home run of the season and his 11th career Eutaw Street homer, tying Davis for the most in ballpark history.

ALL-STARS: Five Orioles were selected to the All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX: Corbin Burnes, Gunnar Henderson, Adley Rutschman, Anthony Santander, and Jordan Westburg...Head Athletic Trainer Brian Ebel also represented the 0's on the AL staff...Burnes (4x) and Rutschman (2x) were repeat All-Stars while Henderson, Santander, and Westburg were first-timers...Burnes (P), Henderson (SS), and Rutschman (C) all started for the first time in their careers.

 $\theta_{\rm x}$ Baltimore became the first AL team with at least five All-Stars, all of whom were under 30 years old at the time of the game, since New York-AL in 2017 (also 5); the

Braves did so with eight such players last year.
Burnes and Rutschman became the first pair of teammates to form the starting battery at the All-Star game since 2016, when San Francisco's Johnny Cueto (P) and Buster Posey (C) did so in San Diego, and the first for the AL since 2006, when Detroit's Kenny Rogers (P) and Ivan Rodríguez (C) did so in Pittsburgh.
Santander scored the game-winning run in the fifth inning after recording a single

and later scoring on a two-run homer by Boston's Jarren Duran, who earned MVF

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 58-38 (.604), the Birds own the third-best record in MLB behind the Guardians (.611, 58-37) and Phillies (.646, 62-34)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 159-99 (.616), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time. The O's are 242-178 (.576) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.586, 246-174), Braves (.616, 258-161), and Dodgers (.634, 267-154)

The Birds became the second team in MLB history to be at least 20 games over .500 at the All-Star break despite two five-game losing streaks, per *OptaSTATS*; the other was the 1979 0's (59-31).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 149 home runs, nine more than the secondplace Yankees (140) and 20 more than the Dodgers (129), who rank third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

- $oldsymbol{ heta}_{\!\scriptscriptstyle B}$ Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (28), Anthony Santander (24), Adley Rutschman (16), Jordan Westburg (15), Colton Cowser and Ryan Mountcastle (12), and Ryan
- Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramírez (23) and Josh Naylor (22), and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (34) and Juan Soto (23).

 The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has
- eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021),
- trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).
 The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.
- Anthony Santander led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history; he tied with Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014) and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966), and finished behind **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a month by an Oriole.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore commences a six-game road trip tonight with the first of three games in Arlington before heading to Miami for the first time since 2021...The Birds went 4-2 on their last road trip against the Mariners (2-1) and Athletics (2-1) from July 2-7...The 0's are a league-best 28-16 (.636) on the road this year and 80-45 (.640) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 during that time.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: The Orioles and Rangers finish a seven-game season series with the first of three matchups tonight in Texas...The O's took three out of four in Baltimore from June 27-30, but lost the series finale...Since the start of 2021, the O's are 16-7 (.696) against the Rangers during the regular season, including a perfect 6-0 in 2022...Baltimore is 277-222-1 all-time against the Rangers since the Washington Senators moved to Texas in 1972; the .555 winning percentage during that time is the best by the Orioles among current AL teams and the second-best in MLB behind the .558 mark against the Brewers

during that time (min. 100 G).

GENUINE DRAFT: The Orioles selected 21 players in the 2024 MLB First-Year Player Draft: 11 pitchers (8 RHP, 3 LHP) and 10 position players (4 OF, 2 INF, 4 C)...0f the 21 picks, 17 were selected out of college, while four were from the high school ranks...University of North Carolina center fielder **Vance Honeycutt** was the first 0's selection at No. 22 with infielder **Griff O'Ferrall** (No. 32) and catcher **Ethan Anderson** (No. 61), both out of the University of Virginia, rounding out Day One.

 $oldsymbol{eta}_{\!\scriptscriptstyle S}$ The O's officially signed O'Ferrall and Anderson earlier today.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023. he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 373 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 20th start of the season tonight against the Rangers...Reinstated from the Paternity List on July 1; placed on the PL June 28...His 2.43 ERA is the lowest mark for an Orioles starting pitcher through his first 19 starts in a season since Jim Palmer in 1978 (2.31) and it is the lowest mark for a pitcher through his first 19 starts to begin an Orioles career all-time...The Orioles are 12-7 in his starts this year...Has allowed 24 stolen bases this season, the most by any pitcher in MLB...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA). College (CA).

HEY NOW. YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Selected to his fourth consecutive All-Star Game and made his first All-Star Game start...Became the fifth Orioles pitcher to start the Midsummer Classic, joining Steve Stone (1980), Jim Palmer (1978, 1977, 1972, 1970), Milt Pappas (1965), and Jerry Walker (1959)...Burnes pitched a scoreless first inning, allowing a walk to Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and a double to Philadelphia's Bryce Harper; left both runners stranded in scoring nosition.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss on July 10 vs. Chicago-NL after allowing three runs on a career-high-tying nine hits (1 HR) and one wild pitch with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings; has completed at least 6.0 innings in a career-high 14 consecutive starts, the longest such streak by an Orioles pitcher since Sidney Ponson did so in 16 straight (7/4-10/2/04 [G2])...Received zero runs of support for the fourth time this year and the first time since May 7 at Washington...Threw 97 nitches. 61 strikes. 97 pitches, 61 strikes.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: Earned the win in his sole outing against the Rangers on June 27 at Oriole Park...Tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing a career-high-tying nine hits (1 HR) with five strikeouts...Marked his first career appearance against Texas, the only team in MLB he had not faced prior to the

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Will be making his 11th career appearance (10^{th} start) against the AL West...0wns a lifetime 5-2 record with a 2.77 ERA (17 ER/55.1 IP) against the division...Has made a start against every AL West opponent this season; has gone 3-1 with a 2.13 ERA (9 ER/38.0 IP) with 44 strikeouts to five walks across his six starts against the division this year.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest streak in the majors this year and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 15 quality starts on the season are tied for second in MLB and his 72 quality outings since the start of 2021 are the most.

NEW BEGINNINGS: Burnes began his Orioles career with 15 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings and three-or-fewer runs allowed...The 15 consecutive outings was the longest such streak to begin a pitcher's career with the Orioles all-time.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with 200+ strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 90 strikeouts away from 200 on the year and 20 away from 1,000 in his career; the last Orioles pitcher to record a 200+-strikeout season was Erik Bedard in 2007 (221).

INNINGS FATER: The 681.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank second in MLB behind Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (699.0 IP)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA(30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
