The Washington Nationals kick off their penultimate homestand on Friday with the start of a three-game weekend series against the Los Angeles Angels.

- In recognition of 25 years since the attacks of September 11., 2001, the Nationals will honor first responders and service members with several activations, including a memorial stair run by the Marine Barracks Washington, the Patriotic Series: Heroes Day and the annual Fallen Heroes Tribute.
- Additionally, 184 seats in Section 107 will remain reserved and draped in bunting in remembrance of the 184 individuals who were killed in the attack at the Pentagon.



The Nationals recalled outfielder **Andrew Pinckney** from Triple-A Rochester and placed infielder **Nasim Nuñez** on the Bereavement List on Thursday.

- Pinckney, 25, hit .273 with a triple, homer, two RBI, one walk, one stolen base and six runs scored in 13 games during his first stint with Washington from Aug. 4 to Sept. 2.

Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers and ranks in Major League Baseball in batting average (3rd, .361) and on-base percentage (8th, .418) and is third among Major League catchers in OPS (.945) and third in slugging percentage (.528) since Aug. 2 (min. 75 PA).

- He's 26-for-72 (.368) with three doubles, three homers, 11 RBI, seven walks, seven strikeouts and 10 runs scored during this 22-game stretch.

In 21 games since Aug. 19, **Simon Mathews'** starting pitchers/openers ranks in Major League Baseball in opponents' slugging percentage (1st, .320), opponents' average (2nd, .210), opponents' OPS (3rd, .623) and ERA (4th, 3.10).

Of **Dylan Crews'** last eight hits, six of them have gone for extra bases (5 2B, HR)...The five doubles lead Major League Baseball, while the six extra-base hits are tied for third since Sept. 4.

- 10 of Crews' last 19 hits have gone for extra-bases since Aug. 22 (8 2B, 3B, HR)...He's slashing .288/.356/.485 with 12 RBI, six walks and a stolen base during that span.
- In addition to the extra-base hits, Crews is 8-for-23 (.348) with five RBI, one hit by pitch, one stolen base and two runs scored in this six-game stretch.

The Nationals boast 10 players with at least 10 home runs this season: **CJ Abrams, James Wood, Luis García Jr., Daylen Life, Curtis Mead, Dylan Crews, Andres Chaparro, Brady House, Keibert Ruiz** and **Jacob Young**.

- Washington is tied with the New York Mets (10) and New York Yankees (10) as the teams with the most players to hit at least 10 home runs this season.
- The 2026 Nationals join the 2019 and 2017 clubs as the only teams in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with at least 10 players to hit at least 10 home runs in a season.

CJ Abrams (30 HR, 95 RBI) and **Daylen Life** (20 HR, 81 RBI) have both eclipsed the 20 HR/80 RBI mark this year, while **James Wood** (30 HR, 74 RBI) is close to joining them.

- There are only nine players in MLB age 25 and younger to hit the 20/80 mark this season and Washington is the only team with more than one player in that group...With six more RBI, **James Wood** joins the club.
- If Wood reaches the 80 RBI mark, the 2026 Nationals would become the eighth team in Major League history with at least three players age 25 and younger to record a 20/80 season...The last team to do so was the 2007 Milwaukee Brewers, who hold the record with four (**Ryan Braun**, **Prince Fielder**, **J.J. Hardy**, **Corey Hart**)...The last team to have three was the 1999 Kansas City Royals (**Carlos Beltran**, **Jermaine Dye**, **Mike Sweeney**).

CJ Abrams' 95 RBI this season are the most by a shortstop in a single season in Nationals history (2005-pres.), ahead of **Ian Desmond** (91 in 2014).

- With five more RBI, he will become the 12th player in Nationals history to record 100 RBI in a season and first since **Anthony Rendon** (126) and **Juan Soto** (110) in 2019.
- He joins **Alfonso Soriano** (40 HR/41 SB in 2006) as the only two players in Nationals history with at least 25 home runs and 25 stolen bases in a season...Only Abrams and **Pete Crow-Armstrong** and **Elly De La Cruz** have hit the 25/25 mark in MLB this season.

Rochester right-handed pitcher **Joe Glassey** has not allowed an earned run in 271 scoreless innings, the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest streak the Minors this season...He's recorded 40 strikeouts against just two walks and a .128 opponents average during this streak...Glassey was acquired by the Nationals at the Trade Deadline and in 12 games in Washington's system, has 13 strikeouts and one walk in 13.2 scoreless innings between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester...Glassey went undrafted out of the University of Illinois before signing with the Baltimore Orioles in 2024.
