## AROUND THE HORN

**STAR WARS NIGHT FIREWORKS & GABI MORENO BOBBLE:** The force will be strong as Star Wars takes over Chase Field this weekend with Friday Star Wars-themed postgame fireworks show followed by Saturday's Gabriel Moreno Mandalorian Bobble, courtesy of Cox, for the first 25,000 fans.

**MOTHER'S DAY ON SUNDAY:** Honor and celebrate all Moms with an exclusive giveaway Mother's Day Jersey, courtesy of Dignity Health, for the first 15,000 moms in attendance.

**63 NONPROFITS AWARDED WITH \$309,000:** Derrick Hall and the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation awarded 63 Arizona nonprofits with \$309,000 in Derrick Hall President's Circle Grants at the end of 2025 and this Friday will celebrate the organizations during a special reception, pregame ceremony and award presentation at Chase Field...the grant program, established in 1998, has awarded a total of \$7.3 million and was renamed in 2024 in honor of Derrick Hall, whose long-standing leadership has helped expand the club's statewide community impact.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs' .588 home win pct. (10-7 record) ranks fourth in the NL, behind the Cubs (.773, 17-5), Braves (.667, 12-6) and Dodgers (.667, 12-6).

- The D-backs are 12-4 (.750) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 7-1 (.875) @ home.
- The D-backs have won or split 4 of their 5 home series (won 3-0 vs. Tigers, split 2-2 vs. Braves, won 2-1 vs. Blue Jays, lost 1-2 vs. White Sox, split 1-1 vs. Padres in Mexico City).
- The D-backs have won 7 of their last 8 home series vs. Pirates since 2018.
- The D-backs have won 11 of their last 15 series overall vs. Pirates since May 29-31, 2017.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 1-0 vs. Pirates on Wednesday in their second-fastest time of game (2:14) of the season (fastest: 2:10, 1-0 win vs. Tigers on April 1).

- **Michael Soroka** (L, 1 ER in 6.1 IP, 7 H, 2 BB, 6 K) recorded his 7th career game with 6.0+ innings, 1 run or less and 6+ strikeouts (last: June 6, 2025 vs. Rangers with the Nationals).
- **Kevin Ginkel** (0.2 IP), **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP) and **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) combined to work 2.2 hitless innings with 0 walks and 1 strikeout.

**SOROKA MAKES HIMSELF AT HOME:** Michael Soroka became the first D-back starter ever to allow 5 runs or fewer over his first 5 home starts to begin his D-backs career [Source: Elias Sports Bureau].

**PEN SPOTLIGHT:** In their last 7 games, D-backs relievers own a combined 2.59 ERA (8 R-7 ER in 24.1 IP), opponent .136 AVG/.481 OPS, 0.86 WHIP and 21 strikeouts.

- **Juan Morillo's** 15-game home scoreless streak (12.2 IP) since June 30, 2025 is the longest active home scoreless streak in the Majors.
  - During the streak, is 1-0 with an opponent .163 AVG/.422 OPS, 0.71 WHIP, 7 hits, 2 walks and 15 strikeouts.
- **Taylor Clarke** has allowed 1 earned run over his last 16 games, going 1-1 with a 0.53 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 17.0 IP), opponent .145 AVG, 0.59 WHIP, 8 hits, 2 walks and 9 strikeouts.

**FAREWELL ANOTHER VARGAS STREAK:** Ildemaro Vargas' career-best 13-game home hitting streak ended last night after going 0-for-3...was tied for MLB's longest active home hitting streak with Mickey Moniak/COL.

- The 13-game home hit streak to start the season is the third-longest in club history, to Luis Gonzalez (21 in 1999) and Danny Bautista (14 in 2002).
- During the home streak, Vargas hit .375 (18-for-48)/1.221 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 17 RBI and 1 walk.

**ROLLIN' NOLAN:** Nolan Arenado has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games, hitting .400 (16-for-40)/1.100 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 7 walks, including 6 games reaching base 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 45 PA] in AVG (1st, .400), OPS (1st, 1.100), OBP (1st, .500), SLG (2nd, .600), hits (T-3rd, 16), runs (T-3rd, 10) and total bases (T-4th, 24).

**TRENDING SNAKES:** Ildemaro Vargas has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 games at a .375 clip (15-for-40)/.955 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 2 walks.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 games at a .407 clip (11-for-27)/.981 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 RBI and 5 walks.

**COZY IN CASA:** Nolan Arenado has reached base safely in 7 straight home starts, hitting .545 (12-for-22)/1.370 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 5 walks.

- Has reached base in 10 of his last 12 home starts, hitting .421 (16-for-38)/1.116 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** in his last 7 home games, is hitting .360 (19-for-25)/1.107 OPS with 1 double, 3 triples, 4 RBI and 5 walks, including 4 games reaching base 2+ times.
