**12NEWS SIMULCAST FINALE:** Tonight is the final of 12News’ 10 simulcasts in an incredible partnership that marked the first time a series of D-backs games were televised on a local network affiliate, providing over-the-air access to fans outside of the national broadcast agreements and a massive reach with approximately 1.59 million television households.

**KETEL MARTE FIELD:** The D-backs dedicated Ketel Marte Field as the 46th Mike Kennedy Diamonds Back Field, presented by APS, on Wednesday... Madison Simis Elementary School and RAMMS Little League will be the beneficiary of the newly renovated diamond.

**SNAKE BITES:** The D-backs — who trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 — are tied fourth with the Reds, 2.0 games behind the Mets (third place) and 1.0 game ahead of the Giants (fifth, 3.0 GB).

- The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 games.
- The D-backs are 13-7 in their last 20 games, featuring a trio of 4-game win streaks: Aug. 27-30 @ Brewers and Dodgers, Sept. 2-6 vs. Rangers and Red Sox, and Sept. 13-16 @ Twins and vs. Giants.
- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 26-18 (.591) record is third in the NL and tied for fifth in the Majors: Phillies (30-15, .667), Brewers (30-15, .667), Guardians (27-17, .614), Mariners (26-17, .605), **D-backs (26-18, .591)**, Yankees (26-18, .591)
- Among NL teams since Sept. 12, the D-backs offense, in 6 games, is second with a .353 OBP, fifth with 22 extra-base hits, tied for fifth with 34 runs, sixth with a .263 AVG, seventh with a .788 OPS, tied for seventh with 55 hits and ninth with a .435 SLG.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won the series but dropped the series-finale, 5-1, vs. Giants in 11 innings.

- **Brandon Pfaadt** tossed 9.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts...became the eighth D-back (ninth time) to work 9.0 scoreless innings with 1 or fewer hits...was the third D-backs starter, first at home, to throw 9.0+ shutout innings and not be credited with a complete game shutout (also: Miguel Batista on May 28, 2002 @ Giants; Edwin Jackson on June 2, 2010 @ Dodgers).
- **Corbin Carroll** had a triple, a sac fly and a stolen base.
- **Gabriel Moreno** had 2 walks and **Blaze Alexander** had 2 singles.

**TO BE THE BEST...:** The D-backs’ .566 remaining strength of schedule is the hardest in the Majors ahead of the Cardinals (.562), Twins (.547), Red Sox (.542) and Marlins (.542).

**VS. PHILLIES:** The D-backs are 9-5 at home vs. Phillies since 2021, including taking 3 of 4 last Aug. 8-11.

- The D-backs are 15-15 vs. Phillies overall the last 5 seasons, since 2021.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 7 of his 8 last games vs. Phillies, hitting .464 (13-for-28)/1.123 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 RBI and 3 stolen bases.
  - Has reached base safely in 7 straight home games vs. Phillies (.480, 12-for-25, 1.136 OPS).
- **Gabriel Moreno**, since June 15, 2023, has reached base safely in 5 straight games vs. Phillies (.375 AVG, 7-for-15, 1.233 OPS).
- **Corbin Carroll**, since Aug. 9, 2024, has reached base safely in 6 straight games vs. Phillies (.280, 7-for-25, .828 OPS).
- **Jake McCarthy** has a trio of multi-hit games — 1 2-hit game and 2 3-hit games — in his last 4 games vs. Phillies, batting .444 (8-for-18)/1.500 OPS with 1 triple, 3 homers and 11 RBI.
- **Alek Thomas** has reached base safely in 9 of and hit safely in 8 of 10 career games vs. Phillies (.406, 13-for-32, .926 OPS, 2 2B, 4 RBI, 3 BB).

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The D-backs are 7-1-1 in their last 8 series, since Aug. 18, and 10-3-1 in their last 14 series, since Aug. 1.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The D-backs have 6 straight home series wins, doing 13-5 at home since Aug. 8, tied for the third-longest streak in club history (also: May 23-July 8, 2003 and May 1-24, 2006) behind 7 straight (Aug. 8-Sept. 25, 2011) and 8 straight (Aug. 3-Oct. 4, 2001).

**1 OF 10: Corbin Carroll** (30 2B, 17 3B, 30 HR) is the 10th player (12th time) in Major League history to reach 30+ doubles, 15+ triples and 30+ homers in a season:

- Babe Ruth (1921), Lou Gehrig (1927), Jim Bottomley (1928), Lou Gehrig (1930), Al Simmons (1930), Lou Gehrig (1931), Chuck Klein (1932), Hank Greenberg (1935), Joe DiMaggio (1937), Stan Musial (1948), Jimmy Rollins (2007), **Corbin Carroll (2025)**
- The only players to reach 30 doubles, 20 triples and 30 homers are Jim Bottomley (1928) and Jimmy Rollins (2007).

**HIT, RUN, SCORE:** Since Sept. 1, the D-backs’ 5.20 runs per game are third in the NL behind the Phillies (5.81) and Brewers (5.47) and ahead of the Giants (5.19) and Dodgers (5.00).

- Among NL teams since Sept. 1, D-backs 6-9 hitters are second with a .263 AVG, tied for second with 38 RBI, fourth with 19 extra-base hits and fifth with a .706 OPS.

**START ME UP:** The D-backs starting rotation has been among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27, ranking tied for first with 13 quality starts, tied for second with 10 starters wins, third with a 2.69 ERA, 39 runs allowed and an opponent .627 OPS, and fourth with 117.0 innings.

- The D-backs are 13-7 @ Brewers, @ Dodgers, vs. Rangers, vs. Red Sox, @ Giants, @ Twins and vs. Giants.
- In their last 20 starts (13 quality), the starters are 10-1 with a 2.69 ERA (39 R-35 ER in 117.0 IP), opponent .224 AVG (96-for-428)/.627 OPS, 30 walks and 88 strikeouts.

**YEAR OF THE SNAKE:** **Geraldo Perdomo’s** 6.8 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is second in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (8.7) and ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (6.7), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.3) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (6.3).

- **Perdomo’s** 6.7 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is third in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.1) and Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and ahead of Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.2).
- **Perdomo’s** 6.8 bWAR Position Players is tied for the fourth-best in a season a D-back with Ketel Marte (6.8 in 2024) behind Ketel Marte (6.9 in 2019), Luis Gonzalez (7.9 in 2001) and Paul Goldschmidt (8.3 in 2015).

**GABI DISHIN’ IT:** **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 8 straight games, hitting .367 (11-for-30)/1.120 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 7 walks.

- Among NL players since Aug. 22, is 12th with a .946 OPS and 13th with a .319 AVG.

**DYNAMIC DUO:** **Geraldo Perdomo** (19 HR, 26 SB) and **Corbin Carroll** (30 HR, 29 SB) look to become the seventh teammates in baseball history with 20+-HR, 30+-SB seasons.

**CC7 FUN:** **Corbin Carroll** (30 HR, 29 SB) is looking to become the first D-back with a 30+-HR/30+-SB season.

- His 77 extra-base hits are fourth in the Majors to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (83), Aaron Judge/NYY (79) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (78) and ahead of with Kyle Schwarber/PHI (76) and Pete Alonso/NYM (75).

- In his last 9 starts, since Aug. 2, is 5-2 with a 2.68 ERA (16 ER in 53.2 IP), an opponent .202 AVG (40-for-198)/.602 OPS, 14 walks and 42 strikeouts.
- Has 1 start in each of the last 3 seasons vs. Phillies (1-0, 1.59 ERA, 3 ER in 17.0 IP, .194 AVG, 12 H, 5 BB, 13 K).

**HOW HE STARTED:** D-backs’ second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs’ 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Has a career-high 6 straight starts of 6.0+ innings and has tossed 6.0+ innings in 10 of his last 14 starts.

- Has a career-high-tying 5 straight quality starts (also: 5 from Aug. 9-Sept. 3, 2024), going 1-0 with a 2.40 ERA (8 ER in 30.0 IP), opponent .200 AVG (21-for-105), 1.00 WHIP, 9 walks and 23 strikeouts.
- His 8 starts of 6.0+ innings with 90 pitches or fewer are tied for third most among NL starters (also: 4 others), behind Sonny Gray/STL (10) and Nick Pivetta/SD (10).

**LAST START:** Tossed 6.0 shutout innings on 4 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts in the D-backs 5-2 extra-innings win on Sept. 13 @ Twins.

**VS. PHILLIES:** Fourth career start, third @ Chase Field (0-1; 4.15 ERA).

- Made his last start on Aug. 9, 2024 in the D-backs’ 3-2 win (ND; 2 ER in 7.1 IP, 9 K).

**VS. NL EAST:** 15th career start vs. NL East, ninth @ Chase Field (3-6; 4.44 ERA).

- In 11 of his 14 starts, has allowed 3 or fewer runs and in 12 of 14 starts, has walked 2 or fewer batters, including 3 starts with 1 walk allowed and 6 starts with no walks allowed.

**HOME COOKIN:** In 10 home starts (7 quality), is 4-1 (team is 6-4) with a 2.28 ERA (16 R-15 ER in 59.1 IP), opponent .203 AVG (43-for-212), 0.96 WHIP, 14 walks and 49 strikeouts.

- Has 3 straight quality home starts and 6 quality home starts in his last 7 (team is 4-3)...in those 6, faced the Giants on June 30, Royals on July 5, Cardinals on July 19, Reds on Aug. 22, Rangers on Sept. 1 and Sept. 7 vs. Red Sox...was just shy of a quality start on Aug. 5 vs. Padres when he allowed 2 ER in 5.2 IP.
- Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 8 of his 10 starts, including 3 starts with 1 earned run and 2 starts with 0 runs allowed.
- Has walked 1 or fewer batters in 6 of his 10 starts.

**FREE PASSES ARE LIMITED:** Has allowed 1 walk or fewer in 11 of his 21 starts.

- Has yielded 2 walks or fewer in 30 of his last 36 starts since June 14, 2024 (2.12 BB/9.0 IP, 208.1 innings, 827 BF).
