**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles tied a season low with three hits, all singles, and fell to Washington in the series opener, 3-0...**Corbin Burnes** turned in his team-leading fifth quality start of the year in a losing effort...Last night snapped the team's seven-game streak of allowing two or fewer runs, which was the longest by the O's since August 1-9, 1980.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Birds have won four of their last five games, six of eight, seven of 12 times, 11 of 16, and 16 of 21...At 23-12 (.657), the Orioles have the best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Phillies (.703, 26-11) and Dodgers (.658, 25-13)...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 207-152 (.577), the second-best record in the AL behind the Astros (.579, 208-151).

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** The Orioles are looking to extend their sweepless streak to 103 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...During this current stretch, the O's have avoided being swept in the final game of a series 12 times - April 14, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (3G), August 10, 2023 vs. Houston (3G), July 19, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3G), July 2, 2023 vs. Minnesota (3G), June 18, 2023 at Chicago-NL (3G), June 8, 2023 at Milwaukee (3G), May 28, 2023 vs. Texas (3G), September 21, 2022 vs. Detroit (3G), September 18, 2022 at Toronto (3G), July 3, 2022 at Minnesota (3G), June 11, 2022 at Kansas City (3G), and May 19, 2022 vs. New York-AL (4G)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

**OPENING STATEMENTS:** The starting pitcher trio of **Cole Irvin** (6.1 IP), **John Means** (7.0), and **Dean Kremer** (6.0) did not surrender a run during the weekend series in Cincinnati...O's starters have posted a 1.47 ERA (8 ER/49.0 IP) in eight games since April 29, the best mark in the AL and second-best in MLB during that time...For the season, the rotation's 3.21 ERA (71 ER/199.0 IP) ranks third in the AL and fifth in MLB.

**PITCH PERFECT:** The Orioles have allowed three runs or less in eight straight games since April 29, the longest such stretch since a nine-gamer from September 26, 1995 to April 5, 1996, and the longest in a single season since doing so in 10 straight May 20-30, 1989...O's hurlers have held opponents to a .160/.232/.242 (39-for-244) slash line with 11 extra-base hits (6-2B, 3B, 4 HR) over that period.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 54 home runs, tied with the 2016 club for the third-most homers through the first 35 games in O's history behind 2012 (56) and 1987 (55)...The most long balls through Baltimore's first 36 games of a season is 57 by the 2012 and 1987 teams; the Birds also hit 55 homers through the first 36 games in 2016.

♫ The Orioles have an MLB-best eight players with at least five homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (10), **Colton Cowser**, **Cedric Mullins**, and **Jordan Westburg** (6), and **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Ryan O'Hearn**, **Adley Rutschman**, and **Anthony Santander** (5); the Padres and Yankees rank second with five players apiece.

**BIG TIME RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** enters today tied for third in the AL in hits (46) and fifth in batting average (.322)...He is tied for the AL lead and tied for second in MLB in multi-hit games (15).

♫ Rutschman has hit safely in six straight games since May 2, 16 of 17 since April 19, and 21 of his last 23 since April 11; for the season, he has a hit in 28 of his 34 games and has reached safely in 29 of those.

♫ Since April 19, he's slashing .365/.382/.581 (27-for-74) with four doubles, four homers, eight runs, 15 RBI, two walks, and a stolen base; during that time, he leads the AL in batting average, hits, and total bases (43), and tied for second in the AL in RBI.

♫ He had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

**ON THE PLACES YOU'LL GO:** The Birds are on a five-game road trip with three games in Cincinnati (3-0) and two in Washington (0-1)...The club had scheduled off day on Monday and will have another tomorrow...At 11-5 (.688) away from home, the Orioles are tied for the best road record in MLB with the Dodgers and Phillies.

♫ Since the start of 2023, Baltimore has the best road mark in MLB at 63-34 (.649).

**BATTLE OF THE BELTWAYS:** The O's and Nats complete their brief two-game set at Nationals Park tonight, the first of two series between the teams this season...The Birds will host the Nationals at Oriole Park for two games from August 13-14.

♫ Baltimore had won seven in a row against Washington, the longest winning streak against the Nats in club history; the O's hold a 7-2 record against the Nationals since 2022.

♫ The O's went 4-0 against the Nats last year, sweeping the season series for the first time since the teams first met in 2006.

♫ Orioles pitchers have not allowed more than three runs to the Nats in any of the nine games since the start of 2022...O's hurlers have a 1.40 ERA (12 ER/77.0 IP) over that period.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's have claimed both awards in the same month...The last MLB team to do so was the Dodgers in August 2023: Mookie Betts (Player) and James Outman (Rookie)...The last occurrence among AL teammates was the Guardians in April 2022: José Ramírez (Player) and Steven Kwan (Rookie).

**SCHEDULE CHANGES:** The following game times have been changed:  
 ♫ Sunday, July 14 vs. New York-AL has moved to 11:35 a.m. from 1:35 p.m.  
 ♫ Sunday, September 8 vs. Tampa Bay has moved to 12:05 p.m. from 1:35 p.m.

**MINOR LEAGUE AWARDS:** Infielder **Coby Mayo** (Norfolk) and left-handed pitcher **Cade Povich** (Norfolk) were named the Orioles Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for April, respectively...Mayo is ranked by *MLB Pipeline* as Baltimore's No. 3 prospect and the No. 26 overall prospect, while Povich is ranked as Baltimore's No. 9 prospect and the club's No. 2 pitching prospect.

♫ Mayo slashed .330/.400/.652 (38-for-115) with six doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 21 runs, 25 RBI, 12 walks, and a 1.052 OPS in 28 March/April games.

♫ Povich made five starts in April, pitching to a 2-1 record with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and 40 strikeouts; also named the International League Pitcher of the Month.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 338 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his second start of the season and first road start against Washington tonight...Made his season debut last Thursday vs. New York-AL...Began the year on the 15-day Injured List with a right UCL sprain...Made three rehab starts, one with Double-A Bowie and two with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts and four walks...Earned the win in his final rehab appearance with the Tides on April 26 vs. Gwinnett; allowed one run on five hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 quality starts) for the O's in 2023 and finished fourth for the AL Cy Young; became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992...Spent time on the Injured List with a right foot contusion from April 5-19 after being struck by a comebacker in the second inning of his season debut on April 3 at Texas... Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

**NATIONAL SECURITY:** Making his third career start against the Nationals tonight...Is 2-0 and has not allowed a run in 14.0 innings in two prior starts against Washington... Completed 8.0 shutout frames against the Nats on September 26, 2023 at Oriole Park, his third career 8.0+ scoreless start.

**BEAST OF THE NL EAST:** Has gone 3-1 with a 1.91 ERA (8 ER/37.2 IP) across six career starts against the NL East...Marks his second lowest ERA against any division behind the AL West (1.22)...Opponents slashed .195/.282/.278 (26-for-133) off him last season...Has not surrendered a run against Miami (7.1 IP), New York-NL (4.2 IP), or Washington in his career.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Bradish owned a 3.33 ERA (34 ER/92.0 IP) in 17 starts on the road last year...Surrendered two earned runs or fewer in each of his final five road starts of the 2023 campaign.

**NIGHT OWL:** Slated to make his first night start of the season...Went 9-6 with a 3.44 ERA (41 ER/107.1 IP) across his 19 night starts in 2023...Opponents slashed .229/.283/.364 (92-for-401) off him at night, compared to the .187/.260/.266 (40-for-214) slash line that hitters produced in 12 day starts.

**HE'S A BRAD MAN:** Bradish led the O's in nearly every pitching category last season, including ERA (2.83), strikeouts (168), opponent batting average (.215), on-base percentage (.275), OPS (.605), WHIP (1.04), and quality starts (18).

**COUNT 'EM UP:** Bradish finished the 2023 campaign with a career-high 168 strikeouts, the most by an O's hurler since Dylan Bundy fanned 184 batters in 2018.

**HIGH QUALITY:** Bradish logged five straight quality starts from August 6 to September 8, the longest such streak of his career...The last longer streak by an Oriole was Alex Cobb's six-gamer from July 26 to August 24, 2018...Bradish's 18 quality starts this year led the O's and were a career high; the last O's hurler with more than 18 such outings was Dylan Bundy, who logged 19 quality starts in 2017.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster...Finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, earning six, third-place, eight, fourth-place, and five, fifth-place votes; marked the highest finish by an Orioles hurler since Zack Britton finished fourth in 2016...Ended the campaign ranked among qualified MLB leaders in ERA and WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), as well as opponent batting average (7<sup>th</sup>, .215), and among qualified AL leaders in opponent average (2<sup>nd</sup>), ERA (3<sup>rd</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), and winning percentage (T-8<sup>th</sup>, .632)...Had a 16.0-inning scoreless streak to end the regular season.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut as the starter in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. TEX; dealt the loss after allowing two runs on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings; became the third player in O's history (since 1954) to strike out at least nine batters in his Postseason debut, joining Mike Boddicker (14, September 6, 1983 vs. CWS - ALCS G2) and Moe Drabowsky (11, September 5, 1966 at LAD - WS G1).
