Emmet Sheehan (LAD) tossed three shutout innings for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Monday, allowing no hits. After one day of AFL action, Sheehan and Bryan Woo are the only AFL pitchers with a 0.00 ERA and three or more innings pitched.

Jordan Lawlar (ARI) went 2-for-3 on Monday with a three-run home run for the Salt River Rafters. MLB Pipeline's 13th-ranked overall prospect, Lawlar scored three runs and reached base safely in four of his five plate appearances.

Kumar Rocker (TEX) is scheduled to make his AFL debut with the Surprise Saguaros this evening in his team's home opener. The thirdoverall selection in the 2022 draft, Rocker will face a Peoria Javelinas team that scored five runs in a Monday win over Glendale.

Nomar Garciaparra (Scottsdale Scorpions, 1994) was drafted in the first round of the 1994 MLB Draft out of Georgia Tech, making his way to the Fall League just months after the end of his collegiate career to play under manager Terry Francona. Garciaparra made his MLB debut in 1996; the right-handed-hitting infielder went on to appear in 1,434 career MLB games, collecting over 1,700 hits, 229 home runs and posting a career .313/.361/.521 batting slash.
