- He ranked in Washington's system in wins (T2nd, 7), strikeouts (3rd, 132), WHIP (3rd, 1.22), opponents average (4th, .243) and innings (T4th, 123.0) in 2025.
- Finished the 2025 season 7-10 with a 4.61 ERA (63 ER/123.0 IP), 32 strikeouts, 38 walks and a .243 average against.
- Entered the 2025 season as the No. 21 prospect in the system, *per MLB Pipeline.com*.

LAST START

In his most recent start on Aug. 5 against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, he tossed 5.2 innings of one-run ball, allowing just three hits while striking out five.

DOWN ON THE FARM

Kent joins the Nationals after going 9-4 with a 3.72 ERA and 105 strikeouts in 20 starts (94.1 IP) between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester.

- He leads Washington's Minor League system in opponents' on-base percentage (.277) and opponents' average (.216)...He ranks second in winning percentage (.692) and WHIP (1.12).
- The opponents' on-base percentage ranks ninth in all of Minor League Baseball, while the opponents' average and WHIP rank 11th.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW, KID

By making the start on Wednesday, Kent will become the 31st starting pitcher originally signed or drafted and developed by the Nationals to start a game for the team (since 2005).

Entered the season with High-A Wilmington before making his Double-A Harrisburg debut on August 14, 2025.

- Made 18 appearances (18 GS) with High-A Wilmington and pitched to a 4.31 ERA (45 ER/94.0 IP) with a 5-7 record.
- His best start of the season came on April 12 when he allowed one hit and struck out nine over 5.0 shutout innings, for which he earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week.
- His 18.5% strikeout-to-walk rate was the best in Washington's Minor League system.
- Made six appearances (6 GS) with Double-A Harrisburg and pitched to a 5.59 ERA (18 ER/29.0 IP) with 35 strikeouts.
