**THE TWINS:** Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2, going 2-1 vs. Boston last weekend and 3-1 against Seattle this week...tonight, Minnesota will start a short roadtrip with three at Rogers Centre over the weekend.

☞ Twins have won 15 of their last 17 games...since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (15-2), ahead of the Dodgers (13-2) and Phillies (12-4).

☞ Twins are looking to extend their road winning streak to seven games...the last time they won at least seven straight away games was August 15-30, 2019, when they won eight straight...their last road loss was on April 17, a 4-2 walk-off defeat in Baltimore.

☞ Minnesota enters today at their 2024 high-water mark of seven games over .500, their highest since finishing the 2023 season 12 games over (.87-75).

**TWINS DOMINATE IN HOME FINALE:** The Twins beat the Mariners yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 11-1, which included a five-run first inning off M's starter Logan Gilbert...Pablo López (4-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with no walks and 10 strikeouts — his seventh career double-digit strikeout total...the offense recorded 11 hits, highlighted by home runs from Ryan Jeffers (8) and Max Kepler (3)...Manny Margot tied his career-high with five RBI, including a bases-clearing three-run double in the first inning...yesterday marked the ninth time for the Twins to reach double-digit hit totals in their last 17 games.

**NEEDED IN MINNEAPOLIS:** Yesterday's win marked the Twins fifth consecutive series victory...a few numbers from the four-game series with Seattle:

☞ Twins outscored the Mariners 26-15 over the four games.

☞ Twins pitchers struck out 53 batters, setting a club record for a four-game series, passing the previous high of 46, done earlier this year in Detroit from April 12-14.

☞ Starters went 2-0, 1.59 ERA (22.2 IP, 4 ER) with four XBH, three walks and 35 strikeouts.

☞ Mariners staff entered the series having allowed just 15 earned runs in their previous 15 games, as the Twins scored 19 earned runs in the four games.

**STARTERS ON STRIKE:** Chris Paddack (Wednesday) and Pablo López (yesterday) each struck out 10 batters, marking the first time for Twins starters to fan 10-plus in back-to-back outings since Sonny Gray (13) and Joe Ryan (10) did it from April 7-8, 2023 vs. the Astros...Twins have never had three consecutive games with 10-plus strikeouts from their starters.

**O CANADA:** The Twins went 3-3 against the Blue Jays during the regular season in 2023, going 1-2 at Target Field from May 26-28 and 2-1 at Toronto from June 9-11.

☞ Twins have gone 8-4 in their last 12 games at Rogers Centre.

☞ In 27 regular season games vs. Toronto, Carlos Correa is hitting .311 (33-for-106) with six doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a .958 OPS in 27 games vs. the Jays...he hit a go-ahead grand slam in the second game of the three-game series here last season...he has reached base safely against the Jays in the regular season in 12 consecutive games...two of his 11 career two-homer games have come in this stadium (July 9, 2017 and June 4, 2021).

☞ Québec City native Edouard Julien is 6-for-17 (.353) with four doubles, one home run, five walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.265 OPS in five career regular season games against Toronto...he grew up a Blue Jays fan.

☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.211 OPS in seven career games vs. Toronto...he hit two home runs in his first career game here on June 3, 2022, both off Yusei Kikuchi.

**SPLIT OPEN AND MELT:** These two teams met in the 2023 AL Wild Card Series at Target Field as the Twins swept in two, taking Game 1 on October 3 by a score of 3-1 and Game 2 by a score of 2-0...the Game 1 win snapped an MLB playoff record 18-game losing streak...the series win marked Minnesota's first since the 2002 ALDS series victory over Oakland.

☞ During that series, Carlos Correa went 3-for-7 (.429) with one RBI.

☞ The Twins faced Yusei Kikuchi in Game 2, who entered in relief of starter José Berríos...Berríos allowed just one run on three hits in 3.0 innings pitched and struck out five...Kikuchi entered with Royce Lewis on first base, loaded the bases, then allowed a Carlos Correa RBI single...Willi Castro batted next and grounded into a double play, scoring another run — proved to be the difference in the 2-0 series-clinching victory.

**LAND OF 10,000 R-EH?-KES:** Twins have homered in 17-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 36 total homers in those 17...below are the longest homer streaks in an opposing park in Twins history (since 1961):

**MAXING OUT:** Max Kepler enters tonight with a career-high 11-game hitting streak (previous best was 10 G)...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .434 (23-for-53) with eight doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 14 RBI, a .492 on-base percentage and a 1.247 OPS in 16 games.

☞ Kepler's streak is the longest by a Twin this season and longest by a Twin since Ryan Jeffers hit in 14 straight from July 15-August 9, 2023.

☞ Kepler's 11-game hitting streak is the second-longest active hitting streak in baseball, trailing Jake Cronenworth (12 G).

☞ Since June 30, 2023, Kepler is hitting .307 (104-for-339) with a .918 OPS in 96 games...fifth-best OPS in baseball since that date (minimum of 350 plate appearances).

**CATCHING ON:** Ryan Jeffers is hitting .370 (20-for-54) with eight doubles, five home runs, 17 RBI, five walks, a .446 on-base percentage, a .796 slugging percentage and a 1.242 OPS in his last 16 games, since April 22...Jeffers has reached base safely in a career-high 16-straight, the longest for a Twin since Edouard Julien reached in 23 straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...Jeffers has driven in 17 runs in his last 13 games overall.

**UNF-ARM-ILIAR SIDE:** Twins hitters are slashing .287/.341/.453 with a .794 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .226/.301/.399 with a .709 OPS vs. right-handed pitching. ☞ In their last 12 games vs. lefties, they are slashing .370/.409/.572 (.982 OPS).

**RIP, SEAN BURROUGHS:** Former Twins third baseman Sean Burroughs passed away yesterday at age 44...Sean finished his seven-year major league career with the Twins in 2012, playing in 10 games for Minnesota that season.

- ☞ Making his second career start against Toronto...made his last start against Boston on May 5, a 9-2 Twins defeat...earned his second loss of the season allowing three runs on four hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings.
- ☞ Recorded a career-high 12 strikeouts on April 13 against the Tigers.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took his second loss of the season in his last start on May 5 vs. Boston, allowing three runs on four hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...recorded his third-straight quality start and team-leading fifth of the season...was perfect through 3.0 innings before Jarren Duran's leadoff double in the fourth...allowed a Rob Refsnyder RBI double that drove in Boston's first run...allowed two more runs on Ceddanne Rafaela's fifth-inning home run...four of his five strikeouts came on 4-seam fastballs (three swinging, one looking); the pitch generated seven whiffs on 25 swings (28.0%)...now owns a 3.54 ERA (40.2 IP, 16 ER) this season and has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his seven starts.

- ☞ Enters sixth among qualified American League pitchers with a 7.67 strikeout-to-walk ratio...is also eighth by averaging 10.18 strikeouts-per-nine innings.
- ☞ Leads the Twins with five quality starts this season, tied for fifth most in the AL.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Made the start on April 29 at Chicago-AL, recording his second-straight quality start and the 30th of his career...allowed two runs on six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Ryan allowed two runs in the first inning on an Andrew Vaughn double and a Eloy Jiménez double play that plated Vaughn...four of the six hits he allowed came in the first inning...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings after the first, allowing just three hits over that span, with one walk and three strikeouts.

**AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS:** Facing the Toronto Blue Jays for the second time in his career tonight...took a no-decision on June 10, 2023 at Rogers Centre, allowing three runs on six hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings; Twins won, 9-4...Blue Jays hitters have hit .273 (6-for-22) with two doubles and a .684 OPS.

- ☞ Has faced nine current Blue Jays hitters.

**ON THE ROAD:** Through three road starts in 2024, Ryan has tossed 17.1 innings with 15 hits allowed, three walks, 20 strikeouts and one home run - Kerry Carpenter's two-run shot on April 13, when Ryan recorded his career-high 12 strikeouts...has yet to win or lose a game on the road.

- ☞ In 32 career road starts, he is 12-10, 4.27 ERA (172.2 IP, 82 ER), 160 hits, 41 walks and 182 strikeouts...Twins are 19-13 in Ryan's 32 road starts.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 12 home wins...behind him are Griffin Jax (9) and former teammate Sonny Gray (8).
- ☞ Tonight marks his second career major league start outside of the United States.
- ☞ Has allowed five home runs this year...only one has come on the road.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .259/.302/.70 with five extra-base hits, including one home run, four walks and 23 strikeouts in 86 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .189/.211/.419 with five doubles, four home runs, two walks and 23 strikeouts in 76 plate appearances.

- ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .214 (146-for-683) 28 doubles, four triples and 21 home runs with a .640 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .237 (175-for-739) with 44 doubles, no triples and 40 home runs with a .737 OPS.
- ☞ In one game vs. Ryan, Blue Jay left-handed hitters have hit .500 (2-for-4), with one double, no walks and no strikeouts...right-handed hitters have hit .222 (4-for-18) one double, one walk and four strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in his seven starts this season, with sinkers all coming in the first three outings...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 71.1 percent of the time in his last start against the Red Sox...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ In his last start against Boston, threw his 4-seam fastball 29 times to left-handed hitters...Boston lefty hitters went (1-for-7), with three strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball.
- ☞ Right-handed hitters are hitting .182 (6-for-33) with two home runs and 10 strikeouts against the fastball in 2024.

**RUNNERS ON:** With runners on scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .357 (10-for-28), with two home run, one walk and four strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .178 (19-for-107) with two home runs, four walks and 37 strikeouts.

**NIGHT NIGHT:** Making his fourth night start of the year...has gone 1-0, 4.15 ERA (17.1 IP, 8 ER) with three walks, 17 strikeouts and a .258 (17-for-66) opponent batting average in his prior three outings...went 5-5, 5.24 ERA (87.2 IP, 53 ER) with 18 walks, 109 strikeouts and a .267 (92-for-344) opponent batting average in 16 night starts in 2023...is 12-10, 3.12 ERA (161.2 IP, 56 ER), .206 BAA in 29 career day starts, compared to 15-11, 4.66 ERA (214.1 IP, 111 ER), .240 BAA in 39 career night starts.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Enters tonight with 419 career strikeouts, already 33rd in Twins history (1961-present)...next up is Pete Redfern in 32nd place with 426.

**HEART OF THE ORDER? NO PROBLEM:** Opposing hitters 4-6 in the lineup are hitting a combined .163 (9-for-55) with 13 strikeouts, no walks and just two extra-base hits (one double and one home run) against Ryan this season.

**QUALITY STARTER:** Recorded his third-straight quality start and team-leading fifth of the season in his last start on May 4 vs. Boston...has allowed three or fewer runs in each of his last seven starts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
