Second baseman **Jeff Kent** will be officially inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, NY on Sunday. The best years of his 17-year Major League career came with the Giants from 1997-2002, when he posted a 31.6 of his career 55.4 bWAR as one of the pillars of the Giants' offense. He was a three-time All-Star, the 2000 NL MVP and won three of his four Silver Slugger awards as a Giant.

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to snap their five-game losing streak with a win in tonight's second-half home opener...SF won its first game out of the break over Seattle before dropping each of its next five games on the trip that also saw a sweep at Kansas City.

- ▶ At 42-60 (.412), SF has the third-lowest win percentage in MLB ahead of only the Angels (41-62, .398) and Rockies (41-63, .394).
- ▶ SF is currently 18 games under .500, which is the franchise's most games under .500 since ending the 2017 season 34 games under.
- ▶ SF's 60 losses through its first 102 games are its most since losing 63 of the first 102 games in 2017...the Giants have had 60+ losses through 102 games just two other times in the SF era (since 1958), also doing so in 1984 and 1985 (both 62 losses).

VS. THE ANGELS: The Giants are 3-6 vs. the Angels since the start of the 2023 season, going 1-2 at Angel Stadium in 2025.

- ▶ Even so, the Giants are 28-20 (.583) all-time vs. the Angels...the .583 winning percentage vs. LAA is SF's third-best against all active teams, behind only its mark vs. the Guardians (17-10, .630) and Rangers (29-18, .617).
- ▶ SF faces Interleague opponents in eight of its 11 series following the All-Star break, also visiting the Rangers, Guardians and Red Sox and hosting the Tigers and Astros within the next month...SF's 9-18 (.333) Interleague record is lowest in the Majors this season.
- ▶ Giants **IF Rafael Devers** is 4-for-5 with three RBI and a walk in his career vs. Angels starter Grayson Rodriguez...**OF Heliot Ramos** is a career .400 (10x25) hitter vs. the Angels with three runs, three doubles, two home runs and six RBI in six games.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP **Logan Webb** is set to make his second start of the second half...one swing spoiled an otherwise solid outing last time out (July 18 at Seattle) for the 2026 All-Star as Webb allowed three runs (all coming on a homer by Cole Young) over 6.2 innings.

- ▶ Webb's most-used pitch is his sinker (30.4% usage rate)...the pitch has a +10 run value, which is tied for the fifth-most valuable sinker in MLB this season...the Angels have a .703 OPS vs. sinkers this season (last in MLB).
- ▶ Former teammate Jorge Soler is 2-for-17 (.118) with a home run and 11 strikeouts in his career vs. Webb...Mike Trout is 0-for-3 with three strikeouts vs. Webb.

CLOSE CALLS: SF had an even run differential despite going 1-5 on the trip with four of its five losses being decided by one run.

- ▶ The Giants are 9-16 (.360) in one-run games this season (28th in MLB)...their 16 one-run losses are two shy of the MLB lead held by the Angels and the Mets.
- ▶ SF has held the lead in each of its last five games...the five-game losing streak when holding a lead at any point in the game is tied for the team's longest in the SF era (also August 25-29, 1991 and April 12-18, 2023) per *Stats, LLC*.

TURN THE TIDE: SF has struggled to both hold onto leads and come from behind after the 6th inning in 2026...the Giants are 32-11 (.744) when leading after the 6th inning...the .744 winning percentage is lowest in MLB... Detroit is second-lowest with a 38-13 (.745) mark.

- ▶ Conversely, SF is 1-43 (.023) when trailing after the 6th inning, which is also the lowest such winning percentage in MLB, with the next closest team being Texas (2-47, 0.41).

20/20: IF Casey Schmitt hit his 20th homer of the season on Wednesday...the Giants now have two players at the 20-homer mark in Schmitt and **IF Rafael Devers**, with **IF Willy Adames** not far behind (18 home runs).

- ▶ Schmitt and Devers are the first Giants to reach the 20-homer mark before SF's 103rd game since **Barry Bonds** did so with 20 homers in 2007...the last time SF had two players with 20+ homers through 102 games was 2000 (Bonds with 32 and **Jeff Kent** with 24).
- ▶ With two more homers, Adames would become the fifth primary shortstop to hit 20+ homers in six straight seasons, joining Cal Ripken (10, 1982-1991), Alex Rodriguez (8, 1996-2003), Miguel Tejada (8, 1999-2006) and Ernie Banks (7, 1955-1961) (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ The Giants have scored 185 runs since June 1, with 94 coming via a home run (50.8%)... the 50.8% mark is fifth-highest in MLB over that span.

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Saturday in Seattle after tossing 6.2 innings with three runs on two hits, a walk and five strikeouts....gave up a homer for the third straight start, marking his first time surrendering a home run in three consecutive starts since 2023...batters were 1-for-5 off his sweeper with three strikeouts and are 2-for-their-last-11 in at-bats ending with the pitch.

AL WEST: Has pitched at least 5.0 innings while allowing three or fewer runs in each of his last 17 starts against AL West opponents...according to *Stats, LLC*, it marks the longest such streak by any MLB pitcher against that division since **Pedro Martínez** had 21 in a row from 1998 to 2001...Webb is 10-1 with a 2.05 ERA over the last 16 of those starts.

VS. LOS ANGELES-AL: Will face the Angels for just the third time in his career and first time here at Oracle Park...Webb has a 1.54 ERA (2er, 11.2ip) with no walks and a 0.94 WHIP in the two starts vs. LAA, striking out a whopping 18 batters in 11.2 innings of work (13.89 SO/9ip)...last faced them on April 18 of last season at Angel Stadium, when he was handed the loss despite matching a career-best 12 strikeouts...Webb tossed 6.0 innings in the start and gave up two runs (one earned) on four hits in SF's 2-0 loss.

DOG DAYS OF SUMMER: Following a stellar month of June that saw him earn NL Pitcher of the Month honors, Webb is now is 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (15er, 16.2ip), four HRs and a 1.38 WHIP in three starts this month.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Was named an All-Star for a third consecutive season...the righty became the first Giants pitcher with three straight All-Star nominations since **Madison Bumgarner**, who made four straight All-Stars appearances from 2013-2016.

JUNE BLOOM: Was named NL Pitcher of the Month in June after leading all MLB pitchers with a 0.71 ERA (3er, 38.0ip) in five starts...went 3-1 in the month with a .148 opposing average, .370 OPS, 0.61 WHIP and a complete game on his way to earn his first career monthly honors...Webb had the lowest ERA of any Giant in a month (min. 20ip) since **Noah Lowry**, who had a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005.

GUESS WHO'S BACK: Since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29, Webb is 3-3 with a 2.90 ERA (19er, 59.0ip), 0.88 WHIP and a .187 BAA in nine starts...Webb landed on the IL on May 9 and missed 20 games with right knee bursitis in what was his first trip to the injured list since October 2022 (low back strain).

STAY GROUNDED: Has a 52.0% ground ball rate this season, fifth-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (57.6%), STL's Andre Pallante (55.6%), DET's Framber Valdez (52.6%) and LAA's José Soriano (52.4%).

HOME, SWEET HOME: Has a 3.74 ERA (22er, 53.0ip) and .599 opposing OPS in eight starts at Oracle Park, compared to a 4.00 ERA and .659 OPS in nine starts on the road...since 2021, Webb's 2.76 ERA at home is sixth-best in the Majors (min. 50 GS).

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 5-12 in Webb's 17 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago (they were 16-17 in his 33 starts in '24)...since 2022, SF as a team is 72-77 in Webb's 149 starts, yet his 3.29 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).

▶ Is scheduled to face the Angels for the six time in his career...is 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9er, 32.0ip) with 38 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP over his five starts...he hasn't faced the Angels since 2022 when he faced them four time.
