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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a nine-game road trip tonight against the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (3 to play), and Rockies (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays...The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and 3.0 games behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

👉 Yesterday, **Gunnar Henderson** tallied an RBI double in the eighth inning, cutting St. Louis' lead to 6-5...It marked his first RBI since August 14, snapping a career-high-tying 11-game stretch without an RBI (also 9/29/24-4/16/25).

👉 **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .360/.392/.480 (27-for-75) with six doubles, one home run, 13 runs, and nine RBI over his last 18 road games.

👉 **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** has recorded an extra-base hit in three straight games, one shy of his career-best four-game run from April 16-June 8, 2025...It is tied for the second-longest active streak in MLB behind CWS' Tristan Peters (5 G).

BRANDON'S BOUNCEBACK: **Brandon Young** is 9-3 (.750) this year, with the Birds going 17-5 across his 22 starts...According to *STATS Perform*, after going 1-7 (.125) in 2025, his +.625 increase in winning percentage would be the largest in MLB history from a pitcher's first major league season to his second (min. 10 GS each season)...The record currently belongs to George "Stump" Weidman, who went 0-9 in 1880 with the Buffalo Bisons and 8-5 in 1881 with the Detroit Wolverines (+.615).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Orioles have homered in 15 straight games, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Cardinals (10 G) and Giants (8 G)...It marks Baltimore's longest streak since going deep in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024.

👉 Baltimore has homered in a season-high nine straight road games (also 4/17-5/2), its longest streak since an 11-game stretch from August 4-27, 2024.

👉 The O's have hit multiple home runs in eight of their last 11 road games (22 HR total).
👉 Overall, the Birds have hit 30 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (31).

A+ GRADES: In 24 career games against the Athletics, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .344/.410/.600 (31-for-90) with seven doubles, two triples, four home runs, 18 runs, 13 RBI, seven walks, five steals, and three hit-by-pitches.

👉 Despite a current 1-for-20 (.050) skid against the A's over his last five games, **Pete Alonso** owns a 1.152 OPS in 15 career games against the club...He reached base safely in each of his first 10 career games opposite the Athletics, going 18-for-39 (.462) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 runs, and 17 RBI.

SOUTHPAW SPEAK: **Coby Mayo** is slashing .307/.363/.746 (35-for-114) with eight doubles, 14 home runs, and 28 RBI against left-handed pitching, ranking among MLB in slugging percentage (1st), OPS (1st, 1.109), and home runs (T-1st).

👉 **Pete Alonso** is 11-for-25 (.440) with one double, three home runs, and eight RBI against lefties since August 9.

👉 **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with two doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, and a 1.136 OPS off southpaws this season...He went 3-for-5 with a double and home run during the last series in St. Louis following an 0-for-8 skid.

👉 **Jackson Holliday** is 9-for-25 (.360) with three doubles against left-handed pitching since August 9 after opening the season 8-for-39 (.205) with one double and one homer.

POLAR BEAR ROARING: **Pete Alonso** enters play today with 91 RBI, tied for the AL lead with HOU's Yordan Alvarez...Alonso looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 Through 24 games in August, Alonso is slashing .374/.430/.703 (34-for-91) with three doubles, nine home runs, 22 RBI, and a 1.133 OPS...The .374 batting average would signal his highest in any month of his career (min. 25 AB in month), surpassing April 2025 (.358, 34-for-95)...His career high for hits in a month came in August 2025 (36).

ROAD TRIPPING: Since the All-Star Break, the O's are averaging 5.55 run per game on the road, the second-highest figure in the majors behind the Cubs (6.42)...Prior to the break, the Birds averaged 4.32 runs per game away from Camden Yards, ranking 18th in the majors.

👉 Among all qualified MLB hitters following the All-Star Break, **Pete Alonso's** 1.108 OPS on the road is second highest behind CHC's Alex Bregman (1.130), while **Christian Encarnacion-Strand's** 1.010 OPS ranks sixth.

'PEN PALS: **Yennier Cano** has gone 44 consecutive appearances (33.2 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (60 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (51 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (47 G).

👉 **Alex Hoppe** has not allowed a hit in a career-best four straight appearances and has not permitted a run across 7.1 innings since making his club debut on August 5.

👉 Over the last seven games since August 20, Oriole relievers have pitched to a 0.78 ERA (2 ER/23.0 IP).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 42-46 (.477) in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the fourth-most such games in the league this season and 20th in winning percentage in those situations this year.

👉 Despite owning a 14-19 (.424) in one-run affairs this season, the Birds are 4-1 in their last five such games since August 14.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 34 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least six pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).

👉 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.

👉 The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 23rd start of the season and the 35th of his career...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on August 22 vs. Tampa Bay after throwing 5.2 innings, allowing two runs on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts...Threw 84 pitches, 48 strikes.
⚡ Has permitted seven home runs over his last five starts (25.2 IP) after allowing six home runs over his previous 14 outings (83.0 IP).

GOING OUT WEST: Young made his lone career start against the Athletics on August 9, 2025 at Camden Yards and took the loss, allowing six runs on six hits (2 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts over 3.0 innings.

SWEET VICTORY: The Orioles have won 17 of Young's 22 starts this season after going 3-9 in his 12 outings last season...That included a seven-game winning streak from May 6-June 10, over which he went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.
⚡ Young is 9-3 (.750) in 22 starts this season...The .750 winning percentage is third highest in the AL (min. 15 GS) behind BOS' Sonny Gray (.800, 16-4) and TB's Nick Martinez (.765, 13-4).
⚡ According to *STATS Perform*, after going 1-7 (.125) in 2025, his +.625 increase in winning percentage would be the largest in MLB history from a pitcher's first major league season to his second (min. 10 GS each season)...The record currently belongs to George "Stump" Weidman, who went 0-9 in 1880 with the Buffalo Bisons and 8-5 in 1881 with the Detroit Wolverines (+.615).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Young is 7-1 (.875) with a 3.67 ERA (22 ER/54.0 IP) across 10 road starts in 2026, with the Birds going 8-2 in those games...His .875 road winning percentage is tied with TOR's Dylan Cease (also .875, 7-1) for the third-highest mark in MLB (min. 10 GS) behind both PHI's Jesús Luzardo (1.000, 8-0) and STL's Andre Pallante (1.000, 7-0).

FASTBALL FOCUS: Opponents are slashing .219/.316/.366 (40-for-183) off his four-seam fastball with six doubles, seven home runs, 25 walks, and 33 strikeouts...However, Young allowed a career-high six hits on the pitch in his August 17 at Tampa Bay, including a career-high two home runs.
⚡ His average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is the sixth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB, including the highest by a starting pitcher.
⚡ Opponents are slashing .329/.400/.506 (28-for-85) on his sinker with three doubles, four home runs, nine walks, and 10 strikeouts.

WHIFFIN': Young recorded a 9.00 K/9.0 IP from June 21-July 31, tallying five or more strikeouts in a career-high seven consecutive starts...However, holds a 6.30 K/9.0 IP with four or fewer strikeouts in each of his three outings this month...Opened the season with a 6.35 K/9.0 IP over his first 11 starts with five or more strikeouts in five of those games.
⚡ On June 27 at Washington, recorded a career-high 23 swings and misses...The 23 whiffs were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Kyle Gibson (also 23) on July 9, 2023 at Minnesota.
⚡ He has tallied 33 of his 99 strikeouts (33.3%) this season on his slider, which opponents are whiffing at 41.6 percent of the time... The 41.7 percent whiff rate is the second-best mark among AL starters (min. 200 sliders thrown) behind TOR's Dylan Cease (44.2%).

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.4 mph and 1,390 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last 16 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .254 (18-for-71) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, and 14 strikeouts to two walks...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles and two strikeouts to two walks.
