TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners conclude their 9-game road trip with the finale of 3 games against the Tampa Bay Rays ( $0-2$ )...Seattle also faced the Cleveland Guardians (1-2) and Miami Marlins (1-2) on the current trip...following the current series with the Rays, the Mariners return home for a 9-game, 11-day homestand against the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...today's game will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS with Dave Sims and Mike Blowers on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on Seattle Sports (710 AM) with Rick Rizzs and Aaron Goldsmith on the call.
ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped last night's game by an 11-3 score...despite losing 3 in a row and 6 of their last 7, the Mariners are 14-10 (.609) over their last 24 games ( $5 / 31-\mathrm{c}$ ) and 18-11 (.621) over their last 29 games (5/26-c).

- \#TexasVoteEm - MLB All-Star Voting is live, with the first phase of voting ending Thursday...you can vote for Mariners at Mariners.com/Vote...the 2024 All-Star Game is set for July 16 in Arlington, Texas.
- Series-ly Sensational - The Mariners own a 13-7-1 series record over their last 20 series (4/15-c).
- Hit 'Em Up - Seattle is 35-3 (.921) when out-hitting its opponent this season.
- Dirty Floors - The Mariners are looking to avoid being swept in a series for the first time this season... Seattle was last swept from Sept. 22-24, 2023 at Texas (3G) and suffered only 4 series sweeps during the 2023 season...Seattle is 1 of 4 teams this season that has yet to be swept in a series of $2+$ games, joining Cleveland, Philadelphia and New York-AL.
BEST IN THE WEST...the Mariners (45-37) hold 1st place in the American League West Division by 4.5 games over the 2nd place Houston Astros (39-40) and 6.5 games over the 3rd place Texas Rangers (3742)...the Mariners have held 1 st place for 45 consecutive days ( $5 / 12-\mathrm{c}$ ).

HOMEWARD BOUND...following today's road trip finale, the Mariners return to T-Mobile Park, where they hold the best home record in the American League with a mark of 27-12 (.692), trailing only Philadelphia (21-12/.721) for best in MLB...Mariners pitchers have been close to unhittable at T-Mobile Park, leading MLB in nearly every home category, including ERA (2.54), WHIP (0.92), SO/BB (4.77) and opp. AVG (.195)... Seattle has won 9 consecutive home series and is $13-2$ over its last 15 home games (5/15-c).
HOT SAUCE...Mitch Garver has homered in back-to-back games, while hitting safely in each of his last 3 games...overall during the month of June, Garver holds an . 857 OPS, while racking up 10 extra-base hits (5 2B, 5 HR ) and 17 RBI...his . 857 OPS during the month leads Mariners batters (min. 30 PA), ranking ahead of Luke Raley (.838), Dominic Canzone (.835) and Ryan Bliss (.831).
CONNECT FOUR...the Mariners are 35-6 (.854) this season when scoring $4+$ runs in a game, as opposed to 10-31 (.244) when scoring 3-or-fewer runs...Seattle's .854 winning percentage when dialing up $4+$ runs is best in the Majors...it is also on pace to be the 2nd-best record when scoring 4+ runs in franchise history, trailing only the 2001 Mariners (.886/101-13).
ALL-STAR ROTATION...the Mariners starting rotation has several All-Star candidates...Logan Gilbert leads the American Leaque in WHIP (0.89) and ranks T-1st in quality starts (13), 2nd in innings pitched (106.1), 3rd in opponent batting average (.196), 7th in ERA (2.71) and 10th in strikeouts (99)...George Kirby ranks 2nd in the Majors (and AL) in strikeout-to-walk ratio (9.89) and walks-per-9 innings (0.9), trailing only Zach Eflin-TB in both...Kirby's 0.99 WHIP ranks 8th in the AL...Luis Castillo's 100 strikeouts rank T-8th in the AL, while Bryce Miller ranks 6th in opponent batting average (.205) and 10th in WHIP (1.04).
ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: WORTHY OF BEING AN AL ALL-STAR...right-hander Andrés Muñoz has 13 saves and a 1.41 ERA ( 5 ER, 32.0 IP ) with 43 strikeouts and 11 walks in 31 appearances this season...his next save will set a career-high, after he recorded 13 saves in 2023...this season, Muñoz has posted a 1.00 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a .184 batting average...the 25 -year-old is 1 of 2 American League pitchers with $13+$ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE...Muñoz has recorded 5 saves of 4+ outs, most in the Majors this season.
WE STAN FOR STANEK...Ryne Stanek has thrown 8 consecutive scoreless outings (6/10-c), going 1-0 with 3 saves and 2 holds during that span...the right-hander has 10 strikeouts and just 1 walk in those 8 appearances, limiting opponents to a .200 batting average ( $5 \times 25$ ) and .471 OPS.
WINNING MONTHS ...the Mariners would secure a winning month of June with 1 more win in the month. Seattle went 17-13 in March/April and 15-14 in May...Seattle is looking to secure 3 consecutive winning months to begin the season for the 5th time in franchise history (others: 2001-03, 2018).
MUÑOZ CHASING HISTORY...Andrés Muñoz is approaching 150 appearances with Seattle, entering today's action with 148 outings in a Mariners uniform...he holds a 2.39 ERA (39 ER, 146.2 IP) with 50 walks and 207 strikeouts in his Mariners career...Andrés has a chance to become the 7 th reliever in MLB history age 25-or-younger to post a sub-2.50 ERA with 200+ strikeouts over his first 150 appearances with a club...he would join Josh Hader-MIL (2.39 ERA, 347 K), Aroldis Chapman-CIN (2.20 ERA, 233 K), Kenley Jansen-LAD (2.21 ERA, 248 K), Craig Kimbrel-ATL (2.36 ERA, 258 K), Francisco Rodriguez-LAA (2.36 ERA, 259 K ) and Bruce Sutter-CHC ( 1.87 ERA, 268 K )....of that group Muñoz would be the first in MLB history to eclipse those numbers (sub-2.50 ERA/200+K), while also allowing fewer than 60 walks.
THE UPCOMING HOMESTAND...following the current road trip, the Mariners will return home for 9-game homestand from June 28-July 7, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...upcoming promotions on the homestand include J.P. Crawford "City Connect" Bobblehead Night on June 28, Aloha Shirt Night on June 29, Bark at the Park on July 2, Patriotic Fireworks on July 3 and Patriotic Cap on July 4
AS YOU MAY KNOW...George Kirby has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in each of his last 5 starts dating back to May 29 vs. Houston, going 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA ( 6 ER, 31.0 IP) with 3 walks and 32 strikeouts while holding opponents to a . 554 OPS during that span, but...DID YOU KNOW? ...George's 1.74 ERA during that stretch ( $5 / 29-\mathrm{c}$ ) ranks 3rd-best in MLB among qualified pitchers?...he trails only Hunter Brown-HOU (1.16 ERA) and Justin Steele-CHC (1.69 ERA)...overall this season, George ranks tied for 10th in the American League with 2.1 fWAR...Mariners teammate Logan Gilbert ranks just ahead of him, tied for 7th in the AL with 2.2 fWAR.

## ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY

- 26-year-old right-hander is making his 17 th start of the season, his 1st against Tampa Bay...he is also making his 73rd career start and 4th against the Rays.
- Is in his third season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB FirstYear Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
- Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record with 7 earned runs, 3 walks, 34 strikeouts and .263 opponent batting average in 5 games started.
- Named Colonial Athletic Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for Elon University after posting a 2.75 ERA and 19-8 record in 88.1 innings pitched across 14 games started.
LAST TIME OUT...ND on $6 / 21$ at Miami....he pitched 7.0 innings and allowed 2 runs (2 earned) on 5 hits (2 home runs) with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts... he has gone $5.0+$ innings in each of his last 13 outings, and 14 of 16 this season.
MID-SEASON FORM...over his last 5 starts (5/29-c) he has a 2-0 record with a 1.74 ERA (6 ER, 31.0 IP ) and 32 strikeouts to 3 walks...over that span, he has a 9.29 SO/9 with a 0.90 WHIP and 4 quality starts.
NL EXPERIENCE...he has made 5 starts against National League opposition this season with a $2-1$ record and a 2.61 ERA ( 9 ER, 31.0 IP ) in those outings...NL hitters are slashing .202/.222/.404 against Kirby with 33 strikeouts and 3 walks.
AGAINST THE RAYS...in 4 career outings against Tampa Bay, he has held batters to a .164 average..marks the 4th lowest opponent average against teams he has faced in his career.
NO JUNE GLOOM...in his first 4 starts in June, he has a 2-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (5 ER, 25.0 IP) and 24 strikeouts to 3 walks...his ERA is the 2nd lowest on the Mariners this month (min. 20 IP ), trailing Logan Gilbert with a 1.21 ERA.
NO FREE RIDES...is the only pitcher since 1900 (min. 50 GS) to have more games started than walks allowed ( 72 starts, 50 walks).
EMPTY BASES...the right-hander ranks 5th in the AL in opponent on-base percentage (.255) and 13th in the AL in WHIP this season (0.99)...both are career-bests for him...in 2023, he had a 1.04 WHIP and a . 270 OBP against.
TOP RANKS...in 2024, ranks 1st in the Major Leagues in BB/9 (0.87) and in SO/BB (9.89)...since his debut in 2022, he ranks 1st in MLB with 1.09 BB/9 (min. 400.0 IP )...Miles Mikolas-STL ranks 2nd during that span with a 1.73 BB/9 mark.
A LOT OF Os...did not allow a run in 17.0-consecutive innings from his start on $4 / 15$ vs. Cincinnati to allowing 1 run in the 4th inning against the Astros on $5 / 3$...it is the longest streak this season by a Mariners pitcher.
WALK THE WALK...among pitchers with at least 60.0 innings pitched this season, Kirby has the 2nd-fewest walks in the Majors with 9....his BB\% is $2.4 \%$, 2nd-best in MLB behind Zach Eflin-TB (1.8\%) and ranks in the 99th percentile of all Major League pitchers.
UNDER CONTROL....has not allowed more than 3 walks in any of his first 72 career starts...it is the 7th-longest streak in MLB history to start a career by a starting pitcher...has a 47-start streak with 2-or-less walks, the 2nd-longest active streak in the Majors (Zach Eflin-PHI/TB, 48).
QUALITY MATERIAL ...recorded his 9th quality start of the season in his last start at Miami...in 2023, had 20 starts of at least 6.0 innings while allowing 3 earned runs or fewer, which ranked T-5th in the Majors and T-3rd among AL pitchers.
LEADING BY EXAMPLE...since his MLB debut on $5 / 8 / 22$, he ranks among the top pitchers in the American League in various categories (min. 350 IP), including SO/BB (1st, 7.88), wins (T-2nd, 27), WHIP (3rd, 1.08), innings pitched (4th, 414.0), ERA (4th, 3.39) and strikeouts (6th, 394).
QUICK STARTER...this season, opposing hitters are batting . 140 (13x93) when leading off an inning with 4 extra-base hits ( 2 doubles and 2 home runs) and 22 strikeouts...the opposing hitters OBP is .158 in these situations.
END THE INNING...this season, opposing hitters are batting . 224 ( $26 \times 116$ ) with 3 doubles, 2 triples and 5 home runs and 27 strikeouts with 2 outs in an inning...with 2 outs and runners in scoring position, hitters are batting .231 ( $9 \times 39$ ) with 8 strikeouts.
GET A WHIFF OF THIS...earned a personal single-game career-high against Arizona on $4 / 27$ with 12 strikeouts...tallied 23 swings-and-missed during that start which also marked as a career-high, T-6th most whiffs in a start this season across MLB... 19 of his whiffs were fastballs.
MISSION CRITICAL...the Mariners own a 30-15 record in games that Kirby tosses at least 6.0 innings in his career...in games Kirby goes 5.2 innings or less, the Mariners are 11-16.
STRIKE 24...began his outing on $8 / 24 / 22$ vs. Washington by throwing 24 consecutive strikes, the most to start a game since the pitch tracking era ( 1988 -current), passing the 21 thrown by Joe Musgrove on $8 / 30 / 18$ vs. STL with PIT.
MARINERS HISTORY...made his 70th career start on $6 / 9$ at Kansas City....he ranks 6th in franchise history for strikeouts (383) through a pitcher's first 70 games in a Mariners uniform...he is 11 strikeouts away from reaching 400 in his career, he would be the 21 st pitcher in franchise history to reach that mark.
