**COOLING DOWN COTUIT:** The Gatemen turned up the heat on the Kettleers and defeated Cotuit by a final score of 7-2 last night. Wareham recorded double-digit hits for the second straight night and used a four-spot in the sixth inning to pull away. Bobby Boser (South Florida) led off the big inning with a solo homer. The Gatemen sent nine men to the plate and knocked five hits in their side of the 6th.

**STEVENSON SETS THE TONE:** Josh Stevenson (LSU) has sparked the Gatemen offense from the top of the order over the past two days. The rising junior has reached base five times and scored three times in the last two Gatemen victories. Stevenson is 2-3 with two singles when leading off innings in this stretch. Manager Ryan Smyth placed Stevenson in the top spot after a 4-4, 3 RBI performance versus Yarmouth-Dennis on June 22.

**LANDON OVER THE WALL(ACE):** Landon Wallace's (West Virginia) 4th inning home run was the longest hit in the Cape Cod Baseball League this season, according to Trackman. Wallace's homer travelled 431 feet to dead center field and came off the bat at 101 MPH. The homer was Wallace's first as a Gatemen.

**HELLO HYANNIS:** Tonight marks the first time the Gatemen visit McKeon Park in 2023. Wareham will look to grab one on the road against the Harbor Hawks after dropping the first two meetings of the season series at Spillane Field. The Gatemen are just 1-4-1 on the road this season. Wareham took two of three games in Hyannis last season.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER LHP Mark Manfredi (Sr. - Dayton)

Mark Manfredi goes back to the bump tonight, as the Dayton Flyer gets set makes his third start of the summer. Manfredi threw four innings and took a no-decision in his last start at Brewster on June 19. He conceded two earned runs on six hits and faced nineteen batters. The Highland Heights, Ohio native enters tonight sporting a 2.50 ERA in eight innings with the Gatemen. In his spring season at Dayton, Manfredi held a 3-4 record on the mound with a 4.99 ERA in 79.1 innings pitched.
