WALK IT BACK: Gatemen pitching allowed 13 free passes on Wednesday night, 11 of which were walks. Wareham ranks ninth in the league in walks, having surrendered 56 over their first ten games of the season.

HE GETS ON BASE: In his first two starts with the Gatemen, Missouri's JC Colon has posted an impressive stat line. Colon currently sports a .429 batting average, with three hits in his first seven at-bats on the Cape. Even more impressive, he has reached base in five of eight plate appearances when in the starting lineup. Colon has made starts at shortstop and third base, and Gatemen fans can look forward to seeing the Puerto Rico native all around the infield this summer.
