The last time the Whitecaps faced off with the Firebirds was over a month ago on June 20th. The 34 day hiatus is the largest gap between consecutive matchups against an opponent this season.

DeCramer has appeared four times for the 'Caps, this is his first start of the year. In 7 1/3 IP the rising redshirt junior has allowed two earned runs with eight strikeouts. This is DeCramer's second year with the Whitecaps.

Recap of last game: The Brewster Whitecaps took down the Wareham Gatemen in a low scoring 1-0 affair yesterday evening. It was a pitchers duel from the get go. Brewster Whitecaps starting pitcher Gaines Estridge had a perfect game going into the sixth inning retiring sixteen straight. The Air Force product finished with five strikeouts and did not allow a walk. Estridge did allow a trio of base hits all in the sixth inning. However a baserunning error gifted the 'Caps an escape from the frame and through six frames it was still 0-0. On the other end of things Peyton Lee threw four scoreless frames with four strikeouts and did not allow a base hit. Brewster relief pitchers Otto Espinoza and Colt Peterson cleaned up the last three innings and set the table for a walk-off in the bottom of the ninth. To lead off the chance Holden Pantier extended his hitting streak to five games with a single to lead off the frame. Tryston McCladdie backed it up with another single, his first hit of the day. Jacob Lee then stepped in and took a pinch hit walk. With the bases juiced outfielder Michael Torres took a bases loaded walk to end the game and give the 'Caps their fourth win of the year over the Gatemen.

NOT OUT OF THE RACE FOR THE TOP: The 'Caps are still fighting for the No.1 seed in the east but it's not going to be easy. The Whitecaps are still three and a half games out on the Y-D Red Sox. Brewster still has two games to go against the Sox but Y-D owns the tiebreaker. The Whitecaps for atleast now seem like the 2 seed is a lock with Harwich's recent struggles.

2025 SUMMARY: The Whitecaps wrapped up the 2025 regular season with their most wins since 2021 (22) and just their third 20-win season in the Jamie Shevchik era (others: 2015 & 2017). 61 players appeared in at least one game this past summer for the 'Caps - 27 position players, 34 pitchers - nearly 20% more players than the 2024 summer. Brewster's season began with a franchise-best 6-0 start, and the Whitecaps had the most wins in the league at the All-Star Break (15). The Whitecaps earned the three-seed in the East and a first-round matchup with the two-seeded Harwich Mariners. Brewster's season came to a close in a two games to one series loss.

GUESS WHO'S BACK, BACK AGAIN?: Dane Harvey played his first game in over two weeks with the Whitecaps. The Ohio State Product returns as the presumable everyday first baseman. Harvey went 0-3 in his first game back in yesterday's summer squirmish.
