WINLESS AT WHITEHOUSE: The Gatemen lost a five-game point streak on Thursday night in a 7-3 loss to Harwich at Whitehouse Field. The two teams traded blows in the first two frames, tying things up at three entering the third inning. Harwich would deliver the decisive blow one inning later, putting up four runs in the fourth to take a 7-3 lead that would hold for the rest of the game. Despite the loss on Thursday night, West Virginia's Keegan Allen held the line out of the bullpen, tossing three scoreless innings with just two hits and four strikeouts.

ROCKY ROAD: The Gatemen loss last night worsened their road record to 1-5-2. Wareham leads the league with seven home wins but is tied for last with just one road win. The lone road win of the season for Wareham came on Opening Day against the Falmouth Commodores. In eight road games, Wareham is hitting .198 and pitching to a 5.81 ERA. In nine home games, the Gatemen are hitting .288 and pitching to a 3.58 ERA.

SCOUTING THE KETTS: The Gatemen and the Kettleers meet today for the third of six meetings this year, with both teams taking a game each in the first two meetings. Wareham downed the Kettleers last Saturday at home behind home runs from Landon Wallace (West Virginia) and Bobby Boser (South Florida) and strong outings by five Gatemen pitchers who worked in the win. Cotuit holds a six-point lead at the top of the West Division over second-place Wareham. The Kettleers are tied for first in the league in both ERA (3.35) and batting average (.263) and are first in slugging percentage (.381). Northeastern's Joe Gigliotti is scheduled to make his third start for Cotuit this evening. He earned a win last Friday versus Falmouth after firing 5.1 innings of one-run ball.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

LHP Nolan Hughes (Jr. Fordham)

One of Wareham's newest activations, LHP Nolan Hughes, makes his Gatemen debut tonight at Cotuit. Hughes comes from Fordham, where the lefty spent time on the weekend rotation and in the bullpen this spring. In his final outing of the season, Hughes tossed a career-high 6.0 innings against Massachusetts with a career-best eight strikeouts. Hughes is a local product, hailing from Halifax, MA, just 30 minutes away from Spillane Field.
