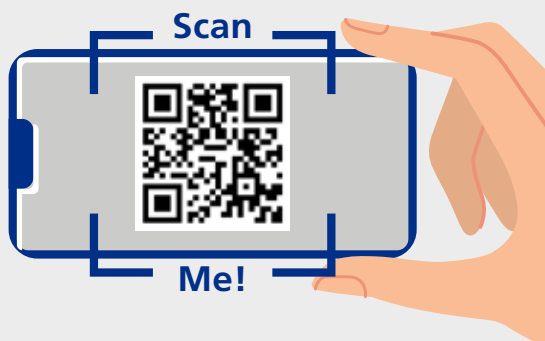

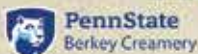

On behalf of Major League Baseball, it is my pleasure to welcome you to the third season of the MLB Draft League. Baseball has a storied history across the communities that comprise this league, and we are proud to continue this tradition in partnership with Prep Baseball Report.

Last season featured many exciting developments for the MLB Draft League, largely because of how fans from the six teams embraced the new format. The MLB Draft League and its teams continued to be a driving force for good in their communities. League charitable outreach totaled more than \$3.0 million in gift-in-kind and monetary donations.

Our goals are to provide the most fun possible, the highest level of play and growth opportunities for our future players.

As we move into the third year of the MLB Draft League, we are grateful to you, our fans, for supporting America's Pastime and embracing this new league in your community. Thank you for coming to the ballpark today and supporting our great game. We couldn't be more excited for another season of the MLB Draft League in communities like this one, and we look forward to hosting high-caliber baseball for years to come.



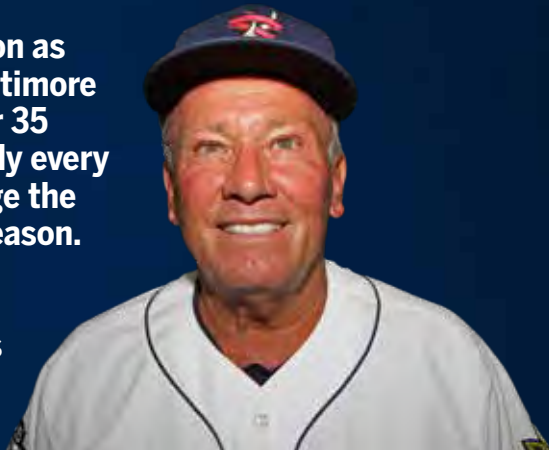

MANAGER DAVE TREMBLEY

The State College Spikes will have a familiar face in the dugout this season as Dave Trembley, who managed the Baltimore Orioles from 2007-10 and brings over 35 years of experience coaching at nearly every level of baseball with him, will manage the Spikes for the second consecutive season.

Trembley guided a Spikes team composed of draft-eligible prospects from around the country to a 20-18 record in the first half of the 2022 season, good for second place in the MLB Draft League. The first-half mark also included an eight-game winning streak from July 9-16.



With a roster of players starting their professional careers in the second half of the season, Trembley led the Spikes to a 21-19 record and stayed in contention for a league championship game berth until the season's final week.

Prior to joining the Spikes last season, Trembley served as the manager for the Bristol State Liners of the Appalachian League in 2021, reconnecting him with the development of young players in Major League Baseball's Player Development Pipeline. Previously, Trembley held the dual roles as Director of Player Development and Minor League Field Coordinator for the Atlanta Braves from 2014-18, preceded by a year as bench coach for the Houston Astros in 2013 and a year as third-base coach for the Astros in 2012.

Trembley compiled over 1,500 wins as a manager in the minor leagues while earning the Baseball America Minor League Manager of the Year Award in 1987 and USA Today/Baseball Weekly Class-A Manager of the Year honors in 1995 and 1999. After joining the Orioles organization in 2003, he rose through the organization to a big league role in 2007, taking over as interim manager partway through the season before becoming full-time manager from 2008-10.

In addition to his time throughout professional baseball, Trembley served as a graduate assistant for the Penn State baseball team while doing graduate work in sports psychology at the University Park campus in the late 1970's.

Alcoholic Beverage Policy - Pennsylvania law requires that you must be at least 21 years of age to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages. Fans wishing to purchase beer at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park must first obtain a wristband from an ID station located on the first-level concourse. In order to obtain a wristband, a valid ID must be presented. No fan will be served at any concession stand without wristband. We reserve the right to refuse any sale. There is a two-beer maximum per ID per trip. Please drink responsibly, and NEVER drink and drive.

We have established the following ground rules for alcohol sales to ensure that the enjoyable ballpark experience is not spoiled by the behavior of inappropriate individuals: 1. It is illegal to consume alcoholic beverages on the sidewalks or in the parking lots; anyone doing so will be subject to arrest. 2. Alcoholic beverages and controlled or illegal substances may not be brought into the stadium. 3. Drunk or disorderly fans will be denied admittance to the stadium. 4. Intoxicated or under-aged fans will not be permitted to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. 5. Drunk or disorderly fans inside the stadium will be ejected and may be subject to arrest. 6. Fans using foul or abusive language will be subject to ejection. 7. Fans interfering with play in any manner, including the throwing of objects onto the field or entering the field, will be subject to arrest.

Animals - Fans are not permitted to bring animals into Medlar Field at Lubrano Park, with the exception of guide or service animals for disabled fans, which are fully certified by Pennsylvania and are in actual use. The Spikes will host four Bark in the Park promotions in 2023, where fans are allowed to bring their "K-9", on June 9, July 9, August 9, and August 29. Bark in the Park rules and regulations can be found at StateCollegeSpikes.com.

ATM - Fans looking for an ATM can head to the Off the Rack Outfitters team store, where cash back is available with any purchase made inside the store.

Autographs - Getting autographs is part of the fun of attending a Spikes game, and the players and coaches are usually available before and after the games. Please be respectful when asking for autographs. As game time approaches, they do have to prepare for the game, and we ask all fans to return to their seats 20 minutes prior to the start of the game. Players are not allowed to sign any autographs once the game has started.

Automobile Assistance - Guests who need automobile assistance should contact the nearest Parking Attendant or Guest Services Representative or go to the Giant Customer Service Center located on the Concourse Level behind home plate.

Bag Policy - All bags brought into Medlar Field at Lubrano Park should be clear bags that can be seen through easily, reducing times for bag searches at entrance gates. Diaper and medical bags are not subject to this policy. Regardless of the bag, all bags are subject to search upon entry and within the ballpark. Prohibited items should be disposed of in trash containers or returned to one's vehicle.

Banners - Spikes fans are encouraged to bring banners and signs to Medlar Field at Lubrano Park to show their support for the team. Signs that obstruct the views of guests, interfere with batters, are derogatory or obscene, or do not pertain to the Spikes will be removed by security.

Batting Practice - Ballpark gates at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park open one hour prior to game time, which generally coincides with the end of batting practice.

Birthday/Anniversary Messages - The Spikes can help celebrate a birthday or a anniversary by displaying the occasion on our videoboard during the game. For more information about birthday, anniversary and other celebratory messages please call (814) 272-1711 or visit the Giant Customer Service Center, located behind home plate on the main concourse level, and get your message on the videoboard for a \$5 charitable donation.

Bus Service - Centre Area Transportation Authority (CATA) bus service is available to and from Medlar Field at Lubrano Park. A CATA bus stop is located just outside the ballpark. Please call (814) 238-CATA or visit www.catabus.com for bus loop schedules and other information.

Camera/Video Equipment - Guests are welcome to bring still and hand-held video cameras into Medlar Field at Lubrano Park as long as the equipment does not interfere with another guest's enjoyment of the game. Guests wishing to use equipment that requires the use of a tripod at a fixed position in the stadium must contact Joe Putnam, Director of Communications, at jputnam@statecollegespiques.com or (814) 272-1687 for permission.

Cellular Phones - The use of cellular phones is permitted at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park, provided such use does not interfere with other guests' enjoyment of the ball game. Please be courteous and refrain from making loud or lengthy calls in the seating areas.

Child Ticket Policy - Children ages two and under are not required to have a ticket for a game. The general rule of thumb is that if a child is small enough to sit on a parent's lap, then the child does not need to have a ticket. However, if the child wants to receive a promotional giveaway, they must have their own game ticket.

Conduct - The State College Spikes are committed to providing our guests with an enjoyable, safe atmosphere. Our staff will support a family-oriented environment where all guests can enjoy the baseball experience free from the following behaviors:

Elevators - For the convenience of our guests in the Geisinger Champions Club, an elevator is located on the first-level concourse, just outside the team office doors. For Pepsi Picnic Pavilion guests requiring special needs, a service elevator is located inside the picnic area.

Exchange of Tickets/Rainouts - Once a ticket is purchased, we are unable to exchange it for another game or provide a refund. The only exception is in the event the required 4 1/2 innings of a game not are completed or when a game is postponed due to weather. In these instances, tickets can be exchanged for tickets of equal or lesser value to a future regular season home game, based upon availability. Medlar Field's right field fence stands 18.55 feet tall in reference to the year that Penn State University was founded. The remainder of the fence is 7 feet tall in front of the Pepsi Picnic Pavilion in left field and 8 feet tall in all other areas.

First Aid Station/Medical Attention - Should you have a medical emergency or need medical assistance, please visit the First Aid Station located on the first-base side of the first-level concourse, or contact your nearest usher or Spikes official.

Food - Fans are not permitted to bring any coolers, containers, outside food or beverages into Medlar Field at Lubrano Park unless expressly permitted by the Spikes prior to game time.

Foul Balls - Fans are welcome to keep any foul ball hit into the seats. At no time should a foul ball or home run ball be thrown back on the field. Violators are subject to ejection and possible arrest. Any guest interfering with a ball in play will be subject to ejection from the ballpark. Fans should always remain alert to the danger of thrown or batted balls.

Rainouts/Rain Checks - In the event a game is postponed due to rain or inclement weather, your ticket stub becomes a rain check which can be exchanged in person at the Spikes' Ticket Office for a ticket of equal or lesser value to any remaining regular season home game, subject to availability. The Spikes do not offer cash refunds for unused or rainout tickets.

Roster - The Spikes' roster is controlled by Prep Baseball Report, which assigns players to all six Major League Baseball Draft League teams.
