The ideal candidates will possess a deep understanding of baseball, exceptional on-air presence, and the ability to connect with a diverse audience. This role is responsible for providing compelling play-by-play commentary, expert analysis, and hosting studio shows to inform, entertain, and engage our viewers.

The optimal candidates will need to be aligned with League initiatives and priorities and be able to represent the brand values of the Cape Cod Baseball League. This internship runs from the date of acceptance through September 1, 2026. This role includes remote work in a fast-paced environment with high volume of work and tight deadlines. Hours includes nights and weekends. Stipend commensurate with experience.

Responsibilities:

- **Game Broadcasting:**
 - Serve as the primary play-by-play voice for live baseball games, delivering accurate, clear, and engaging commentary.
 - Provide expert analysis of game situations, player performance, and team strategy.
 - Tell compelling stories about players, teams, and the history of baseball to enhance the broadcast.
 - Work in collaboration with color commentators, sideline reporters, and production teams to deliver a seamless broadcast.
 - Prepare for broadcasts by researching team and player statistics, historical data, and current news.
- **Studio Anchoring:**
 - Host and anchor pre-game, post-game, and other studio shows.
 - Lead discussions, conduct interviews with players, coaches, and other guests, and break down key game moments.
 - Provide updates on other games, league news, and relevant sports headlines.
 - Read and deliver scripts and ad-lib content in a professional and engaging manner.
 - Serve as a knowledgeable and charismatic on-air personality, representing the brand with professionalism.
- **Content Creation & Social Media:**
 - Contribute to the creation of written and video content for digital platforms, including websites and social media.
 - Engage with fans on social media platforms to promote broadcasts and build a stronger community.
 - Participate in promotional events, fan meet-and-greets, and media appearances as required.
- **General Duties:**
 - Maintain a current and extensive knowledge of baseball rules, regulations, and league trends.
 - Uphold the highest standards of journalistic integrity and professionalism.
 - Travel extensively to cover games, both home and away, throughout the baseball season.
 - Collaborate with the production team, including producers, directors, and camera operators, to ensure a high-quality broadcast.

 - Ability to handle a demanding travel schedule and work non-traditional hours, including nights, weekends, and holidays.
