Brewster Whitecaps Health & Safety Policy

The Brewster Whitecaps are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for players, coaches, volunteers, and fans. Excellent safe and healthy conditions do not occur by chance. They are the result of diligent work and careful attention to conditions and practices.

The General Manager is responsible for health and safety of participants in all baseball-related activities, including (but not limited to) games, practices, travel to and from games, and clinics. S/he will be assisted in this oversight by the Lead Certified Athletic Trainer, who will annually prepare an Athletic Training and Procedures Manual.

The Game Day Vice President will have primary responsibility for fan safety.

Both the General Manager and Game Day V.P. are authorized to make in-season adjustments in procedures to improve health and safety, in consultation with the Executive Committee if need be. Each off-season the two officers will bring proposed improvements to the Board for consideration in budget development.

Any personal injury or reported threat to health or safety shall be recorded, and investigated to the extent necessary to determine whether corrective action should be taken. Such report shall be filed with the Board Secretary.
