#### Sean Riley - Hitting Coach

Coach Sean Riley is a Massachusetts native where he graduated from Lowell High School. He captained the baseball and basketball teams and then went on to play at Chipola Jr. College (Marianna, FL). He has coached for over 25 years on the east and west coast and many of his former players have gone on to play at the college and pro level.

Coach Riley's coaching experience ranges from time with the Lowell American Legion Baseball Team to most

recently working at San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton, CA).

#### Ray Korn — Pitching Coach

Ray Korn has great experience coaching teams like the 1990 USA Junior National World Champion- ships and coaching for minor league affiliate teams for the Detroit Tigers and the Chicago Cubs. He was inducted into the American Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame in 2015. Coach Korn has great experience in developing young athletes, and will look to contin- ue to do that this season with the Harbor Hawks

#### Blaise Martinez –


Blaise Martinez serves as the pitching coordinator at Cressey Sports Performance in Hudson, Massachusetts, one of the nation's premier training facilities for baseball athletes. At CSP, Blaise leads pitching development with a focus on individualized programming backed by biomechanics, high-speed video, force plate data, and pitch tracking technology. The facility's data-driven, evidence-based approach allows him to blend cutting-edge sports science with personalized coaching

to help pitchers optimize performance and stay healthy.

With over eight years of coaching experience, Blaise has worked at highly regarded programs including Don Bosco Preparatory School and Delbarton Preparatory School, both known for their strong baseball traditions. He is currently the varsity pitching coach at Lawrence Academy in Groton, Massachusetts, where he has helped lead multiple programs to county and state championships.

Prior to joining CSP, Blaise was part of the staff at VeloU in Pleasantville, New York, and also coached at Teel's Baseball and Performance in New Jersey, where he worked with athletes across all levels.

He holds both a B.S. and M.S. in Exercise Science and Education, combining academic knowledge with practical coaching experience to deliver high-level pitching instruction.



Mitch Karraker is a native of Clovis, California, and currently serves as the Head Coach at Fresno City College. Karraker replaced former Head Coach Ron Scott, who is the winningest Junior College baseball coach in California history, and led his team to an impressive 34-12 record in his inaugural season.

Karraker began his personal collegiate playing career at Fresno City College before transferring to the



University of Oregon, where he spent 3 seasons as a catcher for the Ducks from 2009-2011. After graduating, Karraker transitioned into a coaching role at Oregon, where he coached in numerous roles from 2011-2019 under the legendary George Horton, a National Championship winning coach at California State Fullerton who revitalized Oregon's previously dormant baseball program during his tenure.

In 2012 and 2016, Karraker had two stints coaching for Team USA Collegiate National Team on a staff that included George Horton (Former Head Coach, Oregon and Cal State Fullerton), Andy Stankiewicz (current Head Coach at the University of Southern California), Jason Gill (Assistant Coach, Cal Poly), Ted Silva (Former Assistant Coach, University of Nebraska, USC, Cal State Fullerton), and John Altobelli (Former Head Coach, Orange Coast College and Brewster Whitecaps Head Coach).

In 2019, he became an assistant coach at Baylor University, under Head Coach Steve Rodriguez, who now serves as the hitting coach at the University of Texas. In 2021, he took the assistant coaching job at Loyola Marymount University, where he served as the hitting and outfielder's coach. He also served as the Head Coach of the Klamath Falls Gems, a summer league team in the West Coast League.

Off the field, Karraker has been married to his wife Kelly for eight years, and they are blessed with three wonderful daughters. Ella. Nora. and Sophie. His hobbies include golfing, cooking, fitness, and being with family.

#### Rich Cogliano – Bench Coach

Rich was born and raised in Brockton Ma. A 1985 graduate of Brockton High School, he attended Kirkwood Community College in Cedar Rapids Iowa and the University of Iowa. Rich was a long time coach and GM in American Legion baseball in the Brockton area. Rich lives with his wife Maria in West Barnstable.






