FLIPPED THE SCRIPT: Less than a week after allowing five runs in the final two innings of a 6-5 loss at Y-D, the Gatemen returned the favor with a late rally to even the season series against the Red Sox. After trailing 4-0 entering the bottom of the fifth, Wareham cut the deficit to just a run in the bottom of the eighth before Grant Hussey (West Virginia) delivered a three-run home run to give the Gatemen an 8-6 lead. Wednesday's win improved Wareham's home record to 7-2, the best home record in all of the CCBL.

GLANCING AT FIRST: Outfielder David Glancy (Notre Dame transfer) set a new season high in the CCBL, walking five times in five plate appearances and scoring three runs. Glancy has now scored 15 runs in 48 at-bats with a league-leading 15 walks and is tied for second in the league with three home runs.

AT LONG LAST(RES): Florida's Rene Lastres is the latest player to join the Gatemen roster after arriving in Wareham last night. Lastres will join Tommy Splaine (Arizona) and Jedier Hernandez (Seton Hall) behind the plate after catching on a Florida team that finished as runners-up in the 2023 College World Series. The La Habana, Cuba, native appeared in 11 games during his sophomore season in Gainesville with 3 RBI and a triple.

HUSSEY HELPS OUT: The biggest moment of Wednesday night's victory came in the bottom of the eighth when Grant Hussey (West Virginia) gave the Gatemen the lead with a three-run homer. The home run, added on to an earlier double, gave the Mountaineer his second six-RBI performance of the season and propelled him to 5th in that category on the league leaderboard.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

RHP Casey Tallent (So. - Clemson)

Casey Tallent toes the rubber for the second time as a Gatemen this evening at Whitehouse Field. Tallent's first start also came on the road against an Eastern Division opponent. On June 22 at Yarmouth-Dennis, he fired four-plus innings and took a no-decision. The Clemson Tiger conceded just one run on six hits while striking out three. He threw 38 of his 60 pitches for strikes. This spring, at Clemson, Tallent threw 21 innings across 16 appearances (one start) and posted a 3.43 ERA.
