Position Overview

The Cape Cod Baseball League and Cape League TV are seeking a dynamic, knowledgeable Game Broadcaster for the 2027 season. The ideal candidate possesses a deep understanding of baseball and exceptional on-air presence to inform, entertain, and engage our audience. This role serves as the primary play-by-play voice of official league broadcasts, delivering compelling commentary and expert analysis across digital streaming and traditional radio broadcasts, with potential opportunities on regional television networks. Additionally, there is an opportunity to work as a contributor to other Cape League media content.

Optimal candidates must align with League initiatives and priorities while representing the brand values of the Cape Cod Baseball League.

Location & Availability

- Must reside on Cape Cod (or within 20 miles) throughout the duration of the season from June 2027 through August 2027.
- Available to work non-traditional hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays across all ten CCBL franchise venues.

Time Commitment & Schedule

- **Pre-Season / Offseason (Remote):** Potentially 4 to 5 hours per week focused on administrative prep, digital asset management setup, style guidelines, and pre-season content planning.
- **In-Season:** Fast-paced environment requiring non-traditional hours, including nights, weekends, and holidays.

Key Responsibilities

Game Broadcasting & Media Content

- Serve as the primary play-by-play voice of official league broadcasts across video streaming, radio channels, and potential regional television broadcasts, delivering accurate, clear, and engaging commentary.
- Provide expert analysis of game situations, player performance, and team strategy.
- Tell compelling stories about players, teams, and the rich history of the Cape Cod Baseball League to enhance the live broadcast.
- Contribute to additional Cape League media content across digital, written, and social platforms.
- Work in close collaboration with color commentators, sideline reporters, and production teams to deliver a seamless broadcast.
- Thoroughly prepare for broadcasts by researching team and player statistics, historical data, and current news.

General & Operational Duties

- Maintain a current and extensive knowledge of baseball rules, regulations, and league trends.
- Uphold the highest standards of journalistic integrity and professionalism.
- Travel to cover games (both home and away) throughout the baseball season.
- Collaborate directly with the production team (including producers, directors, and camera operators) to ensure a high-quality production.

Qualifications

Eligibility / Education

- Current undergraduate or graduate student (graduating 2027 or 2028) OR recent graduate (within 1 year).
- Working towards or holding a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Journalism, Communications, or a related field (preferred).

Experience

- Must have a minimum of 2–4 years of experience as the main play-by-play broadcaster for a collegiate baseball program, professional baseball team, or summer collegiate baseball team.
- Proven experience in live sports television, streaming, and radio broadcasting.

Skills

- Exceptional verbal communication skills with a clear, articulate, and dynamic on-air voice.
- Deep and demonstrable knowledge of baseball (College and MLB), as well as the history of the Cape Cod Baseball League.
- Strong improvisational skills and the ability to react quickly to live, unscripted game action.
- Excellent research and game preparation skills.
- Proficiency with broadcast equipment and production software is a plus.
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work effectively as part of a broadcast crew.
- Ability to work non-traditional hours.

- Passion for sports and live broadcasting.
- Confident on-air presence with a strong work ethic.
- Ability to remain calm, composed, and focused under live pressure.
- Creative and innovative approach to sports storytelling.
