

ALUMNI REPORT

FEBRUARY 28

Charlie Condon (2023 CNT) is swinging a hot bat. The redshirt sophomore connected for three home runs against Michigan State on Wednesday, driving in four runs and drawing a walk. To this point in the season, Condon is batting .639 with seven homers and 13 RBIs.

FEBRUARY 27

2019 15U National Team alum Drew Burress can't stop hitting home runs. The true freshman set a Georgia Tech record with four homers on February 27 as he drove in six runs in a big win over Georgia State. As of February 27, Burress has nine home runs to lead the entire nation.

Derek Curiel (2023 18U) became the all-time hits leader in Orange Lutheran baseball history on Tuesday night against Cypress High School. The top-draft-prospect outfielder picked up his 89th hit in the contest, putting him atop OLu's storied leaderboard.

FEBRUARY 26

Termarr Johnson (2021 18U, 2019 15U) showed out in the Pittsburgh Pirates' spring training game against the Toronto Blue Jays in Dunedin, Florida, as he homered twice and drove in three of the team's four runs. Johnson was recently tabbed the top second baseman on MLB's Top 100 Prospect Rankings for 2024.

FEBRUARY 25

Four-time alum Karson Bowen (2016 12U, 2018 & 2019 15U, 2021 18U) helped fifth- ranked TCU earn a 13-3 win in seven innings over No. 20 UCLA, which ultimately led to a series sweep over the Bruins. Bowen led the Horned Frogs with a 3-for-3 outing, including a pair of doubles, and a game-high five RBIs.

FEBRUARY 24

Georgia Tech freshman Drew Burress (2019 15U) has made an immediate impact in the Yellow Jackets' lineup. On February 24 against Cornell he went 4-for-4 with two homers, four RBIs and two runs scored. He currently leads the team with 11 hits and 14 RBIs through seven games in the 2024 season.

With the winning run on third and one out in the bottom of the ninth on February 24, 2022 18U National Team alum Camden Kozeal delivered. Kozeal roped a walk-off single to center field to bring home the winning run in a 4-3 victory for Vanderbilt over Gonzaga. It was one of Kozeal's two hits on the day, as the Vandy three-hitter went 2- for-5 in the contest.

FEBRUARY 23

Making his second start of his sophomore season, Cade Fisher (2021 18U) was electric in Florida's win over Columbia on February 23. The righthander tossed five innings and struck out ten Columbia batters, scattering two runs while not walking a batter. Fisher was handed a 10-0 lead after the first inning and was mostly on cruise control, finishing his outing with a pair of strikeouts in the fifth.

2023 CNT alum Hagen Smith had one of the best starts of the young season on February 23, striking out 17 batters in six shutout innings against the No. 7-raked Oregon State Beavers. Smith, who got 15 of his 17 K's using his vaunted slider, set the Globe Life Field single-game punch out record in a 5-4 victory for Arkansas. He surrendered just three hits and was methodical in the outing, throwing just 78 pitches.

FEBRUARY 22

Konnor Griffin (2021 15U, 2023 18U) is making things happen all over the diamond for Jackson Prep (MS). Griffin continued his torrid start to his senior high school season on February 22, going 2-for-2 with a walk and three runs scored. Griffin also stole four bases in the contest, giving him 25 swiped bags through eight games.

FEBRUARY 21

After making his collegiate debut on Opening Weekend, 2022 18U National Team alum Matthew Dallas took the mound for his first collegiate start on February 21. The southpaw was unhittable during his three innings of work, allowing just one baserunner via a walk and striking out three. Tennessee picked up the victory, beating East Tennessee State, 16-0.

FEBRUARY 20

Casey Borba (2022 18U) has arrived at Texas. Entering as a pinch-hitter in the Longhorns' big win over Houston Baptist on February 20, Borba blasted the first home run of his collegiate career. The freshman fouled off three consecutive pitches before sending a blast over the left field wall.

As of February 20, CNT alum Jace LaViolette has played in four games this season... and already has two multi-homer games. After his two blasts on Opening Day against McNeese, LaViolette again left the yard twice on February 20 in a Texas A&M victory over Incarnate Word.

FEBRUARY 19

2021 18U National Team alum and current Stetson Hatter Jayden Hylton came through in the clutch against West Virginia on February 19. With two on and two out in the bottom of the ninth of a tie game, Hylton smoked a walk-off double to right field to lift the Hatters to a victory in the first game of their doubleheader.

FEBRUARY 18

Two-time Team USA alum Steven Milam was all over the box score in LSU's 27-5 victory over VMI on February 18. Batting in the leadoff spot, the freshman went 4-for-6 with three RBIs and a double in the win.

FEBRUARY 16

2019 15U National Team alum Drew Burress could not have asked for a better start to his collegiate career. Leading off and playing center field, Burress went 2-for-5 with two home runs, also drawing a walk and driving in a trio of runs in a win over Radford.

Trey Yesavage (2023 CNT) made his first Opening Day start on February 16 and he delivered, tossing four innings and allowing just one hit and one run. Yesavage brought his swing-and-miss stuff to the victory over Rider, punching out eight batters in the outing.
