CAPPY'S "NO CAP" STAT OF THE DAY:

Through day one of the MLB draft the Whitecaps had the most former players drafted of any team in the CCBL. Seven former 'Caps were drafted. The Mariners and Kettleers were tied for second with six drafted. The Commodores had two.

Recap of last game: The Brewster Whitecaps took down the Cotuit Kettleers 7-4 for the 'Caps 8th win in the past ten contests. Out of the gate with sub 1.00 ERA left-handed pitcher Payton Manca on the hill the Kettleers jumped out early. Cotuit scored a pair of runs in the bottom of the first off of a hit and an infield error. The Whitecaps cut the lead in half in the second frame as Holden Pantier raced home on a wild pitch. In the bottom of the third and top of the fourth Cotuit and Brewster traded one run punches and after a scoreless fifth it was a 3-2 Kettleers lead. In the sixth the 'Caps tied up the ballgame and in the top of the seventh with a runner on Jamie Laskofski gave Brewster it's first lead. The middle infielder turned on one to right field for his second homerun of the year and gave the 'Caps a 5-3 lead. Cotuit grabbed one back in the bottom of the frame but from there Brewster cruised with a couple insurance runs in the ninth and an eventual 7-4 victory to win it's second in a row.

HOTTEST TEAM IN THE CCBL: Over the past ten games the 'Caps are the hottest team on Cape Cod. Brewster is 8-2 over the past ten, the next best is the Y-D Red Sox at a 7-3 record. What's more the 'Caps have not lost back-to-back games since the 26th of June. The Whitecaps and the Commodores are the only two teams in the CCBL coming into today on a multi game win streak.

2025 SUMMARY: The Whitecaps wrapped up the 2025 regular season with their most wins since 2021 (22) and just their third 20-win season in the Jamie Shevchik era (others: 2015 & 2017). 61 players appeared in at least one game this past summer for the 'Caps - 27 position players, 34 pitchers - nearly 20% more players than the 2024 summer. Brewster's season began with a franchise-best 6-0 start, and the Whitecaps had the most wins in the league at the All-Star Break (15). The Whitecaps earned the three-seed in the East and a first round matchup with the two-seeded Harwich Mariners. Brewster's season came to a close in a two games to one series loss.

GET READY FOR A CLOSE ONE: The Whitecaps and the Commodores have already played a couple of one run games this season. The season series is currently tied one game a piece. In the first meeting the 'Caps were getting no hit into the ninth inning but made it a close game after the only Brewster grand slam of the season off the bat of Dane Harvey. The Commodores still hung onto the win. In meeting two at Guv Fuller field the 'Caps grabbed the go ahead run in the top of the ninth inning and with the bases loaded in the bottom of the frame slammed the door.
