This internship is responsible for capturing high-quality video footage of League events, athletes, and teams. This role requires a strong understanding of storytelling and baseball, excellent video production skills, and the ability to meet tight deadlines. This internship is a unique opportunity to cover a baseball league with access to the teams, coaching staffs, and game action. You need to have a thirst for learning and growing as a videographer. Intern must provide own equipment.

The optimal candidates will need to be aligned with League initiatives and priorities and be able to represent the brand values of the Cape Cod Baseball League. This internship runs from the date of acceptance through September 1, 2026. This role includes remote work in a fast-paced environment with high volume of work and tight deadlines. Hours includes nights and weekends. Stipend commensurate with experience.

#### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Cover League events: Attend and record video footage of a variety of League events, including games, practices, and marketing events.
- Capture high-quality video: Produce visually appealing and technically sound video footage of players, teams, game action, crowd photos, etc...
- Edit and manage video: Edit and process video footage to enhance its quality and create engaging videos.
- Organize and archive video: Organize and archive video footage in a systematic manner for easy retrieval and distribution.
- Provide video for various purposes: Provide video for sponsor/partner use, use on website, social media, and Cape League TV.
- Meet deadlines: Consistently meet tight deadlines for video delivery.
- Maintain equipment: Properly maintain and care for video equipment.

### **Qualifications:**

- Strong video production skills, including knowledge of camera operation, lighting, and editing techniques.
- Proficiency with professional video production equipment and software.
- Passion for storytelling and baseball and a deep understanding of both.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Ability to meet tight deadlines and work under pressure.
- Experience in sports videography or a related field is preferred.
- 2-4 years of experience in sports videography shooting for college or university team, athletic department, or media outlet covering sports, preferably baseball.
- Working towards Bachelor's or Master's degree, required.

#### **Skills and Abilities:**

- Knowledge of baseball terminology and rules.
- Ability to anticipate and capture key moments in the game(s).
- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Ability to adapt to different lighting conditions and environments.
- Ability to use social media effectively to share and promote videos.

## **Work Environment:**

- Primarily works in outdoor environments, such as stadiums, arenas, and fields.
- Will travel to cover League events.
- Must be able to work irregular hours, including evenings and weekends.
