Brewster middle infielder Jamie Laskofski has been the definition of consistent. The UNC Tarheel has a hit in eight straight games. It's the longest hitting streak of the season for the 'Caps. Over the stretch Laskofski has struckout just four times.

Garcia has a 3.18 ERA through 11 1/3 IP on the season through three starts. Last time out against Chatham the LSU product worked through four innings and allowed four runs. Garcia relies on soft contact with just 6 K's on the year.

Recap of last game:

In the sixth game in six days the Whitecaps took down the Harbor Hawks 6-3 to win it's fifth over that same stretch of games. Early on with 'Caps pitcher Mavrick Rzy on the bump the Ole Miss Rebel allowed a free pass to the first four batters but worked out of a jam giving up just two runs. In the bottom of the first the 'Caps punched right back with two of their own thanks to a Jay Abernathy triple. It's just the third triple of the season for Brewster. Brewster tallied one in the second and third and led 4-2 entering the fifth frame. In the home half of the fifth Brewster scraped another run across despite Dane Harvey grounding into his first double play of the year. In the seventh Hyannis cut the lead to 5-3 and had the bases loaded in the eighth but Finbar O'Brien spun his way out of the no out jam without allowing a run. Brewster tallied one more in the home half and cruised to a 6-3 victory over the Harbor Hawks.

To strikeout or not to strikeout:

The strikeout has been the Whitecaps friend entering the halfway point of the season. The 'Caps go down on strikes the least in the CCBL at just eight times a contest. Flipping to the pitching side and its a similar story. The Whitecaps strike out just under ten batters a contest the third most on Cape Cod. In today's matchup the Mariners should find problems finding the K. The M's strikeout the second fewest batters in the CCBL.

2025 SUMMARY:

The Whitecaps wrapped up the 2025 regular season with their most wins since 2021 (22) and just their third 20-win season in the Jamie Shevchik era (others: 2015 & 2017). 61 players appeared in at least one game this past summer for the 'Caps - 27 position players, 34 pitchers - nearly 20% more players than the 2024 summer. Brewster's season began with a franchise-best 6-0 start, and the Whitecaps had the most wins in the league at the All-Star Break (15). The Whitecaps earned the three-seed in the East and a first round matchup with the two-seeded Harwich Mariners. Brewster's season came to a close in a two games to one series loss.

RUBBER MATCH :

There are no regular season series in the CCBL but this is about the closest thing you are going to get. It's the third time in four games the Whitecaps and Mariners square off. Harwich got the better of game on 2-1 at Stony Brook but the Whitecaps came back in full force in game two. The 'Caps mercy ruled the Mariners 13-0 at Whitehouse field.
