## WAREHAM GATEMEN (8-8-2) VS. FALMOUTH COMMODORES (6-10-2)

**LOWELL LULLS:** The Gatemen lost their second consecutive game Friday night at Lowell Park, falling to Cotuit by a score of 6-3. Wareham hitters struck out sixteen times, breaking their previous season high of fifteen. The Gatemen would put up one run in the ninth, leaving the tying run at the plate with two runners on base. The Gatemen now drop to 0-2 at Lowell Park this summer and 1-2 against the Kettleers overall.

**GLANCY GETS ON:** One of the brightest spots in the Wareham lineup has been Notre Dame transfer David Glancy. After a five-walk performance against Y-D on Wednesday, Glancy added two more free passes to his total, scoring once and tallying two hits. Glancy remains the league leader in both walks (17) and runs (16) and is tied for first in steals (11).

**AWESOME ARMS:** The Gatemen bullpen continued to roll yesterday, as they surrendered just two runs in five innings of work. Since the June 22 loss at Yarmouth-Dennis, the Wareham bullpen has a 2.08 ERA in 30.1 innings of work across seven games. In that stretch, the bullpen has recorded 27 strikeouts to 18 walks. Six Wareham pitchers used in relief during the seven-game stretch were making their Gatemen debuts.

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** Wareham leads the league with seven home wins. The Gatemen have a 7-2 record at Spillane Field and have won four straight games in front of the home fans. Wareham is hitting .288 at home and scoring over seven runs per game. Wareham has hit nine home runs at home and has allowed just one. The team has a 3.58 ERA in 78 innings pitched at Spillane Field.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER

RHP Brett Wichrowski (Jr. - Bryant)

Bryant's Brett Wichrowski makes his second start of the summer on Saturday night at Spillane Field. Wichrowski earned the win in a five inning performance against Chatham on June 23rd, allowing two earned runs, seven hits and striking out four. Prior to his start against Chatham, Wichrowski threw out of the bullpen on two occasions. He has totaled 8.2 innings pitched this season, earning a 3.11 ERA and walking only one batter.
