



A record number eight Commodores players selected for the 2025 Cape Cod Baseball League All-Star Game

July 22, 2025, Falmouth, MA – The Cape Cod Baseball League All-Star Game was held on Saturday, July 19, hosted by the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox at Red Wilson Field.

The best of the East Division completed against the best of the West Division in a game dominated by offense, where the East Division took down the West Division by a score of 13-8.

The Falmouth Commodores had a record number eight All-Star selections on the team, the most of any team in the League. The Commodores Outfielder Antonio Morales was awarded the MVP of the West Division title for the 2025 All-Star Game.
