About the Cape Cod Baseball League:

The Cape Cod Baseball League (CCBL) is the premier collegiate summer baseball league in the nation. Featuring top-tier college athletes from across the country, the CCBL provides an elite showcase for future MLB stars while delivering classic, family-friendly summer baseball to fans across Cape Cod. We partner with organizations, brands, and media platforms to tell real stories at the highest level, blending cinematic video production with smart, modern sports media delivery. We move fast, collaborate closely, and care deeply about doing great work and honoring the storied tradition of the Cape League.

About The Role:

We're looking for a creative and driven Associate Producer Intern to join our broadcast and video production team for the 2027 season, with a strong focus on sports-based content. Reporting directly to the League Media Director, this role is hands-on and fast-paced, blending post-production editing with on-location field production at Cape League ballparks. A passion for baseball, sports media, and storytelling is a must! You'll work closely with League staff, team franchises, and media partners to deliver compelling content across multiple platforms and regional television networks.

Location & Availability

- Must reside on Cape Cod (or within 20 miles) throughout the duration of the season from June 2027 through August 2027.
- Available to work non-traditional hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays across all ten CCBL franchise venues.

Time Commitment & Schedule

- **Pre-Season / Offseason (Remote):** Potentially 4 to 5 hours per week focused on administrative prep, digital asset management setup, style guidelines, and pre-season content planning.
- **In-Season (On-Site):** Coverage of 5 to 6 games per week during the summer season, including high-profile events (Opening Day, All-Star Game, Playoffs, and Championship Series) as well as production of content for league platforms and regional television networks.

Responsibilities:

The Associate Producer Intern for the Cape Cod Baseball League will handle a variety of tasks, including but not limited to:

- Post-production video editing using Adobe Premiere (interviews, feature stories, game highlights, hype videos, and social media content).
- On-location camera operation and field production across Cape Cod League ballparks.
- Pre-production research, story ideation, and project file organization.
- Managing media equipment inventory and digital asset management.
- Assisting with on-set logistics, field production assistant duties, and coordinating with venue/team staff.
- Handling finishing services, assembly edits, and growing into intermediate and polished edits with feedback and guidance.
- Collaborating with the League Media Director to execute league-wide media and branding initiatives.

Related Experience & Skills:

- Experience working in sports media or a strong, demonstrated interest in sports storytelling.
- Experience editing in Adobe Premiere Pro / Adobe Creative Cloud (college coursework, internships, or freelance work count).
- Hands-on field production and camera operating experience.
- Solid understanding of video storytelling, pacing, visual composition, and digital sports media formats.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in high-energy, fast-paced game environments.
- Strong attention to detail, high self-management skills, and eagerness to learn and adapt to League standards.

Required Qualifications & Attributes

- **Experience:** 2 to 4 years of active sports photography experience shooting for a college/university team, athletic department, media outlet covering sports, or baseball league.
- **Eligibility / Education:** Current undergraduate or graduate student (graduating 2027 or 2028) OR recent graduate (within 1 year). Working towards or holding a Bachelor's or Master's degree.
- **Technical Mastery & Equipment:** Proficiency with professional DSLR/mirrorless camera gear, high-speed lenses, telephoto setups, and post-processing software (e.g., Adobe Lightroom Classic, Photo Mechanic, Adobe Photoshop). Must provide personal camera equipment.
- **Key Attributes:** Self-motivated, collaborative, adaptable under tight deadlines, and passionate about visual storytelling and baseball.
- **Baseball Acumen:** Deep understanding of baseball rules, flow, and terminology to anticipate game action and capture key moments.
- **Portfolio Required:** An online photography portfolio demonstrating dynamic action shots, crisp focus, proper exposure, and technical consistency must be attached to the application.

Additional Requirements:

- Available for on-site work on Cape Cod, MA for the duration of the 2027 summer season.
- Ability to work evenings, weekends, and game days as required by the league schedule.
