COMMODORE CONUNDRUM: The Gatemen lost their third consecutive game Saturday night at Spillane Field, falling to Falmouth by a score of 11-5. Wareham trailed just 7-5 entering the seventh inning, but surrendered four runs that would balloon the Commodore lead up to five. The loss was Wareham's second of the season to Falmouth and drops them below .500 for the first time since June 23rd. Three losses in a row amounts to the longest losing streak of the season.

THE CENTENNIAL: The Wareham Gatemen are the first team in the Cape Cod Baseball League to reach 100 runs scored this season. Wareham accomplished the feat in Thursday night's loss to Cotuit when David Glancy drove home Bobby Boser in the 9th inning. Last night versus Falmouth, the Gatemen worked their 100th walk of the season, which is also a first in the Cape League this season. Wareham leads the league in both categories.

HOUSE OF KANE: Maryland's Tommy Kane played a key role out of the bullpen in Saturday night's loss. The lefty fired 2.2 innings, allowing just two hits and striking out five while facing ten batters. Kane was a workhorse this spring at Maryland, throwing 28.1 innings with a 7.31 ERA and a 2-0 record in 17 appearances.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

RHP Aidan Major (So. - West Virginia)

Aidan Major takes the ball tonight for Wareham as he looks to build off of a strong first start. The West Virginia Mountaineer started June 24th versus the Cotuit Kettleers and held them in check for 4.2 innings. He conceded two runs on two hits, walking two and striking out six. Major was one out away from being in line for the win, which ended up going to his West Virginia teammate Keegan Allen. This spring, Major appeared in 21 games, starting three, and pitched to a 4.88 ERA. He struck out 28.5% of the hitters he faced while only walking 6.7%.
