his credit. Pick has managed the Sox to a record six Cape League titles, and seven President's Trophies for the league's best regular season mark. Pickler also has had outstanding success as a collegiate coach. In 1985, he took over a struggling Cypress College program and quickly turned the Chargers into a respected California powerhouse. His teams won five state championships, and he was chosen the National Coach of the Year for California Community Colleges four times. He was inducted into the Cypress College Athletics Hall of Fame in 2017, the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Hall of Fame in 2019, the Cape Cod Baseball League Hall of Fame in 2019, and the California Community College Athletic Association (3C2A) Hall of Fame in 2025, along with his brother, Brad. Scott's wife. Sharon, worked in education. She and Scott raised two children; Jeff, who played baseball at Tennessee where he was named SEC player of the year and recently coached with the Cincinnati Reds, and Kari, who, with her husband, Chris, operates a business running major events. ## MANAGER SCOTT PICKLER RETURNS FOR RECORD 27TH SEASON By David Okula

With 19 postseason appearances, seven President's Trophies for the league's best record, 601 regular season wins and six CCBL championships during his 26-year tenure, Scott Pickler has created a lasting legacy as manager of the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox.

Pickler, known to all as "Pick," assumed the reigns in 1998 and has become synonymous with the Y-D Red Sox and the CCBL ever since. He is the winningest manager in CCBL history, and along with his time on the Cape, he had a successful career as head coach of Cypress College, a community college in California.


Pick's first CCBL title came in 2004, and it began a stretch of three championships in four years (with titles in '06 and '07). Pick added more titles to his tally with a three-peat in 2014-16. His six championships and seven President's Trophies are CCBL career records. In 2004, he added his ninth division title and became the first CCBL manager with 600 regular season wins.

During his tenure, Pick has managed around 125 future Major League Baseball players. Some of the most notable alumni include: 2024 NL Cy Young Award winner Chris Sale, Guardians pitcher Shane Bieber, Giants former catcher/current President of Baseball Operations Buster Posey, Red Sox pitcher Walker Buehler, star reliever David Robertson, and World Series champion Justin Turner.

Pick's legacy goes beyond what he has done on the


Cape. He won five state championships during his time as head coach of Cypress and still serves as Head Coach Emeritus. Now in his 40th season with the team, he has accumulated more than 1.000 wins and led more than 400 student-athletes to receive scholarships at four-year schools.

Pick is a member of many Halls of Fame across the country,



Pick's wife of over 40 years, Sharon, is present at every game throughout the summer. They have two children together, Jeff and Kari, and two grandchildren.

As he enters his 27th season at the helm for Y-D, Pickler has his sights set on adding another championship to his already prestigious career.
