Under the direction of manager Scott Pickler, our youth clinics offer baseball instruction for boys and girls ages 5-18. Coach Pick gears the clinic to the individual needs and playing level of each participant, and he emphasizes good citizenship, character, and teamwork.

Clinics are held at Red Wilson Field, 210 Station Avenue, South Yarmouth, MA. Monday registration opens at 8:30 AM, and the clinic runs 9:00-11:15 AM Monday through Friday. Kids should arrive with sunblock applied, a bottle of water, and baseball glove. Shorts, t-shirts, hat, and sneakers are recommended. Softer baseballs are used, so in the absence of special circumstances, no protective gear is required. Bats are optional. See Coach Pickler on arrival if your child wishes to participate for only 1-2 days. Please note that clinics are held in light rain.

Friday is Family Fun Day! Adults join the fun for a "Kids vs. Adults" game and egg toss, which take place after clinic activities. The day ends with a water "slip and slide," so all kids should bring bathing suits, towels, and change of clothes.

PLEASE NOTE: Kids will be invited to one home game the week of the clinic to take the field with the Y-D Red Sox during the national anthem. Coaches will advise parents of the date. Please bring your child to the field the night of the game wearing his/her clinic t-shirt. Kids meet up at the third base dugout gate at 4:30, unless otherwise instructed.

Scott "Pick" Pickler returns to Y-D for his 27th season as the most successful coach in Cape League history, with 601 wins to

his credit. Pick has managed the Sox to a record six Cape League titles, and seven President's Trophies for the league's best regular season mark. Pickler also has had outstanding success as a collegiate coach. In 1985, he took over a struggling Cypress College program and quickly turned the Chargers into a respected California powerhouse. His teams won five state championships, and he was chosen the National Coach of the Year for California Community Colleges four times. He was inducted into the Cypress College Athletics Hall of Fame in 2017, the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Hall of Fame in 2019, the Cape Cod Baseball League Hall of Fame in 2019, and the California Community College Athletic Association (3C2A) Hall of Fame in 2025, along with his brother, Brad.

Scott's wife, Sharon, worked in education. She and Scott raised two children; Jeff, who played baseball at Tennessee where he was named SEC player of the year and recently coached with the Cincinnati Reds, and Kari, who, with her husband, Chris, operates a business running major events. Scott and Sharon are also blessed with two grandchildren, Bailey and Brandt. (See page 9 for David Okula's article about Pick.)

Coach "G" Giannino returns for his fifth season with the Y-D coaching staff, where he continues to serve as a well-respected leader, teacher, and mentor. With a championship pedigree and a deep commitment to player development, Coach G brings invaluable experience and perspective to Coach Pick's dugout. His steady presence, baseball acumen, and ability to connect with players make him a vital part of the Y-D Red Sox culture.

A California native, Coach G played ball for City College of San Francisco where he was named team MVP, and completed his collegiate career at Bellevue

University, where he led his squad to the 1995 NAIA National Championship. That team, dubbed "The Cardiac Bruins," was inducted into that school's Hall of Fame in 2018 at a ceremony at which Coach G was chosen by his teammates to deliver the speech.

Coach G and his wife, Bonnie, reside in New Jersey with their two daughters, Eliana and Sophie.

As a player, Jeff began his collegiate career with Cypress College playing for his father, before moving on to the University of Tennessee, where in 1998, he was named the Southeastern Conference Player of the Year and a 1st Team All-American. In 1997, Jeff played for the Cape Cod Baseball League Champion Wareham Gatemen. After college, Jeff was drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers and played professionally for eight seasons, collecting over 1,000 career hits. Since retiring, Jeff has spent time as a scout, coach, and front office executive across his 25 years in professional baseball.

MANAGER SCOTT PICKLER RETURNS FOR RECORD 27TH SEASON

With 19 postseason appearances, seven President's Trophies for the league's best record, 601 regular season wins and six CCBL championships during his 26-year tenure, Scott Pickler has created a lasting legacy as manager of the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox.

Pickler, known to all as "Pick," assumed the reigns in 1998 and has become synonymous with the Y-D Red Sox and the CCBL ever since. He is the winningest manager in CCBL history, and along with his time on the Cape, he had a successful career as head coach of Cypress College, a community college in California.

Pick's first CCBL title came in 2004, and it began a stretch of three championships in four years (with titles in '06 and '07). Pick added more titles to his tally with a three-peat in 2014-16. His six championships and seven President's Trophies are CCBL career records. In 2004, he added his ninth division title and became the first CCBL manager with 600 regular season wins.

During his tenure, Pick has managed around 125 future Major League Baseball players. Some of the most notable alumni include: 2024 NL Cy Young Award winner Chris Sale, Guardians pitcher Shane Bieber, Giants former catcher/current President of Baseball Operations Buster Posey, Red Sox pitcher Walker Buehler, star reliever David Robertson, and World Series champion Justin Turner.

Pick's legacy goes beyond what he has done on the

Cape. He won five state championships during his time as head coach of Cypress and still serves as Head Coach Emeritus. Now in his 40th season with the team, he has accumulated more than 1,000 wins and led more than 400 student-athletes to receive scholarships at four-year schools.

Pick is a member of many Halls of Fame across the country, including the Cypress College Athletics Hall of Fame, Cape League Hall of Fame and the American Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame. Last year, he was welcomed into the California Community College Baseball Coaches Association Hall of Fame for his success at Cypress.

Pick's wife of over 40 years, Sharon, is present at every game throughout the summer. They have two children together, Jeff and Kari, and two grandchildren.

As he enters his 27th season at the helm for Y-D, Pickler has his sights set on adding another championship to his already prestigious career.

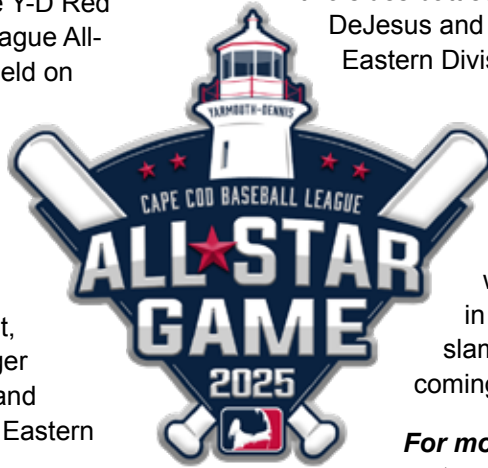
Y-D RED SOX TO HOST CCBL ALL STAR GAME, HOME RUN DERBY AND FAN FEST ON JULY 19

For the fourth time in team history, the Y-D Red Sox will host the Cape Cod Baseball League All-Star Festivities at historic Red Wilson Field on July 19. The event will include the All-Star game between the Eastern and Western divisions, Home Run Derby, autograph sessions, and a new Fanfest featuring a variety of kid-friendly activities.

Y-D players shined at last year's event, which took place in Falmouth. Y-D slugger Ethan Petry won the Home Run Derby and catcher Easton Carmichael was named Eastern Division MVP.

This will be the fourth All-Star Game at Red



Wilson Field. The first took place in 1996, where the two sides battled to a 6-6 tie. In 2006, outfielder Antone DeJesus and first baseman Josh Satin slugged their Eastern Division squad to a 7-2 victory, combining for five RBIs.

Red Wilson Field most recently hosted the All-Star game in 2013, with 4,217 fans in attendance as the East beat the West 9-3. J.D. Davis, who has since played eight years in MLB, was named game MVP after slamming a home run and double after coming off the bench.
