#### CAPPY'S "NO CAP" STAT OF THE DAY:

The Whitecaps are the second team in the CCBL to clinch a playoff spot. The 'Caps did so with 11 games to spare. Another win would be Brewster's 20th. It would be the fourth time with 20 plus wins under manager Jamie Shevchik.

Payton Manca has thrown 19.1 innings this summer and has allowed just two earned runs. The 2026 All Star's 0.93 ERA is the third best amongst qualified pitchers in the CCBL. The Seminole has 23 K's with seven walks.

**Recap of last game:** The Whitecaps clinched a playoff berth for the second straight year with a 7-5 extra innings win over the Commodores. Brewster starter Tate DeRias came into the game with an ERA sub one but faced trouble early. The Commodores struck first with a Braydon Jeffries RBI single. Carter White then jumped on one for a no doubter two run shot, his first of the season. After another run in the second inning the 'Caps trailed the Commodores 4-0. In the fifth with the Whitecaps still without a hit Eddie Yamin destroyed a homer over 400 feet to cut the deficit to 4-1. In the seventh inning Jacob Lee came through with an RBI single to make it a 4-2 game. In the eighth the 'Caps came through in a big way. With two on Holden Pantier doubled to score a pair and even the game at 4-4. Blaine Brown backed it up with a double of his own and Brewster took a 5-4 lead. In the bottom of the ninth the Commodores tied it up and the Whitecaps entered their second extra inning game of the season. In the tenth the Whitecaps scraped a pair across on a Michael Torres single and All Star Zach Kmatz shut the door in the tenth.

**WHEN DID THEY LOSE AGAIN?:** The Whitecaps have not lost since July 9th. Over that time the 'Caps are 6-0-2. Ironically, the Whitecaps last loss came against the Y-D Red Sox. The 5-0 loss is the only shutout defeat of the season for the Whitecaps.

**2025 SUMMARY:** The Whitecaps wrapped up the 2025 regular season with their most wins since 2021 (22) and just their third 20-win season in the Jamie Shevchik era (others: 2015 & 2017). 61 players appeared in at least one game this past summer for the 'Caps - 27 position players, 34 pitchers - nearly 20% more players than the 2024 summer. Brewster's season began with a franchise-best 6-0 start, and the Whitecaps had the most wins in the league at the All-Star Break (15). The Whitecaps earned the three-seed in the East and a first-round matchup with the two-seeded Harwich Mariners. Brewster's season came to a close in a two games to one series loss.

**THE BATTLE FOR THE 1 SEED:** The Whitecaps are three games back on the Red Sox with eleven games to play. The good news? The 'Caps play the Sox three times over the next nine days. The bad news? Y-D has already beat Brewster twice on the year. To win the tiebreaker, the Whitecaps will need to win all three remaining over the Red Sox. If the 'Caps lose tonight, Brewster would essentially fall to five back with ten to play.
