Position Overview

The Cape Cod Baseball League is seeking experienced, highly motivated sports writers to serve as Cape League Writers for the official Cape League Website for the 2027 season. The ideal candidates possess a deep understanding of baseball, exceptional writing and storytelling skills, and a strong commitment to delivering comprehensive league-wide coverage of the CCBL. This role is responsible for providing timely, engaging content ranging from league-wide news to player profiles, roster updates, and long-term trends across all ten franchises. Cape League Writers will also contribute written content for the official website, the bi-weekly League newsletter, Cape League Magazine, the All-Star Game Program, and the end-of-year Cape League Almanac Edition.

Optimal candidates must align with League initiatives and priorities while representing the brand values of the Cape Cod Baseball League.

Location & Availability

- Must reside on Cape Cod (or within 20 miles) throughout the duration of the season from June 2027 through August 2027.
- Available to work non-traditional hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays across CCBL franchise venues.

Time Commitment & Schedule

- **Pre-Season / Offseason (Remote):** Potentially 4 to 5 hours per week focused on administrative prep, roster tracking, pre-season content planning, initial story pitch development, and off-season story writing.
- **In-Season:** Fast-paced environment requiring non-traditional hours, including nights, weekends, and holidays.

Key Responsibilities

League Reporting & Coverage

- Attend and report on games across CCBL venues, writing timely league-wide analysis and feature stories for the official website.
- Provide real-time updates and engage fans through social media channels and website live blogs.
- Conduct regular interviews with players, coaches, and front office personnel across all ten teams to gather insights and develop stories.
- Act as a primary source for breaking league news, including player transactions, awards, and roster moves.

Website & Publication Content Creation

- Develop and produce compelling feature stories, player profiles, and tactical analyses that go beyond the box score for CapeCodLeague.com.
- Continuously cover the league during the offseason, reporting on free agency, MLB Draft updates, winter meetings, and other developments with league alumni.
- Write articles and contributed segments for the League's bi-weekly newsletter, Cape League Magazine, the All-Star Game Program, and the annual Cape League Almanac Edition.
- Collaborate with videographers, photographers, and social media team members to produce integrated multimedia content for digital platforms.
- Participate in podcast and radio segments as needed to provide league-wide commentary and analysis.

- Conduct thorough research on baseball statistics, league history, and rules.
- Build and maintain professional relationships with players, coaches, league/team officials, and sports industry professionals.
- Consistently meet tight editorial deadlines for news articles, web features, and publication assignments.
- Uphold the highest standards of journalistic ethics, integrity, and CCBL policies.

Qualifications

- Current undergraduate or graduate student (graduating 2027 or 2028) OR recent graduate (within 1 year).
- Working towards or holding a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Journalism, Communications, or a related field (preferred).

Experience

- 2–4 years of experience writing for a school/university news outlet or professional sports media organization, with a strong focus on baseball.
- Proven track record as a sports reporter with a deep understanding of baseball rules, statistics, and strategy.

Skills

- Exceptional writing, editing, and storytelling abilities with a keen eye for compelling narrative angles.
- Strong understanding of journalistic ethics, standards, and research practices.

- Proficiency in using web content management platforms and social media (e.g., X/Twitter, Instagram) for real-time professional reporting.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills to quickly build rapport with sources.
- Ability to thrive, manage time efficiently, and meet strict deadlines under pressure in a fast-paced environment.
