Willcox has pitched 17 innings for the 'Caps this season. The incoming sophomore has a 2.65 ERA this year with the Whitecaps. The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket has struck out 20 and has allowed just nine walks.

Recap of last game:

The Brewster Whitecaps took down the Harwich Mariners 6-2 for their third straight win over Harwich. Sebastian Santos-Olson had his first start with the 'Caps. The incoming sophomore went three innings and allowed seven hits. However Santos-Olson allowed just one run with three strikeouts to reduce his season ERA to 0.84. The Whitecaps struck first in the top of the second inning. With a runner on, outfielder Cash Strayer hit a homerun to right field to give Brewster a 2-0 lead. It's Strayer's third homer of the year. In the bottom of the second the Mariners got one back but left the bases loaded. Harwich left 17 runners stranded on the night. In the third Jay Abernathy singled to extend his hitting streak to 11 straight games. Abernathy later came around to score and gave the 'Caps a 3-1 lead. In the sixth Brewster added another run and in the eighth the 'Caps scored another pair to give a 6-1 lead. In the eighth the Mariners had the bases loaded yet again but scored just one and Jordan Regulski slammed the door in the ninth to give the Whitecaps a 6-2 win.

DON'T LET THE WHITECAPS GET HOT:

The Whitecaps are 10-2-1 over their past thirteen games. The best record in the CCBL. The last time the 'Caps lost at home was back on the third of July in a 2-1 loss to the Mariners. Over the past eight games Brewster is scoring on average seven runs a game.

2025 SUMMARY: The Whitecaps wrapped up the 2025 regular season with their most wins since 2021 (22) and just their third 20-win season in the Jamie Shevchik era (others: 2015 & 2017). 61 players appeared in at least one game this past summer for the 'Caps - 27 position players, 34 pitchers - nearly 20% more players than the 2024 summer. Brewster's season began with a franchise-best 6-0 start, and the Whitecaps had the most wins in the league at the All-Star Break (15). The Whitecaps earned the three-seed in the East and a first round matchup with the two-seeded Harwich Mariners. Brewster's season came to a close in a two games to one series loss.

MILESTONE WATCH:

Brewster Whitecaps manager Jamie Shevchik is sitting at 199 career regular season wins. One more and the 12th year manager would get to 200 regular season victories. It would be the 16th most all time wins for any manager of all time in the CCBL.
